ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-3. Wisconsin took a 3-1 lead into the bottom of the eighth inning. Beloit tied the game with two runs in the eighth. Tanner Allen knocked in the winning run with a one-out single in the bottom of the ninth.

OUT IN FRONT: The Rattlers scored three runs after two outs in the top of the fourth. The first two Wisconsin hitters of the inning were retired. Then, the next three Rattlers drew walks. Wes Clarke drove in two runs with a single for a 2-0 lead. Tristan Peters followed with an RBI single to make it 3-0.

WELCOME BACK: Tyler Gillies pitched a 1-2-3 bottom of the sixth inning. It was the first appearance in a minor league game for Gillies since September 1, 2019 when he picked up a save for the Timber Rattlers at Quad Cities. Gillies was diagnosed with cancer after the 2019 season and again in August of 2020.

A DRY SPELL: The Timber Rattlers offense was held to two hits last night. They didn't have a hit after the RBI single by Peters in the fourth inning.

THE ONE THAT GOT AWAY: Beloit chipped away at Wisconsin's lead with a home run by Cody Morissette in the bottom of the fourth. Two walks in the bottom of the eighth inning put the tying runs on base. Back-to-back doubles by Morissette and Victor Mesa Jr. drove in the tying runs. A walk and a stolen base with one out set up Allen for his game-winning hit in the ninth.

ALMOST: The Rattlers had their five-game winning streak ended with the loss last night. Wisconsin has not had a six-game winning streak since June of 2018. The Rattlers also missed on matching the best start in team history through eight games. The 2005 Rattlers are the only Rattlers team to go 7-1 through eight games.

A HISTORY LESSON: Last night was the first time Wisconsin has been walked off by the Sky Carp at ABC Supply Stadium. It was also the 23rd time Beloit has recorded a walkoff win over Wisconsin.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp are in their first season as the Sky Carp and their second season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into AE Supply Stadium on August 3. Jorge Hernandez is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have a history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts eight Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Sal Frelick (#1), Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodríguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). MLB Pipeline has six current Sky Carp on their Top 30 list of Miami Marlins prospects: Dax Fulton (#9), Victor Mesa Jr. (#14), Cody Morissette (#16), Nasim Nunez (#18), Justin Evans (#19), and Tanner Allen (#23).

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ANTOINE KELLY: Selected by the Brewers in the second round of the 2019 draft out of Wabash Valley College in Mt. Carmel, Illinois. He is rated as he #10 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline.

WARRIORS...COME OUT TO PLAY: Kelly was 9-0 with 112 strikeouts in thirteen starts for the Warriors prior to the draft. He allowed 21 hits, 19 earned runs, and 31 walks over 52-2/3 innings pitched at Wabash Valley

SAYING NO TO SAN DIEGO: The San Diego Padres selected Kelly in the thirteenth round of the 2018 draft after his senior season at Maine East High School in Park Ridge, Illinois. Kelly chose junior college over signing with

THE BOYHOOD DREAM COMES TRUE: Kelly has been a Milwaukee Brewers fan since he was young.

WHAT'S BREWING? Kelly made his pro debut in the AZL with the Brewers Blue and made one start for the Rattlers in 2019. He spent 2020 with the Brewers Alternate Training Site. He underwent surgery for Thoracic Outlet Syndrome on November 5, 2020 and has worked his way back to Wisconsin after a relief appearance in Arizona and seven starts with Carolina before joining the Rattlers near the end of the 2021 season.

LAST START: Kelly had a no decision at Beloit on April 12. He allowed two runs on two hits with four walks and nine strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

VS. BELOIT: The game on April 12 is the only time Kelly has pitched against Beloit. That as also his only appearance against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

LHP ZACH KING: Selected by the Miami Marlins in the 13th round of the 2019 draft out of Vanderbilt.

THE COMMODORE: King was 3-7 and six saves with a 4.02 ERA in 70 games - six starts - over three seasons at Vanderbilt. He walked 60 and struck out 129 in 130 innings pitched during his college career.

AS A PRO (2019): King was 2-0 in six games - three starts - with the Gulf Coast League Marlins after he signed his professional contract. King walked seven and struck out 17 over 16-1/3 innings in the GCL in

BEAUTIFUL BELOIT: King made sixteen starts for the Beloit Snappers in 2021. He was 2-9 with a 5.88 ERA and 104 strikeouts in 99-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST START: King lost at Cedar Rapids on April 10. He allowed one run on two hits with four walks, a hit batsmen, and eight strikeouts over

VS. WISCONSIN (2021): King was 1-1 in three starts against Wisconsin in three different stadiums last season. He lost to the Timber Rattlers at Neuroscience Group Field on May 7. He allowed four runs on five hits with three walks and four strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings. King beat Wisconsin at Pohlman Field on July 2 when he allowed one run on four hits with two walks and eight strikeouts. On August 3 at ABC Supply Stadium, King had a no decision when he gave up five runs on five hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings pitched.
