SUNDAY IN THE PARK: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Lansing Lugnuts 12-4 at Neuros Group Field. Wisconsin set a season high in hits (16) and runs (12) in a game. All nine Timber Rattlers in the lineup had at least one hit and eight of the nine had at least one RBI. Joe Gray Jr went 3-for-4 with two RBI and was a home run shy of the cycle to lead the offense. Wisconsin scored four times in the bottom of the second inning to take a 4-1 lead. Lansing scored a run in the top of the third before the Rattlers scored four runs in the bottom of the third to take an 8-2 lead. THE MISIOROWSKI REPORT: Jacob Misiorowski was the starting pitcher for the Timber Rattlers on Sunday. He allowed two runs on four hits and four walks with five strikeouts over 2-2/3 innings on 67 pitches for a no decision. MLB Pipeline also announced that Misiorowski has been added to their Top 100 prospects list at #92.

INTO THE WEST: The Timber Rattlers wrapped up three straight weeks against the East Division with the win on Sunday. The Rattlers went 10-7 with a rainout against the East. Wisconsin was 4-1 at West Michigan, 3-3 at Great Lakes, and 3-3 against Lansing. Tonight's game at Quad Cities is the first game for Wisconsin against a team from the West Division since June 4

MAKING MOVES: The Milwaukee Brewers announced that reliever Luis Amaya was promoted to the Biloxi Shuckers. Amaya was 2-1 with two saves and allowed one run over 14-1/3 innings in seven games during June. Shane Smith has been promoted to Wisconsin from Carolina. Smith was on a 15-2/3 inning scoreless streak with the Mudcats before coming to Wisconsin. LOOKING INTO THE FUTURE: Major League Baseball announced that Misiorowski has been selected to play in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game in Seattle on July 8. Seven other Rattlers have been selected to play in the Futures Game: Chris Mears (1999), Craig Anderson (2000), Shin-Soo Choo (2002),

Phillippe Aumont (2008), Bret Lawrie (2009), Tyler Thornburg (2011), and Antoine Kelly (2022) TALE OF THE TAPE.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo García (#19), and Matthew Wood (#24). Hendry Mendez (#13) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CAMERON WAGONER: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Michigan University.

EASTERN NOTES: Wagoner did not pitch collegiately in 2022. He made six relief appearances during the abbreviated 2020 season and 18 appearances – three starts – in 2021. He was 2-4 with a 4.42 ERA and 67 strikeouts over 57 innings during his two college seasons.

HOW DID YOU SPEND YOUR SUMMERS? Wagoner played for Greeneville in the Appalachian League in 2021 and was with both Wareham and Cotuit in the Cape Cod League in 2022. He was 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA in nineteen games – two starts – and 57 strikeouts over 38 innings pitched in those summer leagues.

AS A PRO: Wagoner made four appearances – two starts – for the ACL Brewers Gold after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-0 and had eight strikeouts in eight innings in the ACL.

DOWN UNDER: Wagoner pitched for the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League during the Winter of 2022-23. He made ten starts during the regular season of the ABL and was 3-1 with a 3.26 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 47 innings pitched.

LAST START: Wagoner lost to Lansing at home on <u>June 21</u>. He allowed two runs on four hits with three walks and three strikeouts. The Rattlers trailed 2-0 when Wagoner left the game and Lansing went on to a 7-1 win.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Wagoner is 0-2 in two starts against the River Bandits this season. He lost to them at home on <u>April 20</u> and at Modern Woodmen Park on <u>May 20</u>. Wagoner has allowed eleven runs on ten hits with eight walks and nine strikeouts over 7-1/3 innings.

QUAD CITIES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP LUINDER AVILA: The Royals signed Avila as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on March 3, 2018.

TWO SUMMERS IN THE LEAGUE: Avila was mainly a reliever for Royals affiliates in the Dominican Summer League in 2018 and 2019. He made 21 appearances – four starts – and was 2-4 with a 4.93 ERA, 27 walks, and 42 strikeouts over 49-1/3 innings.

LEVELS: Avila pitched for both Kansas City's Arizona Complex League affiliate and the Columbia Fireflies in the Carolina League in 2021. In 14 games – ten starts – during 2021, Avila was 3-6 with a 4.66 ERA and 51 strikeouts over 58 innings.

INTO THE ROTATION: In 2022, Avila made 26 starts for Columbia. He was 6-10 with a 4.54 ERA. Avila walked 49 and struck out 97 in 115 innings pitched last season.

LAST APPEARANCE: Avila earned the <u>win with 4-1/3 scoreless innings at</u> <u>Cedar Rapids on April 14</u>. He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out eight.

LAST START: Avila lost at Beloit on <u>June 13</u>. He allowed three runs on six hits with no walks and two strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Avila is 1-0 in two starts against the Timber Rattlers this season. He had a no decision against Wisconsin at Modern Woodmen Park on April 21 and a win at Neuroscience Group Field on May 17. He has allowed five runs – four earned – on ten hits with three walks and twelve strikeouts over ten innings against Wisconsin in 2023.
