WEDNESDAY AT THE PARK: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 3-2 in ten innings Dozer Park. Jadher Areinamo had a two-out RBI single in the top of the tenth to break the 2-2 tie. Three Wisconsin pitchers - Mark Manfredi, Tate Kuehner, and Craig Yoho - combined for sixteen strikeouts. Wisconsin is now 7-2 in day games this season.

BIRTHDAY BOY: Luke Adams celebrated his birthday on Wednesday with an RBI single in the first and an RBI double in the third to put the Rattlers up 2-0. Adams turned twenty yesterday.

AFTER TWO THEY GO! All three Wisconsin runs vesterday were scored after two outs. The Rattlers are 25-for-82 (.305) with runners in scoring position and two outs this season

MAN, THAT WAS BEAUTIFUL: Manfredi allowed one run on four hits and struck out eight over five innings. He set a new single-game high for innings pitched as a pro and matched his single-game high for strikeouts as a pro. In his last two appearances, Manfredi has sixteen strikeouts in nine innings pitched.

CRAIG'S LIST: Yoho retired all six batters he faced yesterday with four strikeouts. He struck out the side in order in the ninth and got a strikeout to end the game. In 7-2/3 innings over seven appearances, Yoho has walked one and struck out fifteen. Yoho earned his first professional win with his two perfect innings yesterday.

PUTTING THE BALL IN PLAY: Wisconsin hitters struck out five times yesterday. Through seventeen games this season, the Rattlers offense has the fewest strikeouts in Minor League Baseball (119).

EIGHT YEARS TO THE DAY: Wisconsin's win yesterday was their first extra innings win at Dozer Park since April 24, 2016 when they won 5-1 in eleven innings with four runs in the top of the eleventh.

SMALL SAMPLE SIZE: Wednesday was only the fifth extra inning game played between the Rattlers and Peoria at Dozer Park since April 24, 2016.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#9), Luke Adams (#16), Dylan O'Rae (#21), Jadher Areinamo (#23), and Patricio Aquino (#29). MLB Pipeline has nine active Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Cooper Hjerpe (#6), Leonardo Bernal (#7), Won-Bin Cho (#9), Brycen Mautz (#20), Zach Levenson (#22), Pete Hansen (#26), Joshua Baez (#29), and William Sullivan (#30).

THE CHIEFS SO FAR: Peoria is 7-10 to start the season. The Chiefs avoided a six-game sweep at Quad Cities with a win on Sunday afternoon over the River Bandits at Modern Woodmen Park. Peoria's only home series prior to this one with Wisconsin was against Beloit from April 9 through April 14. The Chiefs were 4-2 in that series with the Sky Carp.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP WILL RUDY: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Rudy in the 5th round of the 2022 draft out of the California Polytechnic State University, Pomona.

WHAT A SEASON: Rudy was at Cal Poly Pomona for three seasons but had just one full season due to COVID-19 abbreviating 2020 and canceling the 2021 season for the Broncos. In 2022, which was still his freshman season, Rudy went 8-1 with a 3.10 ERA over thirteen starts. He walked fifteen and struck out 96 in 87 innings pitched during that season.

TROPHY ROOM: Rudy was a three-time Pitcher of the Week in the California Collegiate Athletic Association, two-time National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association West Region Pitcher of the Week, a First Team All-CCAA selection, and the CCAA's Most Valuable pitcher last season.

OUR OLD FRIEND FROM POMONA: Rudy was the highest draft selection of a Poly Pomona player since Cody Ponce was picked 55th overall in the 2015 draft. The Brewers also picked Ponce, who pitched for the Timber Rattlers right after the 2015 draft.

THE CAPE: Rudy made one start for Yarmouth-Dennis in the Cape Cod League in 2022 before the draft. He did not pitch in the Brewers system until 2023.

THE MUDCAT: Rudy was 5-3 in eighteen starts for Carolina in 2023 for his professional debut. Rudy had a 3.46 ERA, 26 walks, and 69 strikeouts over 80-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Rudy lost to Cedar Rapids at home on April 18. He allowed six runs on eight hits with two walks and three strikeouts.

VS. PEORIA: Rudy has never faced the Peoria Chiefs prior to this evening. This is the first time he will face an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP CONNOR HJERPE: The St. Louis Cardinals selected Hjerpe in the first round of the 2022 draft out of Oregon State University.

BUSY BEAVER: Hierpe went 11-2 with a 2.53 ERA in eighteen games – seventeen starts – during his final season at Oregon State. He walked 23 and struck out 161 over 103-1/3 innings with the Beavers.

HONOR ROLL: Hjerpe was named to four First-Team All-American Teams, First-Team All-Pac-12, Perfect Game's National Pitcher of the Year, a finalist for the Golden Spikes Award, a finalist for the Dick Howser Trophy, and a member of the Corvallis Regional All-Tournament team.

TO THE BRINK: Hjerpe's final start at Oregon State was a win over Auburn on <u>June 12, 2022 in Game Two</u> of the Super Regional to even the series at 1-1. Hjerpe allowed three runs on three hits with two walks and six strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings for the victory.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline places Hjerpe as the #6 prospect in the Cardinals organization. *Baseball America* puts him at #8 in the St. Louis System.

LAST SEASON: Hjerpe was 2-3 with a 3.51 ERA in ten games – eight starts – for the Chiefs in 2023, which was his first professional season. He walked 25 and struck out 51 in 41 innings pitched. He missed three months due to arthroscopic surgery on his pitching elbow last year. Hjerpe made it back to the Chiefs for the end of the season. He also pitched 8-1/3 innings over seven relief appearances in the Arizona Fall League for Scottsdale in 2023.

LAST START: Hierpe had a no decision at Quad Cities on April 18. He pitched four scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out seven.

VS. WISCONSIN: Hjerpe was 1-1 in two starts against the Timber Rattlers in 2023. He lost at Wisconsin on April 14 and won at Peoria on May 3. Hjerpe lasted just 2/3 of an inning on opening night of 2024 with a start at Wisconsin on April 5 as he allowed one run with no hits, a hit batsman, three walks, and two strikeouts.
