ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is in his second season as the manager of the Loons.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

■ PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYSON HARDIN: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Hardin in the 12th round of the 2024 draft out of Mississippi State University.

BULLDOG: Hardin was 3-3 and two saves with a 6.59 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 56 innings in forty games – two starts – at Mississippi State.

DAYTONA 500: Hardin pitched two seasons at Daytona State College (2021 and 2022). He was the team's pitcher of the year as a freshman and was 8-5 with two saves in 38 appearances – fifteen starts – at DSC.

BREAKING OUT: Hardin worked two innings in Milwaukee's 2025 Spring Breakout Game against the Cincinnati Reds on March 16. He allowed one hit and struck out three without a walk in two scoreless innings.

AWARD WINNING APRIL: Hardin was named Milwaukee's Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April. He was 2-0 with a 0.96 ERA with four walks and 20 strikeouts over 18-2/3 innings.

WHAT A WEEK: Hardin was named the Midwest League's Pitcher of the Week on May 19 for his seven-inning, complete-game, two-hit shutout against Beloit on May 16.

LAST START: Hardin lost to Cedar Rapids at home on <u>June 5</u>. He allowed seven runs – six earned – on ten hits with a walk and four strikeouts over four innings

VS. GREAT LAKES: Hardin has never pitched against the Loons before tonight. This evening is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ERIQ SWAN: The Los Angeles Dodgers selected Swan in the fourth round of the 2023 draft out of Middle Tennessee State University.

MTSU: Swan spent three seasons at Middle Tennessee State. He was 4-13 with a 6.54 ERA in 44 games – 24 starts – during his career there. Swan walked 82 and struck out 134 in 130-2/3 innings in college.

SUMMER BALL/FALL BALL: Swan pitched for the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League in 2022 and for the Glendale Desert Dogs of the Arizona Fall League in 2024.

START/STOP/START/STOP/START: Swan did not pitch professionally in 2023. He started his pro career with Rancho Cucamonga on April 10, 2024 with a two-inning start and went on the IL on April 13, 2024. Swan was sent to the ACL Dodgers for a rehab assignment on June 8, activated from the IL on June 25, placed back on the IL on July 5, and reactivated again on July 26. Swan was 0-1 with a 5.72 ERA in thirteen games – nine starts – in his two stops in the Dodgers system last season.

LAST START: Swan earned the win as he pitched the first six innings of a no-hitter at South Bend in game two of a doubleheader on <u>June 5</u>. Swan walked two and struck out seven in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Swan has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
