SUNDAY AFTERNOON: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 5-3 at Neuroscience Group Field on Sunday. Jackson Chourio went 4-for-4 with a homer, two runs scored, and two RBI to lead the offense. Wisconsin broke a 2-2 tie with three runs in the bottom of the third inning and the bullpen combo of Christian Tripp, Taylor Floyd, and James Meeker combined for 5-2/3 scoreless innings to protect the lead. The victory gave the Rattlers the season series over the Cubs with a 10-8 record. Wisconsin owns the tiebreaker with the division leaders.

THE JACKSON FOUR: Chourio hit his fourth homer since joining the Timber Rattlers when he connected on a 3-0 pitch with Darrien Miller at first in the bottom of the first. He also singled three times for his second four-hit game since joining the Rattlers. Chourio has homered three times in his last five games.

FRUSTRATE THEM: South Bend stranded twelve runners and went 0-for-12 on Sunday.

HOW DO YOU SPELL RELIEF? The Wisconsin bullpen covered 30-2/3 innings in the six-game series with South Bend. The Rattler relievers allowed four runs - three earned - to help Wisconsin win four

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins – including 2022. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013. PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts five

active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Jeferson Quero (#6), Eduardo García (#14), Joe Gray Jr. (#15), and Taylor Floyd (#24). Tyler Black (#7), Russell Smith (#17), and Carlos Rodríguez (#22) are on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has two current Cedar Rapids players on their Top 30 list of Twins prospects: Alerick Soularie (#18) and David Festa (#25). Sean Mooney (#26) is on the Kernels

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN JARVIS: Selected by Milwaukee in the 5th round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

THE SENIOR SEASON: In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

A PERFECT DAY: Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school

NOT ON CAMPUS: Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

YEAR ONE: Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing with Milwaukee. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

2019: Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

2021: Jarvis was 1-7 with a 5.40 ERA in seventeen starts for the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He had 62 strikeouts over 63-1/3 innings.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Jarvis allowed one hit with two walks and eight strikeouts over six scoreless innings against Cedar Rapids on July 29 and was named the Midwest League pitcher of the week for his performance.

LAST START: Jarvis beat South Bend at home on August 10. He allowed two unearned runs on four hits with three walks and two strikeouts over six innings. Jarvis has nine quality starts this season.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2022): Jarvis is 3-0 in three starts against the Kernels this season. He has allowed one run on four hits with seven walks and 27 strikeouts over 17-2/3 innings versus Cedar Rapids in 2022. The only run Jarvis has allowed to the Kernels was a solo home run by Seth Gray on June 29.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ORLANDO RODRIGUEZ: The Minnesota Twins signed Rodriguez as a Minor League Free Agent on July 13, 2021.

NO DOUBTING THOMAS: Rodriguez pitched three seasons for St. Thomas University, an NAIA school in Miami Gardens, Florida. He was 25-3 with 238 strikeouts in 194 innings pitched over his final two seasons with the Bobcats.

INDEPENDENCE DAYS: Rodriguez made two starts for the Schaumberg Flyers in the independent Frontier League before he signed with the Cincinnati Reds on July 6, 2019. He went 0-3 in ten games – eight starts – with 49 strikeouts over 36-2/3 innings with Billings after signing with Cincinnati.

SET ADRIFT: The Reds released Rodriguez on June 1, 2020. He found a spot with the Sugar Land Lightning Sloths of the Constellation Energy League and was 1-3 with a 10.38 ERA in eleven games – five starts. Rodriguez went back to Schaumberg for the 2021 season and went 4-1 with a 2.44 ERA in eight starts. He signed with the Twins on July 13, 2021.

TWIN TIME: Rodriguez made one start in the Florida Complex League and appeared in four games with two starts for Fort Myers in the Florida State League after signing with Minnesota. He was 1-1 with a 4.15 ERA, seven walks, and 23 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings for Fort Myers.

LAST START: Rodriguez had a <u>no decision at Quad Cities on August 10</u>. He allowed three runs – one earned – on two hits, two walks, and four strikeouts over three innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Rodriguez has made five appearances – one start – against Wisconsin this season. He is 1-1 and has allowed four runs on eight hits with nine walks and six strikeouts over 8-1/3 innings.
