PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP K.C. HUNT: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Hunt as a non-drafted free agent on July 20, 2023.

ORIGINALLY: Hunt was selected by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the twelfth round of the 2022 draft out of Mississippi State University. Hunt elected not to sign with the Pirates and returned to Mississippi State.

HAIL STATE: Hunt pitched four seasons with the Bulldogs. He went 4-6 with three saves in 53 appearances – three starts – at Mississippi State. Hunt had 102 strikeouts over 81 innings pitched in college.

HOT FUN IN THE SUMMERTIME: Hunt pitched for three teams in three leagues over four summers while in college. He was with Portland in the West Coast League in 2019, Falmouth of the Cape Cod League in 2021 and 2023, and Trenton of the MLB Draft League in 2022.

BEFORE WISCONSIN: Hunt made his pro debut with the ACL Brewers in 2023 with four relief appearances in the regular season and two relief stints during the 2023 ACL playoffs. Hunt made eight relief appearances with Carolina this season and was 3-0 with a save, a 2.48 ERA, 32 strikeouts, and four walks over nineteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 14, 2024.

SO, WHAT DOES K.C. STAND FOR? Kyle Clemente Hunt was named after Roberto Clemente, his father's favorite baseball player. Mickey Hunt is K.C.'s dad and was also his high school baseball coach at Ramapo (NJ) High.

LAST START: Hunt made his first professional start against the Quad Cities River Bandits on <u>June 6</u>. He allowed three hits, walked none, and struck out five over five scoreless innings to earn the win.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: Hunt has never pitched against the Whitecaps before tonight. This is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Detroit Tigers.

WEST MICHIGAN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP JOE MILLER: The Detroit Tigers selected Miller in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Pennsylvania.

THE PENN IS MIGHTIER: Miller pitched four seasons for the Quakers. He was 10-8 with a 4.49 ERA and 160 strikeouts over 132-1/3 innings in 33 games – 24 starts during his time at Penn.

FROM THE COAST TO THE CAPE: Miller pitched for Asheboro (2019) and Savannah (2021) in the Coastal Plain League and Chatham in the Cape Cod League (2022) over three summers. He was 9-5 with a 2.48 ERA in 21 games – eighteen starts – during his summer collegiate league play.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: In 2022, Miller made a brief relief appearance in the Florida Complex League and four brief starts for the Lakeland Flying Tigers in the Florida State League. He had no record and allowed seven earned runs over 10-1/3 innings with six walks and twelve strikeouts in his first pro season.

LAND OF THE LAKE: Miller spent 2023 with Lakeland and was 2-3 with a 3.93 ERA and 78 strikeouts over 68-2/3 innings in 18 games – twelve starts. Miller started the 2024 season with Lakeland and was 2-0 with three walks, 29 strikeouts, and an ERA of 1.23 in six games – four starts – before his promotion to West Michigan on May 14.

LAST START: Miller had a no decision at South Bend June 7. He allowed a run on four hits with a walk and two strikeouts over three innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Miller has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
