Wisconsin had a 5-0 lead, but the Cubs rallied with four runs in the sixth and two runs in the seventh. Wes Clarke tied the game with a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the eighth. Micah Bello scored the winning run on a passed ball. This was Wisconsin's seventh walkoff win of the season.

LUCKY NUMBER THIRTEEN: Antoine Kelly had set a new single-game high for strikeouts as a pro with thirteen over 5-2/3 innings on Sunday. Kelly got thirty swings that failed to make contact in the game.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

# WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYNE MOORE: The Brewers selected Moore in the  $18^{th}$  round of the 2021 draft out of Old Dominion University.

**THE MONARCH:** Moore went 9-1 with a 3.16 ERA in seventeen games – fourteen starts – in his final season at ODU. He was also named a Second Team All-Conference USA selection in 2021.

**AM I BLUE?** Moore began his professional career with Milwaukee's Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League after signing his professional contract. He made six appearances – two starts – and allowed a run on four hits over 12-2/3 innings for Brewers Blue.

IN MY MIND I'M GOING TO CAROLINA: Moore started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 0-1 with a 2.31 ERA in six starts in the Carolina League. Moore walked eleven and struck out 38 over 35 innings for the Mudcats.

**WELCOME TO WISCONSIN:** Moore joined the Timber Rattlers on May 12, 2022.

**LAST START:** Moore lost in his Timber Rattlers <u>debut in a start against</u> <u>South Bend at home on May 18</u>. He allowed six runs on six hits, three hit batsmen, a walk and two strikeouts over four innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Moore has never faced the Kernels prior to this evening. This will also be the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

# CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP AARON ROZEK:** The Minnesota Twins signed Rozek as a minor league free agent off the roster of the Schaumberg Flyers of the Frontier League on June 24, 2021.

**HE'S A MAVERICK:** Rozek, a native of Burnsville, Minnesota, pitched four years at Minnesota State in Mankato. He was 20-4 with two saves and had a 3.24 ERA with 195 strikeouts in 48 games during his career at Minnesota State.

**IN THE NORTHWOODS:** Rozek pitched in the Northwoods League for three summers. He was with Alexandria in 2014 and pitched for St. Cloud in 2016 and 2017.

**TAKING A FLYER:** Rozek started his professional career with Southern Illinois in the Frontier League in 2018. In 2019, He moved to Schaumburg and was 7-5 with 99 strikeouts and a 3.60 ERA in 120 innings pitched over 20 starts. Rozek did not pitch professionally in 2020 and returned to Schaumburg at the start of 2021 to go 2-0 in four starts before signing with the Twins.

**LEVELS:** Rozek pitched at five different levels of baseball in 2021. He started with Schaumburg and has pitched for the Florida Complex League Twins, Fort Myers in the Low-A Southeast, Wichita in the Double-A Central, and Cedar Rapids. Rozek finished the season with the Kernels and was 1-1 with a 4.03 ERA, five walks and 28 strikeouts over 22-1/3 innings in five games – four starts.

**LAST START:** Rozek <u>lost to Lake County at home on May 18</u>. He allowed three runs on five hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Rozek made <u>a relief appearance against Wisconsin at Cedar Rapids on August 22, 2021</u> and a <u>start at Wisconsin on September 11, 2021</u>. He went 0-1 and allowed seven runs on six hits with two walks and fourteen strikeouts over nine innings. Four of the six hits he gave up were Wisconsin home runs.
