**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Friday's game between the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers and South Bend Cubs was rained out. This was the second Wisconsin home game rained out this season. Wisconsin also had a game at South Bend rained out on April 11.

**LAST ACTION:** [Wisconsin beat the Cubs 3-2 on Thursday at Neuroscience Group Field](#). Wisconsin grabbed a 3-2 lead with two runs in the seventh. Eduarqui Fernández drove in the tying run with a single. Gregory Barrios knocked in Fernández with a sacrifice fly for the lead. K.C. Hunt allowed one run on four hits with five strikeouts over five innings for a no decision as the starting pitcher for the Rattlers.

**CALIENTE:** Eduardo Garcia went 3-for-4 on Wednesday. He is 11-for-26 (.423) in his six games with the Timber Rattlers. He is on a six-game hitting streak and has three multi-hit games with Wisconsin.

**HOLD THE LINE:** Aaron Rund pitched a perfect eighth inning with a strikeout for his fifth hold of the season. Rund is tied with teammate Chase Costello for the second-most holds in the Midwest League. Rund has allowed two runs on six hits with twelve strikeouts over 12-2/3 innings over seven relief appearances in June.

**COFFEE IS FOR CLOSERS:** Yerlin Rodriguez pitched around a lead-off single in the top of the ninth to earn his sixth save of the season.

**THIS ONE GOES TO ELEVEN:** Jadhre Areinamo was 1-for-3 with a walk and stolen base for the Rattlers on Wednesday. Areinamo's hitting streak is up to eleven games. He is 17-for-43 (.395) during this streak, the longest by a Wisconsin hitter this season.

**CLOSE GAMES:** Wisconsin is 12-11 in one-run games this season. In the second half, the Rattlers are 1-3 in one-run games.

**COMEBACK TRAIL:** The Timber Rattlers picked up their twentieth comeback win of the season with Wednesday's win. The 2023 Rattlers had 27 comeback wins over the entire season.

**ABOUT SOUTH BEND:** The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his first year as South Bend's manager.

**ABOUT THE CUBS:** The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

**WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER GAME ONE:**

**RHP WILL RUDY:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Rudy in the fifth round of the 2022 draft out of the California Polytechnic State University, Pomona.

**WHAT A SEASON:** Rudy was at Cal Poly Pomona for three seasons but had just one full season due to COVID-19 abbreviating 2020 and canceling the 2021 season for the Broncos. In 2022, which was still his freshman season, Rudy went 8-1 with a 3.10 ERA over thirteen starts. He walked fifteen and struck out 96 in 87 innings pitched during that season.

**TROPHY ROOM:** Rudy was a three-time Pitcher of the Week in the California Collegiate Athletic Association, two-time National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association West Region Pitcher of the Week, a First Team All-CCAA selection, and the CCAA's Most Valuable pitcher last season.

**OUR OLD FRIEND FROM POMONA:** Rudy was the highest draft selection of a Poly Pomona player since Cody Ponce was picked 55<sup>th</sup> overall in the 2015 draft. The Brewers also picked Ponce, who pitched for the Timber Rattlers right after the 2015 draft.

**THE CAPE:** Rudy made one start for Yarmouth-Dennis in the Cape Cod League in 2022 before the draft. He did not pitch in the Brewers system until 2023.

**THE MUDCAT:** Rudy was 5-3 in eighteen starts for Carolina in 2023 for his professional debut. Rudy had a 3.46 ERA, 26 walks, and 69 strikeouts over 80-2/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Rudy had a no decision at Fort Wayne on [June 21](#). He allowed three runs on five hits with two walks and six strikeouts over six innings.

**VS. SOUTH BEND:** Rudy has made two starts against South Bend this season. He is 0-1 with a 1.86 ERA against the Cubs this season. Rudy has allowed two runs on seven hits with two walks and nine strikeouts over 9-2/3 innings.

**WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:**

**RHP YUJANYER HERRERA:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Herrera as an International Free Agent on August 17, 2019 out of Venezuela.

