## ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 3-2 at ABC Supply Stadium.](https://www.wisconsinradio.com/)

Wisconsin broke a 1-1 tie with a two-run double by Eduarqui Fernández in the top of the fifth inning. The Sky Carp loaded the bases in the bottom of the eighth and scored a run to cut Wisconsin's advantage to one run. In the ninth, Mark Coley tripled with two outs but was left stranded as the Rattlers held on for the win. Aaron Rund got the final five outs for his fifth save.

**HALL OF PAIN:** Tayden Hall gave Wisconsin a 1-0 lead with a homer in the top of the third inning for Wisconsin's first hit off Beloit starting pitcher Emmett Olson. Hall also singled after Jesús Chirinos walked in the fifth inning. Both Hall and Chirinos scored on the double by Fernández.

**EIGHT IS GREAT:** Wisconsin starting pitcher Tate Kuehner had eight strikeouts in four innings and allowed one run last night. Kuehner matched his single-game high as a pro for strikeouts with his performance last night. He also struck out eight two other games this season: at South Bend on May 22 and at home against Quad Cities on June 5.

**END OF THE LINE FOR WISCONSIN:** Wisconsin did not steal a base last night. That stopped a streak of thirteen consecutive games with at least one stolen base by a Rattler base runner. Wisconsin had 33 stolen bases during the streak. The Dayton Dragons and Quad Cities River Bandits also had 13-game stolen base streaks this season.

**MAKING A RUN:** The Timber Rattlers have 194 stolen bases this season. Wisconsin needs to average 1.41 stolen bases per game over the final 37 games of this season to set a new club record.

**ABOUT BELOIT:** The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his second season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, and Mitch Stetter played in Beloit.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP WILL RUDY:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Rudy in the fifth round of the 2022 draft out of the California Polytechnic State University, Pomona.

**WHAT A SEASON:** Rudy was at Cal Poly Pomona for three seasons but had just one full season due to COVID-19 abbreviating 2020 and canceling the 2021 season for the Broncos. In 2022, which was still his freshman season, Rudy went 8-1 with a 3.10 ERA over thirteen starts. He walked fifteen and struck out 96 in 87 innings pitched during that season.

**TROPHY ROOM:** Rudy was a three-time Pitcher of the Week in the California Collegiate Athletic Association, two-time National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association West Region Pitcher of the Week, a First Team All-CCAA selection, and the CCAA's Most Valuable pitcher last season.

**OUR OLD FRIEND FROM POMONA:** Rudy was the highest draft selection of a Poly Pomona player since Cody Ponce was picked 55<sup>th</sup> overall in the 2015 draft. The Brewers also picked Ponce, who pitched for the Timber Rattlers right after the 2015 draft.

**THE CAPE:** Rudy made one start for Yarmouth-Dennis in the Cape Cod League in 2022 before the draft. He did not pitch in the Brewers system until 2023.

**THE MUDCAT:** Rudy was 5-3 in eighteen starts for Carolina in 2023 for his professional debut. Rudy had a 3.46 ERA, 26 walks, and 69 strikeouts over 80-2/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Rudy had a no decision at Cedar Rapids on [July 21](#). He allowed two runs on five hits with three walks and six strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings. The only two runs the Kernels scored were on two-out, solo homers by Rubel Cespedes.

**VS. БЕЛОИТ:** Rudy is 0-2 in two home starts against Beloit – [May 16](#) and on [July 5](#). He has allowed ten runs on ten hits with a walk and eight strikeouts. Beloit has hit four homers in 10-1/3 innings against Rudy this season.

## БЕЛОИТ SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ALEX WILLIAMS:** The Marlins selected Williams in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Stanford.

**THE CARDINAL:** Williams pitched four seasons at Stanford and was 23-8 with a 2.88 ERA in 47 games – 42 starts. He had 211 strikeouts in 237-2/3 innings pitched during his college career.

**TROPHY CASE:** Williams was the Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a First Team All-American for Collegiate Baseball and College Baseball Foundation after he went 8-4 with a 3.20 ERA in eighteen starts in helping Stanford win the Pac-12 regular season and tournament championships. Williams had 96 strikeouts over 101-1/3 innings pitched as a senior at Stanford.

**AT THE COMPLEX:** Williams signed with Miami and made two brief starts in for the Florida Complex Marlins without a decision in 2022. In five innings, he didn't allow a hit, a walk, or a run while striking out five.

**LAST SEASON:** Williams made 21 starts for the Sky Carp in 2023. He was 2-8 with a 5.06 ERA. He walked 35 and struck out 107 over 99-2/3 innings pitched.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Williams allowed an unearned run over 1-2/3 innings as a reliever against the Timber Rattlers on [July 24](#). He hit a batter, struck out a batter, and was not involved in the decision.

**LAST START:** Williams had a no decision against Cedar Rapids at home on [July 12](#). He allowed one hit and walked none with four strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN (2024):** Williams is 0-1 in three games – one start – against the Rattlers this season. He has allowed seven runs – five earned – on seven hits and five walks with three strikeouts over 9-1/3 innings.
