ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 2-1 at ABC Supply Stadium.](#)

Wisconsin was held to three hits in the game. Beloit broke a 1-1 tie with an unearned run in the third and added an unearned run in the fourth. Sky Carp runners stole nine bases in the game last night. The rubber game of this three-game series is tonight.

GETTING EVEN: Beloit took a 1-0 lead on a lead-off homer by Gage Miller in the bottom of the second inning. The Rattlers tied the game in the top of the third as Yhoswar Garcia singled, stole second, moved to third on a grounder by Hedbert Pérez, and scored on a sacrifice fly by Jader Areinamo.

FALLING DOWN: Wisconsin starting pitcher Sam Garcia retired the first two batters he faced in the bottom of the third. Then, Jesús Hernandez blooped a double to right and Yiddi Cappe reached on an infield single with runners on the corners. Cappe stole second and the throw to second glanced off Cappe to allow Hernandez to score the go-ahead run.

RUNNING MEN: Beloit has 203 stolen bases this season. The only team in minor league baseball with more steals than the Sky Carp is the Lynchburg Hillcats, the Carolina League affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. Lynchburg has 210 steals this season. Beloit has the top four stolen base totals in a single game this season: 4/13 at Cedar Rapids (12), 4/9 at Cedar Rapids (10), 7/2 v. Wisconsin (10), 4/5 v. South Bend (8). Beloit is 32-for-36 in stolen base attempts in eight games against Wisconsin this season.

DRY SPELL: Juan Baez singled to lead off the top of the fourth inning for Wisconsin. He was erased on a force play. The Rattlers didn't have another hit for the rest of the game. The only base runners after that for the Rattlers were a two-out walk to Kay-Lan Nicasia in the seventh and a two-out walk to Baez in the ninth.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Bill Hall, Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Lillard, Mitch Stetter, and Matt Chapman played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5th round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON: Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

DELAYED START: Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

AS A RATTLER (2024): Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers

LAST START: Birchard had a no decision against Quad Cities at home on [June 27](#). He allowed a run on four hits with four walks and five strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

VS. БЕЛОИТ: Birchard had a no decision against Beloit at home on [May 17](#). He allowed two runs on three hits with four walks and seven strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.

БЕЛОИТ STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRANDON WHITE: The Miami Marlins selected White in the twelfth round of the 2021 draft out of Washington State University.

DODGING LA: The Los Angeles Dodgers picked White in the fourteenth round of the 2018 draft out of W. F. West High School in Chehalis, Washington. White elected to attend Washington State over signing with the Dodgers.

GO COUGARS: White pitched from 2019 through 2021 with Washington State and was 8-12 with a 5.69 ERA in 30 games – 29 starts with 119 strikeouts and 67 walks over 131-1/3 innings pitched in his career.

ALL PART OF THE JOURNEY: White was with the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaskan Summer League in 2019 and the St. Cloud Rox of the Northwoods League in 2020. White did not pitch professionally in 2021 and missed the 2022 season with an injury. He made his pro debut with the Marlins Florida Complex League affiliate and the Jupiter Hammerheads of the Florida State League in 2023. White pitched with Jupiter again in 2024 and was 6-5 with a 4.98 ERA in nineteen games – fifteen starts.

LAST START: White lost at Peoria on [June 26](#). He allowed ten runs on seven hits with four walks and four strikeouts over two innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: White pitched in relief in game two of a doubleheader at Neuroscience Group Field against Wisconsin on [May 16](#) and took the loss in a 1-0 game. He allowed two hits over two innings with no walks and two strikeouts. One of the hits he allowed was a walkoff-homer by Eduardo Garcia in the bottom of the seventh inning.
