LAST ACTION: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers lost 5-4 to the South Bend Cubs at Neuroscience Group Field on Sunday.](#) Wisconsin went 1-5 in the series.

SO CLOSE (PART ONE): The Rattlers trailed 5-4 heading into the bottom of the ninth on Sunday.

Yhoswar Garcia singled, stole second (his 38th of the season), and went to third on a throwing error with no outs. He was left stranded there.

SO CLOSE (PART TWO): Eduardo Garcia singled, doubled, and homered on Sunday leaving him a triple shy of the cycle. His home run was his thirteenth of the season.

MULTI-BALL: Blake Burke was 2-for-4 with a double on Sunday for his 25th multi-hit game of 2025. Burke is tied for the Midwest League lead in hits (95), third in average (.313), and tied for fourth in doubles (20).

ALL-STAR STORIES: [The National League beat the American League 7-6 in a home run derby swing-off for the 2025 MLB All-Star Game on Tuesday.](#) Former Rattlers Shane Smith and Jacob Misorowski and Rattler rehab Trevor Megill combined for 1-2/3 scoreless innings in the game.

DID YOU KNOW? Kyle Schwarber, who hit three homers in three swings to give the National League the victory in the swing-off, played for the Kane County Cougars in 2014. He played three games against the Timber Rattlers that season and was 5-for-10 with two doubles, a homer, and three RBI.

DID YOU KNOW SOMETHING ELSE? The 2019 Midwest League All-Star Game was decided in a one-on-one home run derby. Blaze Alexander of the West team hit one homer in 90 seconds. Chris Betts hit two homers in his 90 seconds for a walkoff win for the East.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Rattlers begin a nine-game road trip tonight. They have three games with the Cedar Rapids Kernels through Sunday before heading to Quad Cities for a six-game series that starts on Tuesday. The Rattlers are 19-19 on the road this season, but 1-5 in the second half.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended last year when the Kernels missed the playoffs. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#17), Jadhav Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). [MLB Pipeline](#) has five active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Brandon Winokur (#7), Kyle DeBarge (#12), Billy Amick (#14), Danny De Andrade (#25), and Jose Olivares (#28). Charlee Soto (#8), Rayne Doncon (#15), and Khadim Diaw (#29) are currently on the Cedar Rapids IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5th round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON: Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

DELAYED START: Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

AS A RATTLER (2024): Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers.

LAST START: Birchard lost to South Bend at home on [July 9](#). He gave up three runs – one earned – on one hit and five walks over 4-1/3 innings. Birchard struck out seven in the game.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Birchard is 1-1 in two starts – [April 23](#) and [June 4](#) – against the Kernel this season. He has allowed three runs on eight hits with three walks and fifteen strikeouts over 10-2/3 innings in those two starts. Birchard also lost at Cedar Rapids on [September 5, 2024](#).

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TY LANGENBERG: The Minnesota Twins selected Langenberg in the eleventh round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Iowa.

HIS 2023: Langeberg went 6-3 with a 4.15 ERA in seventeen games – fifteen starts – at Iowa. He made his professional debut with the Florida Complex League Twins with two brief relief appearances. Langenberg also made three brief relief appearances with the Ft. Myers Mighty Mussels in the Florida State League last season.

LAST YEAR: Langenberg started 2024 with Ft. Myers. He was 3-3 with a 3.38 ERA and struck out 56 over 48 innings pitched in nine starts. He was promoted to Cedar Rapids on June 11.

LAST START: Langenberg won at Peoria on [July 12](#). He allowed two runs on three hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over six innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Langenberg has made two starts against Wisconsin this season – [April 23](#) in Cedar Rapids and [June 5](#) at Neuroscience Group Field – without a decision. He has allowed two runs on five hits with seven strikeouts over seven innings. Langenberg also started against the Timber Rattlers at Veterans Memorial Stadium on [September 3, 2024](#). He allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out seven over five scoreless innings for a no decision.
