#### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 10-5 at Modern Woodmen Park.](#)

The River Bandits scored four runs in the first inning before the first out was recorded. Cayden Wallace went 3-for-4 with four RBI and was a single shy of the cycle for Quad Cities.

**ROUGH START:** Wisconsin starter Tyler Woessner walked Javier Vaz on four pitches in the bottom of the first. Herard Gonzalez followed with a triple. Gavin Cross was next with an RBI single. Then, Wallace hit a two-run homer. Woessner allowed ten runs on nine hits over four innings. Woessner had allowed one homer in his first 66-2/3 innings pitched this season before giving up three in four innings last night.

**YEOMAN'S WORK:** Ryan Brady took over for Woessner in the bottom of the fifth and pitched four scoreless innings with two hits and four strikeouts.

**KEEP ON WORKING:** Wisconsin's offense kept plugging away as they got to within 4-2 and 6-4. Ernesto Martinez Jr. homered in the second and Terence Doston knocked in a run with a grounder in the third. Robert Moore added a two-run single in the fifth. Wisconsin's scored on a passed ball in the seventh.

**EJECT BUTTON:** Rattlers manager Joe Ayrault was ejected in the seventh inning after a disagreement on a bloop to left off the bat of Matt Wood that would have scored two runs was called foul by the plate umpire.

**MOORE, MOORE, MOORE:** The longest on-base streak of the season by a Timber Rattler now belongs to Moore. The Rattlers second baseman has an 18-game streak with fifteen RBI and eleven runs scored and an .849 OPS during the streak.

**DIFFERENT MONTHS:** The Rattlers were 8-18 in May and hit .224 while their opponents hit .251 to outscore the Rattlers 145-107. The Wisconsin staff had an ERA of 4.87 in May. In June, Wisconsin was 14-10 and hit .257 with an OPS of .698 to outscore their opponents 127-99. The Rattlers pitching staff held opponents to an average of .228 while cutting their ERA of 3.68.

**ABOUT QUAD CITIES:** The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

**ABOUT THE ROYALS:** The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo Garcia (#19), and Matthew Wood (#24). Hendry Mendez (#13) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has seven active River Bandits on their list of Kansas City prospects: Gavin Cross (#1), Cayden Wallace (#4), Carter Jensen (#8), Diego Hernandez (#15), Mason Barnett (#16), Luinder Avila (#28), and David Sandlin (#30).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP EDWIN JIMENEZ:** Milwaukee signed Jimenez as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on October 11, 2018.

**HEADING TO THE CO-OP:** Jimenez was assigned to the Dominican Summer League Co-op team shared between Milwaukee and Cleveland for the 2019 season. Jimenez was 1-5 with a 3.05 ERA in twelve games – eight starts. He walked 26 and struck out 32 over 41-1/3 innings in his first professional season.

**FROM THE ISLAND TO THE DESERT:** Jimenez started the 2021 season with Milwaukee's number two affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was assigned to the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League on August 7, 2021. Jimenez went 1-1 with a 1.72 ERA in five games – four starts – in the DSL and 0-4 with a save and a 5.25 ERA in the ACL. He walked twelve and struck out 48 over 39-2/3 innings combined between his two stops in the system that season.

**CAROLINA ON MY MIND:** Jimenez was 4-7 in 25 games – seventeen starts – with the Carolina Mudcats in 2022. He had a 4.75 ERA, walked 41, and struck out 104 over 113-2/3 innings pitched in the Carolina League last season. Jimenez started the 2023 season with Carolina and went 2-0 in four games – one start – with five walks and 23 strikeouts over eighteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 2.

**LAST START:** Jimenez had a no decision against Lansing at home on [June 24](#). He allowed four runs on six hits – including two homers with no walks and three strikeouts over six innings.

**VS. QUAD CITIES:** Jimenez made a relief appearance against the River Bandits at home on [May 19](#). He pitched 4-1/3 scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked three, and struck out nine for a no decision.

## QUAD CITIES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP DAVID SANDLIN:** The Royals selected Sandlin in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Oklahoma.

**THE COLLEGE BEFORE COLLEGE:** Sandlin pitched two seasons at Eastern Oklahoma State College. In 2021, he was 9-2 with a save and 3.18 ERA in thirteen appearances – eleven starts. Sandlin struck out 100 in 65 innings in his final season before going to Oklahoma.

**BOOMER SOONER:** Sandlin pitched for Oklahoma in 2022. He was 9-4 with a 5.59 ERA and 102 strikeouts over 95 innings in nineteen games – eighteen starts for the Sooners.

**OMAHA HERO:** Sandlin was the starting pitcher for the Sooners against Texas A&M on [June 22, 2022](#) in the game to go to the College World Series Championship Series. Sandlin allowed one run on five hits with a walk and twelve strikeouts over seven innings in Oklahoma's 5-1 win to advance to the Finals.

**CAMEO BEFORE THE ROLE:** Sandlin made one appearance in the Arizona Complex League for the Royals in 2022 for his only professional appearance. He started the 2023 season with Columbia in the Carolina League and was 4-1 with a 3.38 ERA in twelve starts. Sandlin walked thirteen and struck out 79 in 58-2/3 innings pitched with the Fireflies before his promotion to Quad Cities on June 20, 2023.

**LAST START:** Sandlin made his Midwest League debut with a loss against Peoria at home on [June 23](#). He allowed two runs on three hits with three walks and four strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Sandlin has never faced the Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
