LAST ACTION: [The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 24-7 at Neuroscience Group Field on Thursday night.](#) Tai Peete hit for the cycle, Jesús Báez drove in six runs, and Miguel Villarroel added a grand slam to pace the 21-hit attack from the Chiefs. Wisconsin scored seven runs on eleven hits with Daniel Dickinson (3-for-5), Andrew Fischer (3RBI), and Braylon Payne (2-for-3, HR, two walks, and three runs scored) leading the way. Peoria scored in eight of the nine innings.

ONLY OTHER TIME THAT HAPPENED: The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 20-7 at Dozer Park (then known as O'Brien Field) on September 2, 2004. That was the only time before last night a Timber Rattler team gave up twenty runs in a game.

THE INNING: Peoria sent thirteen men to the plate in the top of the seventh and scored ten runs. The first five hitters reached without an out being recorded. There were two outs with a runner at first when two walks extended the inning. A single and an error on the play let all three of those runners score. Another walk was followed by a three-run home run by Peete.

THAT KIND OF NIGHT: Wisconsin had two runs in with the bases loaded and no outs in the bottom of the seventh. Eric Bitonti hit a hard grounder that was heading to right. However, the ball hit Josh Adamczewski, the runner at first. Bitonti was credited with a single, but the dead ball meant Adamczewski was out and the other runners had to return to their respective bases. Wisconsin did not score again in the inning.

STREAKING: Bitonti extended his on-base streak to eleven games with that single. He is 6-for-33 with twelve walks and a .400 OBP.

CALL OF DUTY: Infielder Juan Baez pitched the top of the ninth for Wisconsin. Peete completed his cycle with a triple off Baez in the ninth.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRYCE MECCAGE: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Meccage in the second round of the 2024 draft out of The Pennington School in New Jersey

FAMILY TIES: Meccage is the son of Jeremy Meccage, the former Pitching Coach at Princeton University and the nephew of Justin Meccage, current pitching coach of the San Francisco Giants.

GOING PRO: Meccage signed with Milwaukee over a college commitment to the University of Virginia.

PROSPECT WATCH: Meccage is rated as the #21 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* has placed him at #26 in their rankings of Brewers prospects.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Meccage made his professional debut with the Carolina Mudcats in 2025. He was 1-4 with a 4.35 ERA in nineteen starts. Meccage walked 26 and struck out 69 over 70-1/3 innings.

LAST START: Meccage had a no decision at Quad Cities on [April 10](#) he allowed a hit, walked three, and struck out three over four scoreless innings. The Timber Rattlers won the game 9-0.

VS. PEORIA: Meccage has never faced the Chiefs prior to this afternoon. He has never pitched against an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals before today.

PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BLAKE AITA: The St. Louis Cardinals acquired Aita in a trade with the Boston Red Sox on December 22, 2025. St. Louis sent Willson Contreras to Boston for Aita, Yhoiker Fajardo, and Hunter Dobbins.

ORIGIN STORY: Boston drafted Aita in the sixth round of the 2024 draft out of Kennesaw State University. He was 9-7 in 33 appearances – sixteen starts – in two seasons of college baseball. Aita had 122 strikeouts in 121-1/3 innings at Kennesaw State.

LAST YEAR: Aita made his professional debut with the Salem Red Sox of the Carolina League in 2025. He went 2-3 with a 4.24 ERA in ten games – nine starts – before a promotion to the Greenville Drive of the South Atlantic League on June 10, 2025. He went 3-4 with a 3.78 ERA for Greenville before the trade. Aita had 99 strikeouts in 115-1/3 innings in the Boston system last year.

LAST START: Aita had a no decision against South Bend at home on [April 11](#). He allowed three hits and three walks over 4-2/3 scoreless innings. Aita struck out nine in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Aita has never pitched against Wisconsin prior to today. Aita lost as a reliever to Carolina on [June 1, 2025](#). He walked one, struck out four, and gave up three solo homers in the game. The Mudcats to homer in the game were Eric Bitonti, Luis Peña, and Yannic Walther.
