CIRCLE CITY ROUNDUP

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Harold Castro scored on a wild pitch by Eddy Yean to give the Omaha Storm Chasers a 7-6 win over the Indianapolis Indians in 10 innings on Tuesday night at Victory Field. With Castro starting the 10th inning as the automatic runner at second base, Peyton Wilson grounded out to first base to move Castro over to third with one out. Yean threw a wild pitch in the following at-bat to plate the Storm Chasers their final run. Omaha posted the first two runs of the game. Castro hit a solo homer in the second inning and Tyler Gentry doubled home a run for a 2-0 Omaha advantage. The Indians got on the board via back-to-back bunt singles from Tsung-Che Cheng and Ronny Simon. Dallas Keuchel fielded Simon's bunt and threw it past first base as the ball rolled to the opposing dugout, allowing Cheng to score. Indy grabbed the lead with a two-out rally in the fourth inning. Omaha knotted the game in the fifth inning with an RBI groundout from Gentry. It subsequently took the lead, 4-3, in the sixth on another RBI grounder, this time from MJ Melendez. Indianapolis mounted another comeback in the bottom of the sixth, capped by Matt Fraizer's go-ahead, two-run single. Melendez later hit a go-ahead, two-run double in the eighth inning for a 6-5 Omaha lead. Indy tied things in the bottom of the 9th when Devaney was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded to force extra innings.

SUPER SIMON: Ronny Simon (2-for-4, BB, SB, CS) extended his hitting streak to a season-high nine games last night, which is tied for the fourth-longest active run in the International League. Since his streak began on July 26, he is batting .375 (15-for-40) with four runs, two doubles, one home run, eight RBI, four walks, six strikeouts, three stolen bases and a .932 OPS. He has multi-hit performances in five of those nine games. It was his 14th multi-hit contest with Indy this season. He has reached base safely in 42 of 46 games with the club and hit safely in 36 of those. Simon tallied five RBI on Sunday at Iowa, doing so for the first time since May 12, 2022, with High-A Bowling Green vs. Jersey Shore.

LATE NIGHT WITH BUBBA CHANDLER: Bubba Chandler did not factor into the decision in last night's series opener, tossing 4.2 innings of three-run ball. He allowed a season-high tying eight hits (also July 18 @ NAS) with one walk and seven strikeouts. His 113 punchouts on the season lead all Triple-A pitchers. In eight night starts at Victory Field this season, Chandler is 3-0 with a 1.56 ERA (7er/40.1ip) and 54 strikeouts. MLB Pipeline's No. 5 overall prospect and Pittsburgh's No. 2 has thrown 43 pitches at 100.0-plus mph this season, topping out at 101.7 on June 11 vs. St. Paul.

RIDICULOUS-NICK: Nick Solak (0-for-3, 2 BB) extended his on-base streak to 38 games last night with a pair of walks, the longest on-base run by an International League player this season, and the longest by an Indians player since Chris Richard's 46-game streak from May 13-July 6, 2006. Additionally, it is the fourth Indianapolis on-base streak of 38-plus games since at least 2005, joining Ty Wigington (41G, 6/24-8/8, 2005), Ronny Paulino (42G, 6/6-7/27, 2005) and Richard. During his streak, Solak ranks among qualified IL hitters in batting average (4th, .345), hits (4th, 51) and on-base percentage (5th, .434), while racking up eight doubles, four homers, 24 RBI, 19 walks to 16 strikeouts and a .914 OPS. On the season, Solak leads the IL in batting average, on-base percentage and is tied for second in OPS.

HE GETS ON (BAE)SE: Ji Hwan Bae (1-for-5) extended his on-base streak to 13 games since July 18 and extended his hitting streak to seven games. In this span, he is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with a .919 OPS and ranks among the International League in triples (T-1st, 2), stolen bases (2nd, 8), walks (T-4th, 12) and on-base percentage (5th, .475). Bae has reached base safely in 23 of 26 games played since returning from the 7-day IL on June 27 and in 45 of his 50 games on the campaign overall.

CHA CHENG: Tsung-Che Cheng reached base safely all five times in Sunday afternoon's contest at Iowa, doing so for the first time since Sept. 3, 2021 with FCL Pirates Gold at FCL Pirates Black (1 H, 4 BB). Since returning from the injured list on July 1, Cheng is hitting .260 (19-for-73) with 12 runs, five doubles, two triples, one home run, 16 RBI, 8 walks, two stolen bases and a .758 OPS. He has hit safely in 16 of 22 and reached safely in 18 of those 22 in this span. Additionally, he has driven in one-plus run in 11 of those 22.

TODAY'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's six-game series with the Omaha Storm Chasers on Wednesday afternoon at 1:35 PM. RHP Drake Fellows takes the mound the Indians, set to make his 25th appearance and 11th start of the season. Since entering the Indians rotation on June 7, Fellows is 2-3 with a 4.46 ERA (19er/38.1ip). In four career games (two starts) against Omaha, he is 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA (7er/11.2ip). In his most recent start against the Storm Chasers on June 25 at Victory Field, he tossed 3.2 scoreless innings with four strikeouts. Opposite Fellows is RHP John Gant. In Gant's lone start against Indy this season, he allowed a season-high seven runs (six earned) in 1.2 innings. It was his lone career appearance against the club.

FELLOWS POSTS ZEROES: Drake Fellows owns the longest scoreless streak by an Indians pitcher this season, tossing 15.0 scoreless frames across four starts from July 12-31.

ON THIS DATE IN 1988: Randy Johnson had just 15 Triple-A starts under his belt when he took the mound for the Indians at Nashville during a playoff push. Johnson and Pat Pacillo tossed the last no-hitter in the Bush Stadium era when they threw a combined 8.0 hitless innings. Johnson was tagged for the loss as he gave up the game's only earned run in the first inning, despite not giving up a hit. The future Hall of Famer tossed 7.0 innings, issued two walks and struck out eight.

Drake Fellows: He will be making his 11th start of the season and his 31st career start compared to 34 career relief appearances.

Last Outing: Fellows took the loss on July 31 at Iowa, allowing three earned runs across 4.0 innings with four strikeouts.

Against the Storm Chasers: In four career games (two starts) against Omaha, he is 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA (7er/11.2ip). In his most recent start against the Storm Chasers on June 25 at Victory Field, he tossed 3.2 scoreless innings with four strikeouts.

Fellows Posts Zeroes: Fellows owns the longest scoreless streak by an Indians pitcher this season, tossing 15.0 scoreless frames across four starts from July 12-31.

May Flowers: Fellows was named the Indians May Player of the Month earlier this season. In six appearances, he ranked sixth among Triple-A pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched in ERA (1.15, 2er/15.2ip) and 11th in WHIP (0.96). He was the first Indians reliever to earn the award since Hunter Stratton in Aug. 2023.

Fab Five: Fellows picked up a win in a career and team-high five straight decisions from April 20-May 31. He pitched to a 2.08 ERA (5er/21.2ip) with 25 strikeouts in nine appearances across that stretch.

Miscellaneous: Selected by San Diego in the sixth round (173rd overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt (Nashville, Tenn.) University... Acquired by Pittsburgh from San Diego on Jan. 19, 2021 with RHP David Bednar, OF Hudson Head and LHP Omar Cruz in exchange for RHP Joe Musgrove; New York (NL) recieved LHP Joey Lucchesi from San Diego and sent C Endy Rodriguez to Pittsburgh.
