**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers swept a doubleheader from the Great Lakes Loons at Neuroscience Group Field. Wisconsin rallied from 6-1 down to win game one 8-7 and from 3-0 down to win game two 6-3.

**GAME ONE RECAP:** The Loons had leads of 5-0 and 6-1. Chad McClanahan homered in the bottom of the fourth. Then, Wisconsin got three-run homers from Joe Gray Jr. and Yeison Coca in the bottom of the fifth inning to take an 8-6 lead.

**GAME TWO RECAP:** Great Lakes scored single runs in the second, third, and fourth innings to take the lead. Wisconsin tallied five runs in the bottom of the fourth on a two-run double by Carlos Rodríguez, a two-run single by Antonio Piñero, and an RBI grounder by Gray. Joey Wiemer hit a home run in the fifth inning.

**OH, WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:** Wisconsin relievers covered seven innings and allowed one run on four hits with no walks and fourteen strikeouts in the two games of last night's doubleheader. In game one, Brady Schanuel picked up his fourth win of the season with 2-1/3 scoreless innings and Evan Reifert allowed a run but struck out five over 1-2/3 innings for the save. In game two, Nash Walters won his fourth game with 1-2/3 innings and Taylor Floyd earned his eighth save with 1-1/3 innings and three strikeouts.

**ABOUT GREAT LAKES:** The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They made the Midwest League playoffs seven times between 2007 and 2019. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux.

**ABOUT THE DODGERS:** The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

**GREAT LAKES IN 2019:** The Loons had the best record in the Midwest League in 2019. They were 81-55 in the regular season but were swept in the Eastern Division Finals by the South Bend Cubs.

**GREAT LAKES IN 2021:** The Loons are 45-39 and tied with the Cedar Rapids Royals for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League. Great Lakes is facing a team from the Western Division for the first time this season by playing the Timber Rattlers. They lead the league in homers (123) and are second in OPS (.790) and average (.254). The Loons pitchers are second in the league in ERA (3.96).

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) puts five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Xavier Warren (#11), Carlos Rodríguez (#14), Hayden Cantrelle (#16), Nick Kahle (#19), and Joe Gray Jr. (#30). [MLB Pipeline](#) has four current Loons on their list of Dodgers prospects: Andy Pages (#6), Clayton Beeter (#10), Leonel Valera (#23), and Hyun-Il Choi (#25). Bobby Miller (#3) and Robinson Ortiz (#20) are currently on the Great Lakes Injured List.

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP VICTOR CASTAÑEDA:** The Brewers signed Castañeda as a Minor League Free Agent off the reserve list of Toros de Tijuana from the Mexican League on July 4, 2017.

**TORO! TORO!** Castañeda was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA over nine games – four starts – for Tijuana in 2017 as an 18-year-old.

**FROM MEXICO TO MONTANA:** Castañeda was 2-6 with a 5.13 ERA in fourteen games – eight starts for Helena in the Pioneer League in 2018. He walked fifteen and struck out 40 in 47-1/3 innings pitched last season.

**WELCOME TO WISCONSIN:** Castañeda was 4-2 with six saves in 32 appearance – one start – with Wisconsin in 2019. Castañeda walked 14 and struck out 53 in 44 innings pitched during that season.

**THE SEASON WAS NOT OVER:** Castañeda was assigned to the Glendale Desert Dogs for the 2019 Arizona Fall League by the Brewers at the end of the Wisconsin season. He was 3-1 with a 1.99 ERA, six walks, and 29 strikeouts over 22-2/3 innings pitched in six games – five starts – for the Desert Dogs. Castañeda was named the AFL Pitcher of the Week on September 25, 2019.

**AWARD WINNING:** Castañeda was named the High-A Central League Pitcher of the Week on May 31 for his performance [at Cedar Rapids on May 28](#). He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out eight over 6-2/3 scoreless innings in the game. He was also named the Milwaukee Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July. Castañeda was 2-2 with a 2.45 ERA and 36 strikeouts in 25-2/3 innings over five starts in July.

**LAST START:** Castañeda [lost at Beloit on August 6](#). He allowed four runs on seven hits with two walks and five strikeouts over five innings pitched.

**VS. GREAT LAKES:** Castañeda has never faced the Loons. This is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

## GREAT LAKES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JESÚS VARGAS:** Vargas was signed by the Dodgers as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela in 2014.

**START OF THE JOURNEY:** Vargas began his professional career with the Dominican Summer League affiliate of the Dodgers in 2015 and 2016. He spent the majority of the 2017 season with the AZL Dodgers and was 4-3 with a 3.38 ERA in 14 games – eleven starts. Vargas also made one relief appearance for the Ogden Raptors of the Pioneer League and was 1-0 while allowing three runs on seven hits over four innings.

**WHERE HAVE YOU BEEN SINCE?** Vargas made eight starts with the Loons in 2018 and as 4-3 with a 3.28 ERA before going on their IL on May 22, 2018. He would make appearances for Ogden and the AZL Dodgers on rehab assignments, went back in the IL on September 2. He missed the entire 2019 season and again in 2020.

**LAST START:** Vargas had a no decision [against Fort Wayne on August 6](#). He allowed five runs on five hits with a walk and a strikeout over 2/3 of an inning. He TinCaps hit a pair of homers off Vargas in the game.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Vargas lost to [Wisconsin at Neuroscience Group Field on May 10, 2018](#). He allowed two runs – one earned – on four hits with no walks and five strikeouts over four innings.
