LAST ACTION: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers lost 2-1 in eleven innings to the South Bend Cubs at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium on Sunday afternoon.](#)

Wisconsin trailed 1-0 with one out in the bottom of the eighth inning when Eric Brown Jr singled, stole second, stole third, and scored on a fielder's choice by Robert Moore. The Cubs scored the go-ahead run on an RBI single by James Triantos in the top of the eleventh and Wisconsin stranded the tying and winning runs in scoring position in the bottom of the eleventh. Wisconsin and South Bend split the six-game series.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU? Brown singled, was hit by a pitch, and walked on Sunday to move his on-base streak to fourteen games. Brown stole three bases on Sunday, too.

RUNNING WILD: Wisconsin went 5-for-5 in stolen bases on Sunday. The Rattlers were 18-for-19 in stolen base attempts in the South Bend series. Wisconsin has 48 stolen bases this season and they are fourth in the Midwest League in that category.

BOUNCING BACK: Cameron Wagoner pitched five scoreless innings as Wisconsin's starting pitcher on Sunday. He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out four for a no decision. Wagoner started game one of the series against the Cubs on May 9 and did not get out of the first inning.

MILLER TIME: Darrien Miller had two hits on Sunday – a single and a double. He is 13-for-40 (.325) in his ten games played this month. Miller has five doubles and two homers in May for an OPS of .972.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

DELAYED START: Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

MUDDY WATERS: Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO WISCONSIN: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022. He made four starts with the Rattlers and allowed one run on six hits with six walks and twenty strikeouts over nineteen innings pitched for a 1-1 record with a 0.47ERA.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24, 2022. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 29 for this game.

LAST START: Cruz had a [no decision against South Bend at home on May 10](#). He allowed six runs – two earned – on eight hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings. The Timber Rattlers lost the game 10-6.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Cruz had a [no decision at Quad Cities on April 21](#). He allowed four runs on three hits – including two home runs – four walks, and five strikeouts over four innings. Cruz gave up homers to Gavin Cross and Cayden Wallace in the start.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

LHP NOAH CAMERON: The Royals selected Cameron in the 7th round of the 2021 draft out of the University of Central Arkansas.

CENTRAL PLANNING: Cameron pitched in 2019 and 2020 with Central Arkansas. He was 7-2 in eighteen starts for the Bears. He had 122 strikeouts and a 2.86 ERA in 122-2/3 innings in his college career.

A SETBACK: Cameron did not pitch in college in 2021. He injured his elbow playing for the Wilmar Stingers in the Northwoods League during the summer of 2020 and needed Tommy John Surgery. Cameron did not pitch professionally in 2021 after signing with the Royals.

THE LONG-AWAITED DEBUT: Cameron made his professional debut with the Columbia Fireflies on April 8, 2022 against Augusta. He allowed three runs on four hits with three walks and four strikeouts over three innings.

DEEP SOUTH: Cameron was 0-1 with a 3.72 ERA, nine walks, and 39 strikeouts over 29 innings pitched in seven starts for Columbia before he was sent to Quad Cities on May 20, 2022.

BANDIT: Cameron went 2-1 with seven walks and 53 strikeouts in 31 innings over nine starts for the Quad Cities last season. He was injured in a start on June 25, 2022 and made three rehab starts in the Arizona Complex League in August prior to returning to the River Bandits on August 14, 2022 to finish the season.

LAST START: Cameron [lost to Cedar Rapids at home on May 9](#). He allowed seven runs on ten hits with no walks and five strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings. Cameron gave up two homers in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Cameron had a [no decision against the Timber Rattlers at home on April 20](#). He allowed two runs on three hits with two walks and nine strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings. Alex Hall homered off Cameron in that game. In 2022, Cameron made the start against Wisconsin [on June 25](#) and allowed two runs – one earned – on three hits and two strikeouts over three innings for a no decision.
