TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Thomas Harrington: The Campbell University alum is currently the Pirates' No. 3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 80 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Major League Debut: Harrington had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on April 1, 2025 and debuted with a 4.0 inning start the same night at Tampa Bay. Picked up his first career save in his next appearance on April 7 vs. St. Louis.

Last Outing: Thomas Harrington took his sixth loss of the season in Tuesday's series opener, losing each of his last three starts. He tossed a season-high 6.0 innings with three earned runs, three hits, three walks and five strikeouts. It was Harrington's first quality start with Indy since Sept. 11, 2024, when he tossed 6.2 innings of two-run ball vs. Rochester. He has tossed 5.0-plus innings in five of his last seven starts.

Against the Redbirds: Tuesday was Harrington's first career start against the Redbirds.

Miscellaneous: Harrington was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (36th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft.
