WEDNESDAY DAY GAME: The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-2 at Dozer Park in game two of this series. Tommy Jew broke a 2-2 tie with the three-run home run in the bottom of the eighth inning

TOUGH DAY IN THE FIELD: The Timber Rattlers were charged with four errors on Wednesday. There was an error on the first play of the bottom of the first that led to an unearned run and a 1-0 lead for the Chiefs

SHORT DAY ON THE BENCH: Wisconsin manager Joe Ayrault was ejected in the bottom of the first inning after an RBI double by Jacob Buchberger, the third batter of the inning for the Chiefs. Buchberger hit a ball down the first base line that was ruled fair by plate umpire Ken Jackson. The ejection was the first of the season for a member of the Timber Rattlers.

BUSY DAY BEHIND THE PLATE: Peoria attempted seven stolen bases yesterday. Wisconsin catcher Wes Clarke threw out three would-be thieves for the Chiefs in the game.

A SPELL OF WILDNESS: Peoria had a 1-0 lead with two outs and none on base after Clarke caught Carlos Soto trying to steal second in the fourth inning. The next four Chiefs walked with Masyn Winn drawing a bases-loaded walk to make the score 2-0. Wisconsin pitchers walked seven Chiefs in Wednesday's game.

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER: Sal Frelick was 3-for-4 for the Rattlers on Wednesday. He had two singles and a home run. The homer was a solo shot in the top of the sixth inning that got the Rattlers on the scoreboard to make the score 2-1. Frelick has two homers this

PETERS PRINCIPLE: Tristan Peters tied the game 2-2 with an RBI single in the top of the eighth inning. The singled extended his current hitting streak to eight games for the longest streak on the team this season. Peters is 10-for-27 (.370) during his streak.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1957 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1956 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1983. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1984 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his first year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to Springfield from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first time with Peoria. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts eight Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Sal Frelick (#1), Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodríguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). MLB Pipeline has six current Chiefs2 on their list of Cardinals prospects – four active and two on the injured list: Maysin Winn (#5), Michael McGreevy (#8), Austin Love (#21), and Gordon Graceffo (#23) are on the active list. Ian Bedell (#22) and Jhon Torres (#24) are on the Peoria Injured List.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP BRANDON KNARR: The Brewers signed Knarr as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Tampa on July 17, 2020.

GOLDEN DOME: Knarr pitched at Notre Dame as a freshman and appeared in twelve games.

TO FLORIDA: Knarr spent his sophomore season at the College of Central Florida. He was 6-1 with 86 strikeouts and an ERA of 4.66 over 65-2/3 innings in sixteen games – thirteen starts.

TAMPA, TOO: Knarr transferred to the University of Tampa for the 2019-2020 season and was 4-1 with 64 strikeouts and a 2.55 ERA over 35-1/3 innings pitched in six starts before the shutdown.

IN THE MUD: Knarr started the 2021 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 7-2 with 103 strikeouts over 75 innings and an ERA of 3.84 in sixteen games – thirteen starts – before his promotion to Wisconsin on August 17.

LAST START: Knarr was the winning pitcher in game two of a home doubleheader against the Quad Cities River Bandits on April 23. He allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings. Both runs allowed were on solo homers.

VS. PEORIA (2022): Knarr allowed one run on two hits with three walks and five strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings in the <u>first game of a doubleheader against the Chiefs at home on April 10</u>. The Rattlers lost 1-0 and Knarr was charged with the loss

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP DIONYS RODRÍGUEZ: The Cardinals signed Rodríguez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic in 2018.

AND TO THE REPUBLIC: Rodríguez pitched of the Dominican Summer League affiliate of the Cardinals in 2018 and 2019. He was 4-0 with two saves despite a 7.40 ERA in nineteen relief appearances in 2018 between the Cardinals Red and the Cardinals Blue affiliates. In 2019, Rodríguez was 2-1 with two saves and a 5.88 ERA in seventeen relief appearances. Rodríguez walked 51 and struck out 58 in 50-1/3 innings pitched in those two seasons.

WILD PALMS: Rodríguez pitched for Palm Beach in 2021made seven starts after signing with the Cardinals. He made 22 appearances – twelve starts – for the Cardinals last season in the Low-A Southeast and was 4-5 with 22 walks, 88 strikeouts, and a 3.36 ERA in 69-2/3 innings pitched.

RATING BY THE BOOK: Baseball America ranks Rodríguez as the #21 prospect in the St. Louis system.

LAST START: Rodríguez had a <u>no decision at Cedar Rapids on April 22</u>. He allowed two runs on three hits with three walks and five strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2022): Rodríguez had a no decision at Wisconsin in game two of a doubleheader on April 10. He allowed a hit, walked five, and struck out four over three innings in that game.
