WEDNESDAY TWINBILL: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers and Cedar Rapids Kernels split a doubleheader at Neuroscience Group Field. The Timber Rattlers won game one 8-2. The Kernels won game two 15-2.

GAME ONE RECAP: Marco Dinges went 3-for-3 with a homer and three RBI to lead the Timber Rattler offense in game one. Ryan Birchard allowed two runs – on solo homers by Caelen Culpepper and Brandon Winokur – and struck out ten to set a professional, single-game high over 5-2/3 innings as the Rattler starting pitcher. The Kernels five-game winning streak ended.

GAME TWO RECAP: The Kernels scored in each of their first five innings to take a 15-1 lead. Danny DeAndrade drove in five runs for the Kernels. Cole Peschl allowed one run over five innings with four strikeouts as the starter for Cedar Rapids. Luiyin Alastre went to the mound from right field to pitch a perfect top of the seventh. The Kernels ended Wisconsin's winning streak at four games with the win.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Wisconsin's win in game one got them to 26-26 on the season, the first time they have been .500 since they were 3-3.

RUNNING WILD: Eduardo Garcia stole two bases in the first game and another base in the nightcap. Garcia has 21 steals this season. Garcia had 20 stolen bases over 153 games between the 2023 and 2024 season.

WORTHY OPPONENT: Culpepper led off both games of the doubleheader with a homer. That has only happened four times in Major League Baseball: Harry Hooper (5/30/1913); Rickey Henderson (7/6/1993), Brady Anderson (8/21/1999), and Ronald Acuña Jr (8/13/2018).

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended last year when the Kernels missed the playoffs. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

Charlee Soto (#8), Billy Amick (#14), and Khadim Diaw (#29) are currently on the Cedar Rapids IL.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYSON HARDIN: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Hardin in the 12th round of the 2024 draft out of Mississippi State University.

BULLDOG: Hardin was 3-3 and two saves with a 6.59 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 56 innings in forty games – two starts – at Mississippi State.

DAYTONA 500: Hardin pitched two seasons at Daytona State College (2021 and 2022). He was the team's pitcher of the year as a freshman and was 8-5 with two saves in 38 appearances – fifteen starts – at DSC.

BREAKING OUT: Hardin worked two innings in Milwaukee's 2025 Spring Breakout Game against the Cincinnati Reds on [March 16](#). He allowed one hit and struck out three without a walk in two scoreless innings.

AWARD WINNING APRIL: Hardin was named Milwaukee's Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April. He was 2-0 with a 0.96 ERA with four walks and 20 strikeouts over 18-2/3 innings.

WHAT A WEEK: Hardin was named the Midwest League's Pitcher of the Week on May 19 for his seven-inning, complete-game, two-hit shutout against Beloit on May 16.

LAST START: Hardin allowed one run over four innings for a no decision against Peoria at home on [May 29](#). He walked two, hit one, and struck out five.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Hardin had a no decision at Veterans Memorial Stadium on [April 26](#). He allowed two runs on six hits with two walks and four strikeouts over four innings.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TY LANGENBERG: The Minnesota Twins selected Langenberg in the eleventh round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Iowa.

HIS 2023: Langeberg went 6-3 with a 4.15 ERA in seventeen games – fifteen starts – at Iowa. He made his professional debut with the Florida Complex League Twins with two brief relief appearances. Langenberg also made three brief relief appearances with the Ft. Myers Mighty Mussels in the Florida State League last season.

LAST YEAR: Langenberg started 2024 with Ft. Myers. He was 3-3 with a 3.38 ERA and struck out 56 over 48 innings pitched in nine starts. He was promoted to Cedar Rapids on June 11.

LAST START: Langenberg had a no decision at home against Lake County on [May 30](#). He allowed three runs on seven hits with three walks and five strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Langenberg was the starter against the Rattlers in Cedar Rapids on [April 23, 2025](#). He allowed one hit and struck out three over four scoreless innings for a no decision. Langenberg also started against the Timber Rattlers at home on [September 3, 2024](#). He allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out seven over five scoreless innings for a no decision.
