ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Beloit Snappers beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 8-4 at ABC Supply Stadium. The Timber Rattlers had a 1-0 lead on a first-inning, solo home run by Thomas Dillard, but the Snappers took the lead with two runs in the third, added a run in the third, and tacked on four runs in the bottom of the sixth for a 7-1 lead.

**DILLY DILLY!** Dillard reached base five times last night. He homered, had two singles, walked, and was hit by a pitch. The home run was his 16<sup>th</sup> of the season.

WALKING INTO HISTORY: Hayden Cantrelle drew two walks last night to give him 70 walks in 70 games this season. He trails Edouard Julien by three walks for the Minor League lead in walks. Cantrelle tied TJ Bohn, who had 70 walks in 2003, for eleventh on Wisconsin's single-season list for most walks. Isan Díaz is tenth with 72 walks. Bo Robinson leads with 108 walks. MAKE THEM SWEAT: The Timber Rattlers trailed 8-3 heading into the top of the ninth. They scored a run when Joe Gray Jr. was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded and that brought the tying run to the plate. Tyler Mitzel got the final out on a deep fly to the warning track in left field

TOUGH NIGHT IN THE FIELD: Wisconsin was charged with five errors last night. That was the most errors they have committed in a game this season. The Snappers scored four unearned runs last night.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Snappers are in their first season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3. Mike Jacobs is in his first season as the manager of the Snappers. Jacobs managed the Clinton LumberKings in 2019, Clinton's last year as an affiliate of the Marlins.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins had a history in the old Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and current Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings and went 78-61 to qualify for the playoffs. They were swept by the South Bend Cubs in the 2019 MWL Championship Series.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Carlos Rodríguez (#14), Hayden Cantrelle (#16), Nick Kahle (#19), Thomas Dillard (#21), and Joe Gray Jr. (#30). MLB Pipeline has three current Snappers on their list of Miami prospects: Kameron Misner (#13), Connor Scott (#14), and Will Banfield (#25).

## PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP VICTOR CASTAÑEDA: The Brewers signed Castañeda as a Minor League Free Agent off the reserve list of Toros de Tijuana from the Mexican League on July 4, 2017.

**TORO! TORO!** Castañeda was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA over nine games – four starts – for Tijuana in 2017 as an 18-year-old.

**FROM MEXICO TO MONTANA:** Castañeda was 2-6 with a 5.13 ERA in fourteen games – eight starts for Helena in the Pioneer League in 2018. He walked fifteen and struck out 40 in 47-1/3 innings pitched last season.

**WELCOME TO WISCONSIN:** Castañeda was 4-2 with six saves in 32 appearance – one start – with Wisconsin in 2019. Castañeda walked 14 and struck out 53 in 44 innings pitched during that season.

THE SEASON WAS NOT OVER: Castañeda was assigned to the Glendale Desert Dogs for the 2019 Arizona Fall League by the Brewers at the end of the Wisconsin season. He was 3-1 with a 1.99 ERA, six walks, and 29 strikeouts over 22-2/3 innings pitched in six games – five starts – for the Desert Dogs. Castañeda was named the AFL Pitcher of the Wek on September 25, 2019.

AWARD WINNING: Castañeda was named the High-A Central League Pitcher of the Week on May 31 for his performance at Cedar Rapids on May 28. He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out eight over 6-2/3 scoreless innings in the game. He was also named he Milwaukee Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July. Castañeda was 2-2 with a 2.45 ERA and 36 strikeouts in 25-2/3 innings over five starts in July.

**LAST START:** Castañeda had a no decision against the <u>Cedar Rapids</u> <u>Kernels at home on July 30</u>. He allowed three runs on six hits with eight strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings.

VS. BELOIT (2021): Castañeda is 1-1 in three starts against the Snappers this season. He was the winning pitcher at home on May 4 and took the loss at home on May 9. Castañeda had a no decision at Beloit on June 30. In his three starts against the Snappers this season, Castañeda has allowed five runs on eight hits with five walks and 15 strikeouts over 15 innings.

## **BELOIT STARTING PITCHER**

RHP GEORGE SORIANO: Signed by the Miami Marlins as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on August 19, 2015.

2016 to 2018: Soriano started his professional career in the Dominican Summer League in 2016 and was 1-6 with two saves, a 3.56ERA, and 56 strikeouts over 55-2/3 innings over 17 games (nine starts). He missed the 2017 season and returned to the mound in the Gulf Coast League in 2018 to go 2-1 with a save, a 1.91ERA, and 36 strikeouts over 42-1/3 innings over eleven games – three starts.

**ON TO IOWA:** Soriano pitched for the Clinton LumberKings during the 2019 season. He was 4-7 with a save and a 3.91 ERA in 23 games – 20 starts – for the LumberKings. He walked 50 and struck out 99 in 119-2/3 innings pitched that season.

**IN THE PRESENT:** Soriano started this season with the Jupiter Hammerheads in the Low-A Southeast. He was 3-0 with a 2.91 ERA and 47 strikeouts over 34 innings in seven starts before his promotion to the Snappers on June 29.

**LAST START:** Soriano won <u>at Peoria on July 31</u>. He allowed two runs on eight hits with a walk and five strikeouts over six innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN (2021):** Soriano made his 2021 Snappers debut with a start against the Timber Rattlers on July 3 at Pohlman Field and took the loss. He allowed three runs on five hits with a walk and three strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.
