ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Jase Bowen smacked two extra-base hits, including a two-RBI triple turned Little-League home run in the fifth inning, to drive the Indianapolis Indians to a 2-1 victory vs. the Buffalo Bisons on Saturday night at Victory Field. With a 1-0 deficit, Sammy Siani kicked off the fifth frame with the Indians' first hit, a single, to set up Bowen's game-deciding play. Bowen smashed a triple 105.6 mph to deep center field off Elieser Hernández to drive in Siani and he scampered home after the ball squirted away from the center fielder to flip the score on Buffalo. Joey Loperfido led off the game for Buffalo with a single and advanced to second on a passed ball before advancing home on a single from Yohendrick Pinango for the Bisons' lone run of the game. After allowing a run in the first inning Chase Shugart settled in with a perfect second inning before handing the ball to Hunter Barco. Barco tossed 3.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit and striking out two. He was followed by Brandon Bidois with a clean 2.0 innings with two punchouts and Beau Burrows (S, 2), who closed the door with a 2.0 inning save.

WINDIANAPOLIS: The Indians have won back-to-back home games and have improved their Triple-A best home record to 46-22 (.676). Indy has the most home wins of any full-season minor league club this season and hold the fifth-best home winning percentage. It is the Indians' best home winning percentage to this point in the season since at least 2005, surpassing their 46-24 (.657) record at home through Aug. 30, 2012. 46 wins at Victory Field also surpasses the Indians' home win total in 26 of 28 full seasons in the Victory Field era (since 1996). Indians' pitchers have struck out the second-most batters (678) at home this season and have held opponents to the third-lowest ERA (3.73) and batting average (.227) among Triple-A pitching staffs. The Indians hold a +55-run differential at home, which trails only Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's +84 differential for the best among International League teams.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS: The Indians moved to 27-13 in one-run games with last night's win. That amounts to a .675 winning percentage, which only trails Syracuse (16-6, .727) for the best among Triple-A teams this season. It is the Indians' best winning percentage in one-run games to this point in the season since at least 2015, surpassing their 30-23 record (.566) through Aug. 30, 2015. The Indians have finished with an above .500 record in one-run games in five seasons since at least 2005 and last did so in 2021. Indy is on track to surpass their 28-19 (.596) record in one-run games in 2011 for its best one-run record in a season since at least 2005.

OFFENSIVE OUTFIELD: Indians' outfielders accounted for three of Indy's four hits in last night's win. Indy's outfield core currently paces International League clubs with a .280 batting average and 411 hits on the season while ranking third in doubles (87) and tying for the third-most triples (12).

BOWEN'S BLAZING: Jase Bowen powered Indy's offense with two extra-base hits, a double and a triple turned Little-League home run that plated both Indians' runs in the win. In seven games at Victory Field, Bowen is hitting .333 (8-for-24) with two doubles, two triples, a homer, four RBI and a 1.068 OPS. In 19 games with Indy overall, Bowen has racked up five doubles, two triples, a homer and six RBI while hitting .254 (17-for-67) with a .775 OPS.

SAMMY SWINGS: Sammy Siani broke up a perfect game with a single off RHP Elieser Hernández last night and scored the game-tying run. Against right-handed pitchers in Triple-A, Siani has logged a .280 batting average (7-for-25) with a double, two homers, five RBI, six walks to six strikeouts, a .419 on-base percentage and a .979 OPS. In nine games with Indy since being promoted from Double-A Altoona on Aug. 20, he is hitting .267 (8-for-30) with a .389 on-base percentage and a .889 OPS.

BAE'S BACK: Ji Hwan Bae returns tonight after being placed on the 7-day IL on Aug. 19. Before being placed on the IL, Bae was riding a seven-game hitting streak from Aug. 9-17 across which he racked up the most doubles in Triple-A (6) while hitting .355 (11-for-31) with seven runs scored, a triple and a .988 OPS. He has hit safely in 17 of his last 21 contests dating back to July 20, good for a .309 batting average (25-for-81) with 18 runs scored, eight doubles, three triples, 10 stolen bases and a .904 OPS in that span. Additionally, Bae has not committed an error in 58 straight games with Indy, the longest string of games without an error by an Indians' primary outfielder (> 50% of games in the outfield in that season) since Jared Oliva had a streak of 90 games without an error from April 16-Sept. 27, 2022.

BUCCO ABOARD: Right-handed pitcher Justin Lawrence had his rehab assignment transferred from Single-A Bradenton prior to Tuesday's game. Lawrence, 30, did not allow a run in 10 of 11 appearances with Pittsburgh before being placed on the 15-day IL on April 24 and being transferred to the 60-day IL on May 3 with right elbow inflammation. He has allowed one hit and has held opponents to a .083 batting average across his four rehab appearances between Bradenton and Indianapolis.

TODAY'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians and Buffalo Bisons meet in the series finale of their six-game set from Victory Field today at 1:35 PM. The Indians are looking to secure a series split and avoid dropping back-to-back series at home for the first time since losing consecutive sets to Omaha and Columbus from May 27-June 9, 2024. Southpaw Nick Dombkowski gets the start for Indy, his ninth start and 23rd appearance of the season. He started against Buffalo on Tuesday and allowed two runs on four hits while striking out five in 4.0 innings of work. In five starts since June 1, Dombkowski has pitched to a 1-1 record with a 3.48 ERA (8er/20.2ip), 18 strikeouts and a 1.11 WHIP. He will be facing off against his Tuesday counterpart, MLB rehabber Alek Manoah. In two starts against the Indians, he has a 0.79 ERA (1er/11.1ip) with 17 strikeouts and a .190 batting average against (8-for-42). In his start against Indy on April 30, 2024, at Victory Field, Manoah matched a career high with 12 punchouts across 6.0 innings on one-run ball but was outduelled by Paul Skenes (6.0ip, 4 h, 0 r, 7 k) in a 4-3 Indians' win.

ON THIS DATE IN 1978: Champ Summers, the eventual Minor League Player of the Year, blasted two home runs vs. Springfield to keep the Indians' playoff hopes alive with a 5-2 win as they awaited their postseason destiny. Their chances of winning the Eastern Division title relied on the outcome of the second game of a doubleheader between Evansville and Iowa. The Indians and Triplets were tied for first place heading into the day, but Evansville's 3-2 loss to Iowa in Game 2 of the doubleheader provided Indy clarity. Indianapolis went on to the American Association playoffs as the Eastern Division champions. Summers hit .368 that season with 34 home runs and 124 RBI.

Nick Dombkowski: The southpaw will be making his ninth start and 23rd appearance of the season for the Indians.

Last Outing: Dombkowski started the series opener vs. Buffalo on Tuesday and allowed two runs on four hits and two walks while striking out five.

Against the Bisons: Tuesday was Dombkowski's first appearance against the Bisons.

INT Pitcher of the Week: Dombkowski was awarded the International League Pitcher of the Week award for the week of Aug. 18-24. He made one start in the week, on Aug. 20 at Syracuse, and allowed two hits, no runs and no walks while striking out four across 6.0 innings of work. Both hits were singles and he induced double plays to erase each of them, leading him to face the minimum 18 batters in his award-winning effort.

Heating Up: In five starts since June 1, Dombkowski has pitched to a 3.48 ERA (8er/20.2ip) with 18 strikeouts and a 1.11 WHIP.

Miscellaneous: Dombkowski was signed as a non-drafted free agent by Pittsburgh out of the University of Hartford on July 20, 2021.
