ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1983 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1984. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his first year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: <u>MLB Pipeline</u> places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#8), Robert Moore (#10), Hendry Mendez (#16), Eduardo García (#22), and Joseph Hernandez (#29). <u>MLB Pipeline</u> has seven active Peoria players on their list of Cardinals prospects: Tink Hence (#3), Cooper Hjerpe (#7), Jimmy Crooks (#16), Austin Love (#20), lan Bedell (#25), Dionys Rodriguez (#27), and Victor Scott II (#28). Dionys Rodriguez (#27) is on Peoria's IL.

## PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYLER WOESSNER: Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Arizona College.

WHAT A SEASON: Woessner went 11-2 with a 3.55 ERA in nineteen games – eighteen starts – during his final season at CAC. He walked 34 and struck out 122 in 96-1/3 innings pitched for the Vaqueros.

PITCHING INTO THE FINALS: Central Arizona College advanced to the 2022 NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado. Woessner was the winning pitcher in the game that got CAC into the Championship game as he allowed three runs and struck out eight over seven innings in the Vaqueros' 7-4 win over Walters State Community College on June 3. 2022. Central Arizona College won the National Title the next day with a 4-2 win over Cowley County Community College

**NORTH TO ALASKA:** Woessner pitched in three games – one start – for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League in 2021. He had no record, walked three, and struck out four over seven innings.

FIRST YEAR AS A BREWER: Woessner started his pro career with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and made three appearances – two starts – with eleven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Woessner also made one start for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 Carolina League season.

**LAST START:** Woessner had a no decision at Kannapolis on <u>August 26.</u> 2022. He allowed a run on two hits and two walks with two strikeouts over 1-2/3 innings.

VS. PEORIA: Woessner has never faced Peoria prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals.

#### PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TRENT BAKER: Drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the ninth round of the 2021 draft out of Angelo State University.

**ANGELO:** Baker pitched four seasons at Angelo State, an NCAA Division II school in San Angelo, Texas. He was 31-7 with a 2.69 ERA and 148 strikeouts over 131 innings pitched in 52 games – 47 starts.

**SENOIR SEASON:** Baker went 13-1 with a 2.11ERA in seventeen starts during his final season at Angelo State. He had 120 strikeouts over 106-2/3 innings pitched, was named the Lone Star Conference Pitcher of the Year, and helped the Rams advance to the 2021 NCAA Division II College World Series. He pitched twice during that College World Series, but had a no decision in both starts.

**SUMMER WORK:** Baker pitched for three different summer wood bat leagues during his college career: Newark of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League (2018), Mankato of the Northwoods League (2019), and Round Rock of the Texas Collegiate League (2020).

GOING PRO: Baker made eight relief appearances without a decision in the Florida Complex League affiliate of the Cardinals in 2021 after signing with St. Louis. In 2022, Baker made 25 starts for Palm Beach in the Florida State League and was 9-7 with a 3.14ERA and 138 strikeouts over 123-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Baker had a <u>no decision at Dunedin on September 6.</u>
2022. He allowed three runs on nine hits and a walk with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

**VS. WISCONSIN**: Baker has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
