INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Memphis Redbirds scored 10 unanswered runs to take down the Indianapolis Indians, 10-2, at AutoZone Park on Saturday night. The Indiana broke out to a 2-0 advantage in the first inning. Ronny Simon jumped on the second pitch of the game for a leadoff homer to open the scoring. After Billy Cook singled and Lack Suwinski walked, Liover Peguero advanced Cook to third base on a flyout. Matt Fraizer drove in the second run of the opening frame with a double to follow. Michael Siani began the Redbirds resurgence with a leadoff homer of his own, depositing Drake Fellows fifth pitch of the game into right field. Memphis tied the game later in the inning on a run-scoring double play. Mike Antico gave the Redbirds a lead they would not relinquish with a two-run blast off Fellows in the second inning. They tallied one run in the third inning, two runs in the fifth and three runs in the seventh to seal victory. Following 4.2 innings of two-run ball from Curtis Taylor, Michael Gomez picked up his first win of the season with 1.1 scoreless frames. Zack Weiss earned his second save of the season as he blanked the Indians across the final 3.0 innings.

SOMEONE COOKED HERE: Billy Cook went 2-for-5 with one run in last night's contest, posting four straight games in which he reached base safely multiple times. He reached four times on Wednesday and Thursday, and three times on Friday. He extended his hitting streak to six games, collecting two-plus hits in three straight games and five of those six overall. It marks his first string of three consecutive multi-hit performances since Sept. 6-8, 2024. He has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games with an official at-bat dating back to May 23 at Toledo. In that span, he is hitting .385 (20-for-52) with four doubles, four RBI, eight walks, seven runs and four stolen bases. Thursday night marked his first multi-steal game since Sept. 5, 2023, with Double-A Bowie vs. New Hampshire. He drew three walks on Wednesday, his most since walking three times on Sept. 2, 2024, at Toledo.

SIMON SAYS: Ronny Simon launched the second pitch of the game 407 feet to right-center field for a leadoff homer in last night's contest. It was Indy's first leadoff blast since Nick Gonzales on Aug. 22, 2024, at Columbus. Simon finished 1-for-4 with the homer and a walk yesterday. He made his mark in his Indians debut, going 2-for-4 with a stolen base on Friday night. It marked his third multi-hit game of the campaign, last doing so with Jacksonville at Memphis on April 15. He joined the Indians this week after being claimed by Pittsburgh on June 2. The 25-year-old was designated for assignment by Miami on May 30. In 19 games for the Marlins this season, he hit 234 (11-for-47) with two doubles, five RBI, seven walks and six runs. He made his major league debut on April 21 vs. Cincinnati, collecting his first major league hit and RBI off Nick Lodolo with a single up the middle.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak continued his dominant 2025 campaign, going 1-for-4 on Friday night. Among all minor leaguers with at least 30 games played, he ranks first in batting average (397) and third in both SLG (645) and OPS (1.097). He has reached base safely in 31 of 34 games this season and has one-plus hit in 30 of those. He extended his hitting streak to 10 games, marking his second double-digit hitting streak of the season, including a team best 13-game hitting streak from April 3-23. The 10-gamer run is tied with Rochester's J.T. Arruda for the longest active hitting streak in the International League among active players. In these 10 games since May 7, Solak is hitting. 474 (18-for-38) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, eight RBI, four walks, nine runs and one stolen base. He tallied five RBI with a trio of this on Thursday, marking the most RBI in a single game by an Indy batter since Joshua Palacios' five RBI on Sept. 8, 2024, at Toledo and Solak's most in a game since Aug. 28, 2022, with Round Rock at Albuquerque.

CONCRETE JUNGLE: Nick Yorke continued his scorching run at the plate, going 1-for-3 with a walk on Friday night. Since May 1, he has hit safely in 23 of 28 games and posted multiple hits in nine of those. In this span, he is hitting .327 (34-for-104) with five doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI, seven walks, 13 runs and seven stolen bases. Since this date he leads the team in hits, total bases (45) and stolen bases. Yorke's trio of hits on Thursday matched a season high (3x, MR - 5/1 @ OMA) and marked his 12th multi-hit game of the campaign, which is tied with Nick Solak for the most such contests on the team.

DAZZLING DAURI: The Indians roster features one major league rehabber, right-hander Dauri Moreta. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. He has since pitched to a 4.22 ERA (5er/10.2ip) with Indy, allowing seven hits while striking out 16 across his 13 appearances dating back to May 6.

COMEBACK KIDS: After scoring four unanswered runs on Thursday night when trailing, 9-6, the Indians improved to 14-5 in one-run games this season and picked up their 16th comeback win of the campaign. Their 16 comeback wins through June 5 were the most by the team since the 2019 Indians totaled 17 comeback wins to that date. Thursday night marked Indy's second win this season when trailing after the 7th frame (2-21).

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians conclude their six-game series against the Memphis Redbirds this afternoon at 2:05 PM ET. Right-hander Thomas Harrington is set to take the mound for the Indians. In his last start on Thomas Harrington took his sixth loss of the season in Tuesday's series opener, losing each of his last three starts. He tossed a season-high 6.0 innings with three earned runs, three hits, three walks and five strikeouts. It was Harrington's first quality start with Indy since Sept. 11, 2024, when he tossed 6.2 innings of two-run ball vs. Rochester. He has tossed 5.0-plus innings in five of his last seven starts. Tuesday was his first career start against Memphis. On the mound for the Redbirds is right-hander Zach Plesac. He was signed to a minor league deal by St. Louis yesterday and is set to make his season debut for Memphis. He is 0-2 in two career starts against Indianapolis, allowing nine earned runs in 11.2 innings. In his last start against Indy on May 26, 2023, with Columbus, he took the loss, allowing six runs across 5.1 innings.

WHAT'S AT STAKE: The Indians look to avoid their fifth series loss of the season and their third on the road. A split would tally their third on the road this season, with Indy yet to capture a road series victory on the campaign. The head-to-head record since 2021 is on the line with the Indians leading, 21-20. Indianapolis aims to avoid three straight losses against the Redbirds for the first time since July 8, 2023-April 2, 2024, and three straight at Memphis since dropping five in a row from April 18-22, 2023.

ON THIS DATE IN 2000: The third inning at Ottawa was an offensive outpour for the Indians as they already led the Lynx, 2-1. Starting pitcher Everett Stull highlighted the inning with a grand slam and was one of two Indy players who drove in four runs (also: Kevin Barker). Outfielders Damon Hollins and Chris Jones each finished the game with four hits. Stull limited Ottawa to four runs in 6.0 innings.
