### LAST ACTION: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Dayton Dragons 9-8 at Day Air Ballpark.](#)

The Rattlers trailed 8-6 heading into the top of the ninth inning but scored three times to take the lead. Tanner Shears pitched a scoreless ninth inning for his fourth save of the season. Each Rattler in the batting order had at least one hit as the team collected a season-high eighteen hits in the game. Wisconsin went 7-for-21 with runners in scoring position. Six Rattlers pitchers walked nine and struck out nine in the game.

**RIDE MY SEESAW:** Wisconsin trailed 3-0, took a 5-3 lead with five runs in the fourth inning, trailed 6-5, tied the game 6-6 with a run in the sixth inning, and fell behind 8-6 after the Dragons scored twice in the bottom of the sixth before their rally in the ninth.

**ANATOMY OF RALLY:** Darrien Miller hit a solo homer with one out in the top of the ninth. Je'Von Ward followed with a double. Jose Acosta doubled to knock in Ward with the tying run. Robert Moore put the Rattlers in front with an RBI single.

**IN BUNCHES:** The Timber Rattlers had five straight batters reach base with two singles, a walk, and two singles in the fourth inning. Wisconsin had five straight hitters reach base in the ninth with the aforementioned hits followed by a walk to Matt Wood.

**FOUR!** Ward went 4-for-5 with two doubles, three runs scored, and an RBI for the Rattlers last night.

**BIG GAME BOB:** Moore had three hits and three RBI on Tuesday night. He has five three-hit games and four three-RBI games this season. Moore has twelve multi-RBI games and 43 RBI for the season.

**COME ON BACK, YA HEAR!** Last night was the second time Wisconsin has rallied to win a game when trailing after eight innings. Wisconsin's other ninth-inning comeback this season was at Great Lakes on [June 16](#).

**RUBY TUESDAY:** Wisconsin has won seven straight games played on a Tuesday. The Rattlers are 8-5 on Tuesdays this season.

**ABOUT DAYTON:** The Dayton Dragons entered the Midwest League when the Rockford Reds moved to Ohio for the 2000 season. Dayton has been an affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds since 2000. Joey Votto, Johnny Cueto, Adam Dunn, Homer Bailey, Didi Gregorius, Nick Senzel, and Elly De La Cruz are just a few MLB players to play for the Dragons. The Dragons finished the first half 33-33 and missed the playoffs. Bryan LaHair is in his second season as the manager of the Dragons. LaHair appeared in 67 games with the Timber Rattlers during the 2004 season. He hit .279 with 24 doubles, five homers, and 28 RBI.

**ABOUT THE REDS:** The Cincinnati Reds have been the Major League parent club for the Reds since 2000. The Reds had two MWL affiliates in 1999 (Rockford and Clinton) and 2000 (Dayton and Clinton). Cincinnati's first Midwest League affiliate was the Cedar Rapids Red Raiders in 1963 and 1964. The Reds left the Midwest League in 1964 before returning to Cedar Rapids in 1980 where they stayed until the end of the 1992 season. The Reds left the MWL for four seasons before returning to partner with the Burlington Bees in 1997 for two seasons before the partnership with Clinton and Rockford started.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), Eduardo Garcia (#19), and Matthew Wood (#24). Eric Brown Jr (#6) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has five Dayton players on their list of Top 30 Reds prospects: Edwin Arroyo (#2), Chase Petty (#6), Jay Allen II (#9), Austin Hendrick (#18), and Tyler Callihan (#27).

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP CAMERON WAGONER:** Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Michigan University.

**EASTERN NOTES:** Wagoner did not pitch collegiately in 2022. He made six relief appearances during the abbreviated 2020 season and 18 appearances – three starts – in 2021. He was 2-4 with a 4.42 ERA and 67 strikeouts over 57 innings during his two college seasons.

**HOW DID YOU SPEND YOUR SUMMERS?** Wagoner played for Greeneville in the Appalachian League in 2021 and was with both Wareham and Cotuit in the Cape Cod League in 2022. He was 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA in nineteen games – two starts – and 57 strikeouts over 38 innings pitched in those summer leagues.

**AS A PRO:** Wagoner made four appearances – two starts – for the ACL Brewers Gold after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-0 and had eight strikeouts in eight innings in the ACL.

**DOWN UNDER:** Wagoner pitched for the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League during the Winter of 2022-23. He made ten starts during the regular season of the ABL and was 3-1 with a 3.26 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 47 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Wagoner lost to Beloit at home on [July 8](#). He allowed three runs on eight hits with two walks, a hit batsman, and three strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. DAYTON:** Wagoner has never faced the Dragons prior to this evening. He has made one appearance against the ACL Reds in 2022, a start at Goodyear on [August 11](#). Wagoner pitched two scoreless, hitless innings with no walks and a strikeout for a no decision against the Reds in that game.

## DAYTON SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP CHRIS MCELVAIN:** The Cincinnati Reds selected McElvain in the eighth round of the 2022 draft out of Vanderbilt.

**VANDY:** McElvain pitched three seasons at Vanderbilt, including the shortened 2020 season. He was 11-6 with two saves and a 4.33ERA in 44 games – seventeen starts – and recorded 165 strikeouts over 141-1/3 innings pitched during his college career. In his final season at Vanderbilt, McElvain was 6-5 in sixteen starts with 100 strikeouts and 44 walks in 86-1/3 innings and an ERA of 4.27.

**TAKE SOME TIME:** McElvain did not pitch professionally in 2022 after signing with the Reds.

**FLORIDA MAN:** McElvain started the 2023 season with the Daytona Tortugas in the Florida State League. He was 3-3 with a 3.04ERA in twelve games – eight starts. McElvain had 53 strikeouts and nineteen walks over 50-1/3 innings before his promotion to Dayton on June 20.

**STRONG DEBUT:** McElvain made his Dayton debut on [June 23](#) and allowed a run over four innings against Lake County. He followed that up with a game at West Michigan on [June 30](#) where he allowed one hit over five scoreless innings.

**LAST START:** McElvain had a no decision against Great Lakes at home on [July 7](#). He allowed five runs – four earned – on four hits with six walks and four strikeouts over three innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** McElvain has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
