ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The lowa Cubs scored seven runs in the top of the 11th inning to defeat the Indianapolis Indians, 7-0, on Tuesday night at Victory Field. With automatic runner Parker Chavers on second base to begin the 11th, Hayden Cantrelle put down a sacrifice bunt to advance the potential first run of the game to third base. James Triantos brought home Chavers on a fielder's choice for a 1-0 lead. Following the run-scoring play, seven consecutive lowa batters reached to extend the lead to 7-0. Eddy Yean opened the game with 3.0 scoreless innings. The Indians tossed 10.0 scoreless innings to begin the game, using seven total pitchers in the contest. Ryan Harbin allowed all seven runs in the 11th. I-Cubs starter Connor Noland tossed 5.0 scoreless frames of his own as the I-Cubs pitched an 11.0-inning shutout. Caleb Kilian was credited the win with a scoreless 10th inning.

EDDY YEAN STRIKEOUT MACHINE: Eddy Yean opened the game for the Indians last night, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings. He struck out seven batters, his most since a career-high nine on June 25 (2) with Low-A Bradenton vs. Jupiter. Prior to tonight, he had not struck out more than two batters in an outing since Aug. 7, 2024, with Double-A Altoona at Portland.

BRANDAN BLANKS: Brandan Bidiois tossed 2.0 scoreless and hitless innings in last night's contest, and has now faced 71 consecutive batters without allowing a hit since July 29 with Double-A Altoona at Portland. Bidois is yet to allow a hit or run in six games and 9.2 innings with Indy, walking five and striking out 13. Among all minor leaguers with at least 50.0 innings pitched, he has the lowest batting average against (.111, 21-for-190), lowest OPS against (.349), second-lowest ERA (0.78) and hits per nine (3.28). In addition to these stats, he has an 8-0 record across 37 total appearances in 2025.

BOWEN BASH: Jase Bowen went 1-for-2 with a walk and a stolen base last night and he has reached safely in nine straight games since Aug. 30. He has posted one-plus hit in eight of those including six straight. In this span, he is hitting .367 (11-for-30) with four runs, three doubles, two triples, one home run, five RBI, four walks, three stolen bases and a 1.141 OPS.

WINDIANAPOLIS: The Indians 78 wins are their most in a season since winning 79 games in 2018. They can reach 80 wins for the first time since winning 83 games in 2015. Indy owns a Triple-A best 46-23 (.667) record at home and it is the club's best home winning percentage to this point in the season since at least 2005, surpassing their 46-24 (.657) record at home through Aug. 30, 2012. 46 wins at Victory Field also surpasses the Indians' home win total in 26 of 28 full seasons in the Victory Field era (since 1996). Indians pitchers have struck out the third most batters (678) at home this season and have held opponents to the third-lowest ERA (3.76) in those games.

CLOSE SHAVE: The Indians improved their record in one-run games to 29-13 (.690) on Sunday afternoon. It is the Indians' best winning percentage in one-run games to this point in the season since at least 2015, surpassing their 30-23 record (.566) through Aug. 30, 2015. The Indians have finished with an above .500 record in one-run games in five seasons since at least 2005 and last did so in 2021. Indy is on track to surpass their 28-19 (.596) record in one-run games in 2011 for its best one-run record in a season since at least 2005.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue the 2025 season's final homestand against the lowa Cubs this afternoon at 1:35 PM. RHP Drake Fellows is set to make his 31st appearance and 17th start of the season. Fellows has made two appearances (1 start) against the I-Cubs on the campaign, allowing five earned runs in 6.2 innings. Opposite Fellows is RHP Antonio Santos, who was activated from the development list today. He has allowed nine earned runs in 12.2 innings across three appearances with the club. Indy is 6-6 against lowa on the campaign and seeks to win its second consecutive season series following a 13-5 record in 2024.

JOLLY GOOD, FELLOWS: Drake Fellows is on the heels of a solid start at Columbus on Sept. 4, as he allowed just one run across 5.0 frames. In his last three starts dating back to Aug. 23 at Syracuse, he has a 2.25 ERA (4er/16.0ip) with 14 hits, eight walks and seven strikeouts.

ON THIS DATE IN 2005: In Game 4 of the Governors' Cup semis at Buffalo, Graham Koonce broke a 1-1 tie with a solo shot in the top of the fourth. The score remained that way until the ninth, when Game 3 hero J.J. Furmaniak cracked a two-run homer for huge insurance runs. Mark Corey then retired the side in the bottom half on 12 pitches to force a winner-take-all Game 5.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Drake Fellows: He will be making his 17th start of the season and his 37th career start compared to 34 career relief appearances.

Last Outing: Fellows is on the heels of a solid start at Columbus on Sept. 4, as he allowed just one run across 5.0 frames.

Against the I-Cubs: Fellows has made two appearances (1 start) against the I-Cubs on the campaign, allowing five earned runs in 6.2 innings.

Fellows Posts Zeroes: Fellows owns the longest scoreless streak by an Indians pitcher this season, tossing 15.0 scoreless frames across four starts from July 12-31.

May Flowers: Fellows was named the Indians May Player of the Month earlier this season. In six appearances, he ranked sixth among Triple-A pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched in ERA (1.15, 2er/15.2ip) and 11th in WHIP (0.96). He was the first Indians reliver to earn the award since Hunter Stratton in Aug. 2023

Fab Five: Fellows picked up a win in a career and team-high five straight decisions from April 20-May 31. He pitched to a 2.08 ERA (5er/21.2ip) with 25 strikeouts in nine appearances across that stretch.

Miscellaneous: Selected by San Diego in the sixth round (173rd overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt (Nashville, Tenn.) University...