**STARTING IN ARIZONA:** Herrera made his professional debut in the Arizona Complex League in 2021 as he pitched for Milwaukee's Blue and Gold affiliates. He was 3-3 with a 9.00 ERA in eleven games – four starts – in 2021. Herrera walked 38 and struck out 37 over 35 innings. He also began the 2022 season in Arizona with a 2-3 record and a 5.36 ERA in eleven games – eight starts – before a move to Carolina in August of that year.

**TIME IN CAROLINA:** Herrera pitched for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 season, the entire 2023 season, and the start of this season. He was 8-5 with a save and a 4.54 ERA in 30 games – thirteen starts – with 66 walks and 101 strikeouts over 111 innings pitched for the Mudcats.

**PROMOTION TIME:** Herrera made four relief appearances for the Mudcats in 2024 and was 3-0 with a 2.12 ERA. He walked six and struck out 27 in seventeen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on April 30.

**LAST START:** Herrera won at Fort Wayne on [June 22](#). He allowed a run on four hits with three walks and three strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. SOUTH BEND:** Herrera lost to the Cubs at South Bend on [May 25](#). He allowed nine runs – seven earned – on nine hits with a hit batsman and two strikeouts over three innings.

**SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER GAME ONE:**

**LHP DREW GRAY:** The Chicago Cubs selected Gray in the 3<sup>rd</sup> round of the 2021 draft out of IMG Academy in Bradenton, Florida.

**START & STOP START:** Gray was the top prep prospect in Illinois in 2020 before transferring to IMG Academy for his senior season. Gray signed after the Cubs picked him, but and made his pro debut in the ACL in 2021 before injuring his elbow in February of 2022. The injury led to Tommy John Surgery. He did not pitch again until 2023.

**HARD RESET:** Gray got back on the mound with a start against the ACL Padres on June 6, 2023. He made three brief starts in the ACL before a promotion to Myrtle Beach in the Carolina League.

**WORKING ON THE BEACH:** Gray was 0-3 with a 4.23 ERA in eleven starts for the Pelicans in the Carolina League. Gray walked 23 and struck out 45 over 27-2/3 innings at Myrtle Beach in 2023.

**HOW DOES HE RATE?** MLB Pipeline puts Gray as the #10 prospect in the Cubs system. *Baseball America* places Gray as the #18 prospect in the Cubs system.

**LAST START:** Gray had a no decision against Lake County at home on [June 21](#). He allowed two runs on one hit with five walks and three strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Gray is 0-1 with a 2.57 ERA in two starts against Wisconsin this season. He has allowed two runs on four hits with six walks and six strikeouts over seven innings versus the Timber Rattlers.

**SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:**

**RHP WILL SANDERS:** The Chicago Cubs selected Sanders in the 4<sup>th</sup> round of the 2023 draft out of the University of South Carolina.

**HEAD START:** Sanders pitched for Lexington County in the Coastal Plain League in 2020 before he ever pitched an inning at South Carolina. He was 2-1 with a 7.29 ERA in nine games – two starts. Sanders walked ten and struck out 22 over 21 innings pitched.

**HE WAS GAME:** Sanders pitched three seasons for the Gamecocks from 2021 through 2023. In 51 appearances – 36 starts – Sanders was 17-10 with a 4.08 ERA. Sanders had 222 strikeouts and 68 walks in 205-1/3 innings pitched at South Carolina.

**SIGNING DAY:** Sanders signed his contract with Chicago on July 19, 2023. He did not pitch in a professional game after joining the Cubs organization. Tonight is his pro debut.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Sanders took the loss in relief at the University of Florida in Game One of the NCAA Super Regional on [June 9, 2023](#). Sanders allowed two runs on three hits with a walk and three strikeouts over 2-1/3 innings pitched. The Gators won the game 5-4.

**LAST START:** Sanders had a no decision against Lake County at home on [June 23](#). He allowed two runs – one earned – on four hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Sanders is 1-0 in two starts against the Timber Rattlers this season. He has allowed four runs – three earned – on six hits with three walks and six strikeouts over seven innings.
