SUNDAY AFTERNOON: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 5-4 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium.](#) Dylan O'Rae broke a 3-3 tie with a two-run singled in the bottom of the sixth inning. The victory gave the Timber Rattlers the series victory as they took two of three games from the Chiefs to start the 2024 season.

JIMENEZ SHOWS HIS QUALITY: Wisconsin starting pitcher Edwin Jimenez pitched six innings, allowed three runs, and picked up the win after a quality start. Jimenez scattered seven hits and walked three with four strikeouts in the game.

A PITCHER'S BEST FRIEND: Wisconsin's defense turned a pair of inning-ending double plays at key points in Sunday's game. The Chiefs had the bases loaded with one out in the top of the second inning when Jimenez got Darlin Moquete to ground into a 5-3 double play to kill the rally. In the sixth, Jimenez walked a batter with one out before inducing Joshua Baez to hit into a 6-4-3 double play.

COMEBACK KIDS: Peoria had leads of 1-0 and 3-2 with the Rattlers rallying for the win twice. The Chiefs took their 3-2 lead on an RBI double by Alex Iadiseria in the top of the fifth inning. Wisconsin tied the game with a two-out, RBI single by Mike Boeve in the bottom of the fifth. Boeve was 5-for-8 in the final two games of the series. In the sixth, Wisconsin loaded the bases on three consecutive singles. O'Rae singled home the go-ahead runs in the with one out in the sixth.

SAVINGS PLAN: Chase Costello, Stiven Cruz, and Craig Yoho worked the final three innings to preserve the win. Costello worked around two base runners in the seventh. Cruz relieved Costello with a runner on and two outs in the eighth for an inning-ending strikeout. Yoho took over for Cruz with one out and runners on second and third in the ninth. Yoho got the second out on a sacrifice fly and ended the game on a grounder to second for the save. The Rattlers were 2-for-2 in save opportunities in the series with Peoria.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his first year as South Bend's manager.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

SEASON SO FAR: South Bend won their season opening game 3-1 on April 5 at Quad Cities. The Cubs lost the next two games in the series 3-2 in ten innings on Saturday and 4-0 on Sunday. The Cubs are coming off a 57-73 record in 2023.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP PATRICIO AQUINO: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Aquino as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: Aquino made his professional debut with the Brewers #1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He made eleven starts and was 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 44 innings pitched.

LET'S GO TO ARIZONA: Aquino was 2-1 with a 4.72 ERA in eight games – seven starts – for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League during the 2022 season. He had 49 strikeouts over 34-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO CAROLINA: Aquino was 5-3 with a 2.75 ERA in 21 games – 19 starts – with 86 strikeouts over 88-1/3 innings pitched during the 2023 regular season.

PLAYOFF CALL: Aquino was the starting pitcher for the Mudcats in Game Two of the first round Carolina League playoff series against the Down East Wood Ducks. He had a no decision with six scoreless innings. The Mudcats would lose the game 6-5 in ten innings.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline rates Aquino as the #29 prospect in the Brewers organization.

LAST START: Aquino pitched six shutout innings at Down East in Game Two of the Carolina League playoff series between the Mudcats and Wood Ducks on [September 14, 2023](#). Aquino had a no decision, allowed four hits, hit one, walked none, and struck out five.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Aquino has never faced the South Bend Cubs prior to this evening. The last time he pitched against an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs was on [July 29, 2022](#) in a game against the ACL Cubs. Aquino worked three innings in relief and allowed four runs – three earned – on five hits with two walks and three strikeouts for a no decision.

SOUTH BEND SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP NICK HULL: The Chicago Cubs selected Hull in the seventh round of the 2022 draft out of Grand Canyon University.

WHERE THE DEER AND THE ANTELOPE PLAY: Hull pitched five seasons at Grand Canyon University. He was 15-5 with a save and a 4.04 ERA in 79 games – 25 starts – at GCU. Hull had 214 strikeouts over 220-2/3 innings in college.

IN THE SUMMER TIME: Hull pitched in three different Summer Collegiate Leagues during his time with GCU. He was at Bellingham of the West Coast League in 2018, Mankato of the Northwoods League in 2019, and Orleans of the Cape Cod League in 2021.

GETTING TO WORK: Hull made four appearances – three starts – in the Cubs system after signing his professional contract in 2022. He had one relief appearance in the Arizona Complex League and three starts for the Myrtle Beach Pelicans.

LAST SEASON: Hull started 2023 with Myrtle Beach and was 6-3 with a 4.30 ERA in eighteen games – fifteen starts – before getting bumped up to South Bend. Hull was 2-0 with a 3.24 ERA in five games – one start – with the Cubs.

LAST START: Hull was the starting pitcher for Mesa in the Arizona Fall League in a game against the Peoria Javelinas on November 3, 2023. He allowed four unearned runs on three hits with three walks with four strikeouts over 2-2/3 innings. Hull was not involved in the decision.

VS. WISCONSIN: Hull has never pitched against Wisconsin prior to this evening. The only other time he has faced an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers was as a starter against the Carolina Mudcats on [September 10, 2022](#). He allowed four runs on six hits with two walks and two strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings to take the loss.
