#### **INDY BITS**

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians dropped the series opener to the Louisville Bats, 4-2, on Tuesday night. It ended a run of three consecutive wins as the away team against Louisville. Right-hander Bubba Chandler led the charge for Indy, tossing 4.0 scoreless innings with one hit, two walks and eight strikeouts. Matt Gorski put the Indians up 1-0 with an RBI single in the third inning. The lead was extended 2-0 in the sixth inning when DJ Stewart crushed a 408-foot home run to right field. Indy then surrendedered the lead in the eighth inning when five consecutive batters reached base off Peter Strzelecki. A bases-loaded walk put the Bats on the board, an RBI single tied the game and a sacrifice fly put the Bats ahead. The squad tacked on one more insurance run before the Indians came up short in the ninth inning. The Indians pitching staff matched their season high, striking out 14 opposing batters (Last: 4/4 vs. IOW).

**TONIGHT'S MATCHUP:** Right-hander Braxton Ashcraft is set to make his third start of the season after taking the loss in his first two starts. It marks his third career game against Louisville, last throwing one scoreless inning on Aug. 30, 2024 at Victory Field. He has not allowed a run in 4.0 career innings against the team. Opposite Ashcraft is Bats right-hander Randy Wynne. Wynne has allowed one earned run across two starts (6.2ip) this season. In 10 career games and seven starts against the Indians, Wynne owns an 0-4 record and 6.16 ERA (21er, 30.2ip). He made three starts against the Indians last season, allowing just two runs over 10.2 innings.

**CHANDLER CHUCKS:** Bubba Chandler is yet to allow a run in two starts this season, striking out 12 batters in 6.2 innings opposed to just seven total baserunners (2h, 5bb). In nine career starts with the Indians, the right-hander owns a 1.57 ERA (8er, 46.0ip) with 66 strikeouts, a 1.04 WHIP and .173 opponent average (28-for-162). He has punched out eight or more batters in five of those nine starts and posted six-plus strikeouts in seven of them. He has not allowed an earned run in 9.0 career innings opposite Louisville.

**NO FLY ZONE:** The Indianapolis Indians have not allowed a home run through seven games and 59.0 innings this season. It is the team's longest stretch of games without allowing a homer in the Victory Field era. Indy is the only Triple-A team to have not given up a home run this season.

**GORSKI GALORE:** Matt Gorski has reached base safely in all seven of the Indians games this season and is riding a teamhigh six-game hitting streak. In those seven games he is hitting .333 (8-for-24) with three doubles, one home run, four RBI, three walks, one stolen base and a .990 OPS. He launched his first home run of the season in Game 1 on Thursday vs. Iowa, following DJ Stewart's three-run bomb for a set of back-to-back blasts in the third inning.

**PEGGY PROWESS:** Liover Peguero is riding a six-game on base streak, hitting .238 (5-for-21) with one double, three walks and a .333 OBP in this span. He has collected a hit in five of those six games, including three straight.

**THE THRILL OF 1T:** The Indians walked off winners in game two and game four of last week's series vs. Iowa. In game two on Thursday, the Indians walked off in the first contest of a seven-inning doubleheader, with the game going to extras in the eighth inning. Malcom Nuñez stepped to the plate as a pinch hitter in the bottom of the eighth and delivered a game-winning fielders' choice. It was the Indians first pinch-hit walk-off plate appearance since Christian Bethancourt's decisive RBI single in the 10th inning on June 30, 2021 vs. Iowa. In Sunday's resumed contest, Nick Solak won the game with an RBI single through the left side.

**YOUNG BUCS:** Six prospects ranked among the Pirates top 30 according to MLB Pipeline began the seaosn in Triple-A, led by right-hander Bubba Chandler as the organization's No. 1 (MLB's No. 15) overall farmhand. It marks the second consecutive year that the Pirates top prospect will begin the season with the Indians, following right-hander and 2024 MLB Rookie of the Year Paul Skenes. Other prospects on the 2025 Opening Day roster include utilityman Nick Yorke (No. 5), Opening Day starter and right-hander Braxton Ashcraft (No. 6), right-hander Mike Burrows (No. 15), infielder Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 17) and outfielder Billy Cook (No. 18). Last season, the Indians featured six of the Pirates top 30 prospects (according to *Baseball America*).

ON THIS DATE IN 1996: The Indianapolis Indians officially announced that "Victory Field" will be the name of the new ballpark under construction in downtown Indianapolis.

**Braxton Ashcraft:** The right-hander and Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

**Opening Day Starter:** Ashcraft made his second career Opening Day start on March 28 at St. Paul, last doing so on June 14, 2019, with Class-A short season West Virginia.

**Last Outing:** Ashcraft took the loss on April 3 (Game 2) vs. lowa, tossing 5.0 innings of two-run ball. He allowed a career-high tying eight hits (MR: 5/2/24 (1) with Altoona at Harrisburg), one walk and five strikeouts.

**Against the Bats:** Today marks Ashcraft's third career appearance opposite the Bats, last throwing one scoreless inning on Aug. 30, 2024 at Victory Field. He has not allowed a run to the club in 4.0 career innings.

**Prospectus:** Ashcraft enters the 2025 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 4 according to *Baseball America*. Since being drafted by the Pirates in 2018, No. 4 is his highest ranking according to *BA*, elevated from No. 10 last season.

**Miscellaneous:** Ashcraft was drafted by Pittsburgh in the second round (51st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Robinson High School (Waco, Texas). He had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on Nov. 14, 2023.
