### WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 8-7 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium.](#)

The Kernels had a 7-0 lead after scoring six runs in the first inning and another run in the second. The Timber Rattlers rallied with five runs in the second and a run in the third. Joe Gray Jr. drew a bases-loaded walk with two outs in the sixth inning to tie the game. Hendry Mendez knocked in the go-ahead run with a fielder's choice in the bottom of the eighth.

**THREE CHEERS FOR THE BULLPEN!** Three Wisconsin relievers covered 8-1/3 innings yesterday. Miguel Guerrero allowed two runs – one earned – over 4-1/3 innings. Michele Vassalotti pitched 1-2/3 innings without allowing a hit or a run. Shane Smith entered the game in the top of the seventh with the bases loaded. He stranded all three runners and pitched two more scoreless innings for the win.

**SHANE! COME BACK, SHANE!** Smith earned his first Midwest League victory with his performance yesterday. He allowed one hit, walked one, and struck out three in his 2-1/3 innings. Dating back to his last nine appearances with the Carolina Mudcats before his promotion to Wisconsin, Smith has allowed one run and struck out 32 over 25-1/3 innings pitched.

### OPPORTUNITY KNOCKED. RATTLERS ANSWERED:

Wisconsin scored five runs in the second inning on two walks, two errors, and three hits as they sent nine men to bat and take a big bite out of the Kernels lead. Terence Doston drew a bases-loaded walk, three runs scored on an error that could have been an inning-ending double play, and Matt Wood had an RBI single to account for the scoring.

### ANNOUNCE MY PRESENCE WITH AUTHORITY:

Eduardo Garcia was activated from the Wisconsin Injured List before Wednesday's game. He was in the lineup for the first time since July 6. Garcia homered on his second at bat of yesterday's game, a 447' blast off the top of the hitting background.

**ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS:** The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including this year. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

**ABOUT THE TWINS:** Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places three active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), and Matthew Wood (#24). Eric Brown Jr (#6), Eduardo Garcia (#19), and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has eight active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Emmanuel Rodriguez (#2), Noah Miller (#11), Misael Urbina (#19), Alejandro Hidalgo (#20), CJ Culppepper (#26), Kala'i Rosario (#27), Ben Ross (#28), and Cory Lewis (#30). Connor Prelipp (#3) is currently on the IL and Jose Salas (#7) is on the Development List.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP BRANDON WOODRUFF:** Selected by Milwaukee in the 11<sup>th</sup> round of the 2014 draft out of Mississippi State.

**ON ASSIGNMENT:** Woodruff is working his way back from a Grade 2 Subscapular Strain in his right shoulder. He was placed on Milwaukee's 15-Day IL on April 11 and was transferred to the 60-Day IL on May 15.

**THREE YEARS AT STATE:** Woodruff pitched three seasons with Mississippi State and was 3-6 with a 4.70 ERA and 81 strikeouts over 90 innings pitched in 34 games – eighteen starts – in college.

**SKIPPED US:** Woodruff started his professional career in the Pioneer League with the Helena Brewers in 2014 and moved to Brevard County in the Florida State League in 2015 without playing for the Timber Rattlers.

**MAKING MOVES:** Woodruff went 4-1 with a 1.83 ERA in Brevard County before a promotion to Biloxi in the Southern League where he went 10-8 with 124 strikeouts and a 3.01 ERA in 113-2/3 innings during the 2016 season.

**MLB DEBUT:** Woodruff started the 2017 season with Colorado Springs in Triple-A before making his Major League debut with the [Brewers on August 4, against the Tampa Bay Rays](#). Woodruff was the winning pitcher in that debut with six strikeouts over 6-1/3 scoreless innings.

**LAST BREWERS START:** Woodruff made the start and got the win against the St. Louis Cardinals on [April 7](#) at American Family Field. He allowed four hits and walked two with four strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

**LAST TIMBER RATTLERS START:** Woodruff pitched three scoreless innings at Dayton on [July 22](#) in his first rehabilitation start. He allowed two hits, walked none, and struck out four on 32 pitches. Woodruff was not involved in the decision.

**VS. CEDAR RAPIDS:** Woodruff has never faced the Kernels prior to this evening.

## CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ZEBBY MATTHEWS:** The Minnesota Twins selected Matthews in the eighth round of the 2022 draft out of Western Carolina University.

**PARAMOUNT CATAMOUNT:** Matthews was 13-9 with a 3.58 ERA in 36 games – 24 starts – during his career at Western Carolina. He had 211 strikeouts over 183-1/3 innings pitched with just 30 walks during his three-year career. In his final season at WCU, Matthews was 4-6 with four saves in 22 games – ten starts – with 122 strikeouts over 95-2/3 innings.

**MOVING ON UP:** Matthews made two relief appearances as a professional in 2022 after signing with the Twins. He pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts for Minnesota's Florida Complex League team before working two scoreless innings with four strikeouts for the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels in the Florida State League.

**BACK IN FLORIDA:** Matthews made eight appearances – seven starts – with Fort Myers to start the 2023 season. He was 3-1 with a 2.56 ERA. Matthews walked five and struck out 53 in 38-2/3 innings in the Florida State League before his promotion to Cedar Rapids on May 28.

**LAST START:** Matthews beat Peoria at home on [July 21](#). He allowed three runs on five hits with no walks and six strikeouts over six innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Matthews has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. Tonight is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
