#### CIRCLE CITY ROUNDUP

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians loaded the bases twice in the first inning but only yielded one run before erupting for three runs in the second to give them a winning advantage they would not surrender as they took down the Gwinnett Stripers, 8-1, on Tuesday night at Victory Field. With a 1-1 game in the bottom of the second inning, Brett Sullivan wrapped a 391-foot home run around the right field foul pole to put the Indians on top. Tsung-Che Cheng reached on a walk one batter later and came around to score on an errant pickoff attempt by lan Mejia. Indy capped its game-deciding inning at a 4-1 advantage with an RBI double from Ji Hwan Bae. The Indians pieced together a hit, four walks and a throwing error in the first inning to take an early 1-0 lead. The Stripers responded quickly in the top half of the second, loading the bases on a walk, a single and a catcher's interference before scoring their lone run of the game on an RBI groundout from Matthew Batten. Indy's offense sputtered until the sixth inning when Liover Peguero jolted the offense with a solo homer to lead off the frame. The Indians added another run in the seventh when Bae reached base, stole second and came around on a Nick Solak single. Cheng capped the scoring with a two-run homer in the eighth to give the Indians some extra cushion. Thomas Harrington recorded his fourth quality start of the campaign, tossing 6.0 innings while allowing two hits and one unearned run. Dauri Moreta, Eddy Yean and Kyle Nicolas each tossed a scoreless inning while combining for one hit to hold the Stripers at bay.

**HARRI STYLES:** Thomas Harrington earned his sixth win of the season last night, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball (unearned) with two hits, two walks and two strikeouts. It marked his fourth quality start of the season. He has tossed 5.0-plus innings in seven consecutive starts for the first time since a 10-start stretch from May 30-July 26, 2024 with Double-A Altoona.

**PEGGY TALK TO 'EM:** Liover Peguero (1-for-4, HR, K) launched his fifth home run of the season last night crushing a sweeper off southpaw Hayden Harris 412 feet to left field in the sixth inning. It was his second-farthest hit homer of the season, trailing only his 420-foot blast on May 14 vs. Louisville. Indy's three homers in the contest matched a season high (also April 3 vs. Iowa).

SULLY SMASH: Brett Sullivan (2-for-4, 2 R, HR, K), gave the Indians a 2-1 lead, the game-winning run, with his second home run of the season in the second inning of last night's contest. At 104.4 mph and 391 feet, it marked his second-hardest hit ball of the season and farthest hit, exiting the stadium down the right field line onto S West Street. It was his first homer since May 29 vs. Nashville.

**CHA CHENG:** Tsung-Che Cheng (1-for-3, 2 R, HR, 2 RBI, BB, K) cashed in with his first career Triple-A home run yesterday, his first longball since Aug. 20, 2024, with Double-A Altoona at Richmond. It was just the second homer of the campaign allowed by Stripers closer Wander Suero across 35.0 innings. Cheng has hit safely in four of five games this month, hitting .294 (5-for-17) with three runs, one double, one homer, six RBI and two walks. On July 4 vs. Louisville, he drove in a career-high tying four runs (6x, MR: 8/7/24 with Altoona at Portland).

**BAEWATCH:** Ji Hwan Bae (3-for-4, R, 2B, 3B, RBI, BB, 2 SB) was just a home run shy of the cycle as he powered the Indians offense in an array of box score categories. He matched a season high with three hits, last doing so on June 28 vs. Omaha. He reached base safely four times for the third time this season (MR: 6/28). Since returning from the injured list on June 27, he is hitting .361 (13-for-36) with nine runs, one double, one triple, three RBI, five walks and four stolen bases in nine games.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak (1-for-4, 4 R, BB, SB) extended his team-best on-base streak to 22 games yesterday, which is the fourth-longest active run in the International League. Solak is hitting .337 (29-for-86) with 19 runs, three doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, 11 walks, two stolen bases and an .862 OPS in this stretch. He has hit safely in 20 of those 22 games, with a team-high tying 14 game hitting streak from June 12 (1)-27. He owns honors as the IL's top hitter with a .363 batting average (77-for-212) for the season. As the Indians lone representative on the league offensive leaderboard, he also ranks among qualifiers in on-base percentage (3rd, .429), OPS (5th, .976) and slugging percentage (9th, .547).

TODAY'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's six-game series with the Gwinnett Stripers this afternoon at 1:35 PM. Last night, Indy picked up its first win over the Stripers since Aug. 3, 2023, and first win over them at Victory Field since May 31, 2017. RHP Sean Sullivan takes the mound for the Indians, opening a bullpen game, set to make his sixth appearance and fourth start of the campaign. Sullivan last tossed 3.0 innings of two-run ball on July 3 at Louisville with four hits, one walk and two strikeouts. It marks his first career game against the Stripers. Opposite Sullivan is RHP Jhancarlos Lara, who is set to make his 17th appearance of the season and first start since April 30 with Double-A Columbus at Biloxi. It marks his first career appearance against Indianapolis.

**ON THIS DATE IN 2006:** In the final game before the All-Star break, starter Marty McLeary struck out 11 batters in 6.1 innings against Toledo en route to a 6-2 Indianapolis win at Victory Field. McLeary was in line for the loss as he surrendered two earned runs in the sixth inning, but Indy tied up the game in the bottom of the sixth. Chris Richard then hit a three-run homer during a four-run eighth. McLeary finished the season with a team-leading 115 strikeouts and 2.68 ERA.

**ON THIS DATE IN 1944:** Former Olympic champion Jesse Owens gave a running exhibition and an inspirational speech in support of WWII between games of an Indianapolis Clowns vs. Detroit Stars doubleheader. The Clowns swept the Stars, 8-1 and 14-2 in front of a crowd of 5,000 fans.
