ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 9-5 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Quad Cities took a 3-0 lead in the top of the first and a 5-4 lead in the top of the second. Wisconsin rallied behind a three-run homer by Jesús Chirinos and solo homers by Jheremy Vargas and Ramón Rodríguez. Three Wisconsin relievers – Chase Costello, Brian Fitzpatrick, and Bayden Root – pitched 5-1/3 scoreless innings.

FAST STARTS: Wisconsin has outscored opponents 53-20 in the first inning this season.

HE GETS ON BASE: Dylan O'Rae went 0-for-3 but was hit by pitches twice last night to extend his current on base streak to sixteen games. Since the streak started on May 17, O'Rae is 16-for-53 (.302) with seventeen runs scored and thirteen walks for an on base percentage of .486.

BIG FLIES! Last night was the third time the Rattlers have hit three homers in a game this season. The last time Wisconsin had three homers in a game was on May 12 at Quad Cities. Rodríguez has hit all three of his homers against the River Bandits. Vargas has hit two of his three homers against Quad Cities.

THE RAMÓN: Rodríguez was 3-for-4 with a walk, a homer, two doubles, three runs scored and two RBI last night.

PUT IT IN PLAY: Wisconsin hitters struck out three times last night. They have struck out 355 times in 52 games for an average of 6.83/game.

TWO-OUT BINGO: Wisconsin scored seven of their nine runs last night with two outs.

STANDINGS CHECK: Wisconsin's lead in the West Division over the Cedar Rapids Royals remained at 1-½ games after both teams won on Monday.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP TATE KUEHNER: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Kuehner in the seventh round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Louisville.

MARSHALLING THE PAST: Kuehner played high school baseball in Marshalltown, Iowa. Former Timber Rattlers catcher Jeff Clement, the #3 pick in the 2005 draft, also played his high school baseball at Marshalltown.

CARDINAL RULE: Kuehner pitched four seasons with Louisville. He was 15-13 with nine saves and a 3.69 ERA over 70 appearances – fourteen starts – for the Cardinals. Kuehner had 193 strikeouts over 165-2/3 innings. During the 2022 NCAA Regionals in Louisville, Kuehner earned two saves and a win over seven innings in three scoreless appearances for the Cardinals.

COLLEGE SUMMER LEAGUES: Kuehner made five appearances for Waterloo in the Northwoods League in 2020 and four appearances for Danbury in the New England Collegiate Baseball League in 2021.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Kuehner made two appearances – one start – for the ACL Brewers in the regular season after signing with Milwaukee in 2023. He had no record with a walk and two strikeouts over three scoreless innings.

PLAYOFF CALL: Kuehner was the winning pitcher for the ACL Brewers in the ACL Semifinal Game against the ACL Rockies on [August 24, 2023](#). He allowed a hit over two scoreless innings with no walks and two strikeouts. The Brewers won the game to advance to the ACL Championship Series.

LAST START: Kuehner had a no decision against Fort Wayne on [May 29](#) at home. He allowed two runs on five hits with four walks and four strikeouts over four innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Kuehner had a no decision at Quad Cities on [May 7](#). He allowed a run on a hit – a home run by Carson Roccaforte – with three walks and six strikeouts over four innings.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BEN KUDRNA: The Kansas City Royals selected Kudrna out of Blue Valley Southwest High School in Overland Park, Kansas in the second round of the 2021 draft. Kudrna was taken with the 43rd overall pick in the draft. MLB Pipeline rates Kudrna as the #3 prospect in Kansas City's system.

BYE-BYE TO THE BAYOU: Kudrna signed with the Royals over a commitment to Louisiana State University. made his professional debut in the Dominican Summer League in 2018. He was 2-4 with three saves and a 4.18 ERA. Noriega walked eight and struck out thirty over 32-1/3 innings.

GETTING STARTED: Kudrna did not pitch professionally in 2021. He made his professional debut with the Columbia Fireflies in the Carolina League in 2022. Kudrna was 2-5 with a 3.48 ERA in seventeen starts with 61 strikeouts over 72-1/3 innings pitched. Kudrna returned to Columbia to start the 2023 season and was 4-3 with a 3.56 ERA in fourteen games – thirteen starts. He walked 30 and struck out 70 in 68-1/3 innings with Columbia before his promotion to Quad Cities on July 12, 2023.

DOWN BY THE RIVER: Kudrna went 1-4 with a 5.36 ERA in eight starts for the River Bandits after his promotion. He walked fifteen and struck out 34 over 40-1/3 innings pitched in the Midwest League last season.

LAST START: Kudrna lost to South Bend at home on [May 29](#). He allowed seven runs on six hits with five walks and a strikeout. Kudrna gave up three home runs in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN (2024): Kudrna had a no decision at home against the Timber Rattlers on [May 8](#). He allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and four strikeouts over six innings.
