ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat 5-4 in eleven innings at Modern Woodmen Park.](#) Wisconsin broke a 1-1 tie with three runs in the top of the eleventh inning on an RBI double by Tayden Hall and a two-run double by Luis Castillo. However, the Bandits scored four runs in the bottom of the eleventh on an RBI single by Trevor Werner, a two-run triple by Callan Moss, and a two-out, RBI single by Omar Hernandez.

LOOKING GOOD: Wisconsin starting pitcher Chandler Welch retired the first twelve batters he faced. The first Quad Cities runner got on due to a misplayed fly to center that dropped in for a double. That runner would score later in the inning. Welch struck out seven over six innings, walked none, and allowed three hits for a no decision. He set professional single-game high for innings pitched and strikeouts.

STARTING STRONG: Through the first five games of this series Wisconsin pitchers have allowed four runs and struck out 27 with only seven walks in 25-1/3 innings.

KING OF TRIOS: Eduardo Garcia went 3-for-5 with a double and two runs scored last night for his first three-hit game of the season.

THEY GET ON BASE: Garcia and Matt Wood both extended their team-high on base streaks to six games last night.

AND HE....WALKED ON DOWN THE HALL:

Wisconsin took the lead in the fourth inning on an RBI double by Tayden Hall. He had two doubles and two RBI last night.

ESCAPE ARTIST: Wisconsin reliever Patricio Aquino got the game to the eleventh inning by getting out of a bases-loaded, one-out jam in the eighth, pitching around a leadoff triple in the ninth, and another bases-loaded, one-out situation in the tenth. He scattered five hits in his three scoreless innings.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYSON HARDIN: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Hardin in the 12th round of the 2024 draft out of Mississippi State University.

BULLDOG: Hardin was 3-3 and two saves with a 6.59 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 56 innings in forty games – two starts – at Mississippi State.

DAYTONA 500: Hardin pitched two seasons at Daytona State College (2021 and 2022). He was the team's pitcher of the year as a freshman and was 8-5 with two saves in 38 appearances – fifteen starts – at DSC.

BREAKING OUT: Hardin worked two innings in Milwaukee's 2025 Spring Breakout Game against the Cincinnati Reds on [March 16](#). He allowed one hit and struck out three without a walk in two scoreless innings.

LAST START: Hardin earned the win in game one of the series with Quad Cities on [April 8](#). He pitched five no-hit innings, walked one and struck out four.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Hardin had never faced the River Bandits prior to the game on April 8.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP LOGAN MARTIN: The Kansas City Royals selected Martin in the 12th round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Kentucky.

WILD CAT: Martin was 1-1 in nine games – eight starts – for Kentucky in 2023, his only season at the SEC school. Martin had a 4.44 ERA with 30 strikeouts in 26-1/3 innings.

WHERE DID HE COME FROM? Martin pitched three years at Sewanee: The University of the South, an NCAA Division III school of the Southern Athletic Association in Sewanee, Tennessee before transferring to Kentucky. In 2022, his final season of DIII ball, Martin had 98 strikeouts in 69-1/3 innings with a 1-5 record and a 3.89 ERA.

LAST START: Martin lost to Wisconsin in game one of this series on [April 8](#). He allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and five strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Martin had never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to the game on April 8.
