WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: [The Beloit Sky Carp defeated the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 12-7 at Neuroscience Group Field](#). The Sky Carp scored six runs in the top of the first inning with Michael Snyder capping the inning with a two-out, three-run home run. Beloit added four runs in the top of the fourth to take a 10-1 lead.

THESE GUYS: Beloit has scored 29 runs on 29 hits in the first two games of the series. They are outscoring Wisconsin .377 to .215 so far. The Sky Carp have five doubles, three triples, and two homers in the series. They are also 11-for-11 in stolen bases to run their season total to a minor league-leading 113 steals

MISSED OPPORTUNITY: Wisconsin had a run in with one out and the bases loaded in the bottom of the first inning against Beloit starting pitcher Noble Meyer but did not score as Meyer got a popup and a strikeout to end the threat.

ALWAYS AREINAMO: Jadher Areinamo hit his fourth homer run of the season, a lead-off shot to left in the fifth inning. Areinamo has four homers on the season. He also walked twice.

IT GOES TO ELEVEN: Blake Burke went 1-for-4 with a double and a walk yesterday to extend his current hitting streak to eleven games, the longest streak on the team this season. Burke is 14-for-45 (.380) during the streak. Burke is also on an 18-game on-base streak (24-for-72, .935 OPS)

SOMETHING TO SHOOT FOR: Khadim Diaw of Cedar Rapids has the longest on-base streak in the Midwest League this season at twenty games. Tommy White of Lansing has the longest active on-base streak at nineteen games. White also has the longest hitting streak in the MWL this season. He is currently on a 17-game hitting streak.

A ROUGH HOME: Wisconsin is 5-12 at home this season. They have lost the first two games in three of their four home series in 2025.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, Mitch Stetter, and Matt Chapman played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYSON HARDIN: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Hardin in the 12th round of the 2024 draft out of Mississippi State University.

BULLDOG: Hardin was 3-3 and two saves with a 6.59 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 56 innings in forty games – two starts – at Mississippi State.

DAYTONA 500: Hardin pitched two seasons at Daytona State College (2021 and 2022). He was the team's pitcher of the year as a freshman and was 8-5 with two saves in 38 appearances – fifteen starts – at DSC.

BREAKING OUT: Hardin worked two innings in Milwaukee's 2025 Spring Breakout Game against the Cincinnati Reds on [March 16](#). He allowed one hit and struck out three without a walk in two scoreless innings.

AWARD WINNING APRIL: Hardin was named Milwaukee's Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April. He was 2-0 with a 0.96 ERA with four walks and 20 strikeouts over 18-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Hardin lost at Peoria on [May 9](#). He allowed four runs – three earned – on nine hits with no walks and five strikeouts over six innings.

VS. BELOIT: Hardin has never faced the Sky Carp prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ANTHONY FLORES: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Flores as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on June 4, 2022.

ON AN ISLAND: Flores pitched the 2022 and 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League. He combined to go 3-8 with a 4.42 ERA and 87 strikeouts over 79-1/3 innings in 22 games – eighteen starts.

COMING TO AMERICA: Flores made twelve appearances in the Arizona Complex League and seven appearances with the Carolina Mudcats in 2024. He combined to go 5-4 with a 5.17 ERA and 85 strikeouts and 27 walks over 69-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Flores lost at Beloit on [May 10](#). He allowed six runs – four earned – on four hits with three walks and five strikeouts over three innings.

VS. BELOIT: Flores has never pitched against the Sky Carp prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KARSON MILBRANDT: Selected by the Miami Marlins in the 3rd round of the 2022 draft out of Liberty (MO) High School. Milbrandt is ranked as the #25 prospect in the Marlins system by MLB Pipeline.

IS IT IN YOU? Milbrandt was named the Gatorade Player of the Year for Missouri prior to the 2022 draft. He was 7-1 with a 1.66 ERA and 91 strikeouts over 50-2/3 innings pitched. He also hit .400 with an OPS of 1.043 in his senior season.

VANDERWHAT? Milbrandt signed with the Marlins over a commitment to Vanderbilt University.

STARTING OUT: Milbrandt made one professional appearance in 2022, a two-inning start for the Jupiter Hammerheads against the Lakeland Flying Tigers on September 9 in a Florida State League game. He allowed two runs on two hits with a walk and a strikeout for a no decision.

LEAVING JUPITER: Milbrandt started the 2023 season with the Jupiter and was 3-3 with a 5.33 ERA in twelve starts. He walked 26 and struck out 52 in 52-1/3 innings pitched before being assigned to Beloit on June 28. Milbrandt was 0-3 with a 4.60 ERA in eleven starts for the Sky Carp after the promotion. Last season Milbrandt went 1-8 with a 4.33 ERA in 22 starts for Beloit.

LAST START: Milbrandt had a no decision against Cedar Rapids at home on [July 11](#). He allowed two runs – one earned – on four hits with two walks and a strikeout in four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: In three starts against Wisconsin last year, Milbrandt had a no decision at Wisconsin on [May 17](#), lost at Wisconsin on [July 4](#), and a no decision at home on [July 23](#). He gave up ten runs on thirteen hits with eleven walks and ten strikeouts over 12-1/3 innings versus Wisconsin last season.

BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:

RHP IKE BUXTON: The Miami Marlins selected Buxton in the fifteenth round of the 2022 draft out of the Lipscomb University.

STARTING OUT IN IDAHO: Buxton began his collegiate career at Boise State University. He was a redshirt in 2019 and made four relief appearances during the shortened 2020 season before transferring to Lipscomb for 2021.

NASHVILLE: Buxton pitched two seasons at Lipscomb. He was 11-8 with a save and a 4.45 ERA in 33 games – 24 starts – in his two seasons for the Bison. In his final season at Lipscomb, Buxton was 7-3 with 66 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings in fifteen games – fourteen starts.

IT'S COMPLEX: Buxton made three relief appearances with the Marlins affiliate in the FCL after signing with Miami. He walked eight, struck out five, and allowed five runs over 4-2/3 innings as a pro in 2022.

GOOSING THE NUMBERS: Buxton was 2-2 with a 3.71 ERA in seven starts for the Sky Carp after earning promotion to the Midwest League in 2023. He was 2-8 with a 5.35 ERA in nineteen starts for Beloit in 2024.

LAST START: Buxton lost at Quad Cities on [September 8, 2024](#). He allowed six runs – five earned - on five hits with two walks and five strikeouts in 2-2/3 innings.

LAST APPEARANCE: Buxton won in relief against Cedar Rapids at home on [May 8](#). He allowed a run on two hits with a walk and a strikeout over three innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2024): Buxton had two no decisions at Neuroscience Group Field – [May 18](#) and [July 6](#) – Wisconsin scored eight runs – six earned – on nine hits in eleven innings against Buxton, who walked three and struck out seven in those games.
