**DUELING HOMERS:** Kyle DeBarge gave the Kernels a 2-0 lead on a two-run homer in the top of the sixth. Jadher Areinamo tied the game with a two-out, two-run home run in the bottom of the sixth.

PUSHING THE LIMITS: Wisconsin starting pitcher Jaron DeBerry set a new single-game high for innings pitch as a pro as he worked 5-1/3 innings. His longest outing as a pro before last night was four innings DeBerry allowed two runs on five hits with no walks and four strikeouts.

YEOMAN'S WORK: Jesús Broca relieved DeBerry with one out in the sixth and pitched 3-2/3 scoreless innings of relief. Broca scattered six hits, walked none, and struck out four for the win.

IN CONTROL: DeBerry and Broca combined for Wisconsin's fifth walk-free game of the season last night. The only walk by Cedar Rapids pitchers last night was an intentional pass to Hedbert Pérez in the bottom of the ninth

STAYING HOT: Eduardo Garcia doubled in the first inning to extend his current on-base streak to nineteen. MAKING A HABIT OF IT: The Timber Rattlers recorded their third walkoff win of the homestand last night on Guilarte's game-winning sacrifice fly. Blake Burke had a walkoff single in the ninth against Peoria May 27. Tayden Hall had a walkoff sacrifice fly in the eleventh on May 31.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended last year when the Kernels missed the playoffs. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#17), Jadher Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29).

### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP ANTHONY FLORES:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Flores as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on June 4, 2022.

**ON AN ISLAND:** Flores pitched the 2022 and 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League. He combined to go 3-8 with a 4.42 ERA and 87 strikeouts over 79-1/3 innings in 22 games – eighteen starts.

**COMING TO AMERICA:** Flores made twelve appearances in the Arizona Complex League and seven appearances with the Carolina Mudcats in 2024. He combined to go 5-4 with a 5.17 ERA and 85 strikeouts and 27 walks over 69-2/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Flores had a no decision against Peoria on <u>June 1</u>. He allowed four runs on nine hits with a walk and three strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. CEDAR RAPIDS:** Flores has made two relief appearances against the Kernels this season – <u>April 5</u> and <u>April 23</u>. He has allowed three runs on six hits with two walks and four strikeouts over four innings with to no decisions.

### CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEJANDRO HIDALGO: The Minnesota Twins acquired Hidalgo in a trade with the Los Angeles Angels on November 18, 2022 in exchange for Gio Urshela.

**ORIGIN STORY:** The Angels signed Hidalgo as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on July 2, 2019.

**ONE YEAR IN IOWA:** Hidalgo was 0-5 with a 5.28 ERA over 21 games – eight starts – for the Kernels in 2023. He walked 53 and struck out 57 in 58 innings.

MISSING TIME: Hidalgo did not pitch in 2024 due to injury.

**LAST START:** Hidalgo had a no decision against Lake County at home on <u>June 1</u>. He allowed two runs – one earned – on three hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Hidalgo made a start at Wisconsin on April <u>5</u> and another at Cedar Rapids on April <u>25</u> this season. He has allowed two runs on four hits with five walks and thirteen strikeouts over nine innings for a pair of no decisions against the Rattlers in 2025.
