ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 9-7 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Beloit broke a 2-2 tie with three runs in the top of the fifth inning. Wisconsin responded with two runs in the bottom of the fifth. The Sky Carp scored four runs in the top of the seventh to go up 9-4. The Rattlers got two runs in the bottom of the seventh and a run in the ninth but fell short on the comeback. Eric Bitonti, Daniel Dickinson, and Luis Castillo homered for Wisconsin.

WHAT'S AT STAKE: Wisconsin and Beloit are tied at the top of the second half West Division. The winner of today's game will go into the All-Star Break with a one-game lead. After today, the Rattlers and Sky Carp will meet twelve more times this season in Beloit.

OPERATION TURNAROUND: Daniel Dickinson went 2-for-2 with a double, homer, three walks, and three runs scored last night. Dickinson is 21-for-51 (.412) with five homers, fourteen RBI, and an OPS of 1.334 in seventeen games this half. He hit .200 with no homers, 24 RBI, and an OPS of .614 in the first half.

CHASING HISTORY: The 2026 Timber Rattlers are just the fifth team in franchise history to reach 100 home runs in a season. The 2021 team holds the franchise record.

He became the fifth Rattler this season to reach double digits in homers (Andrew Fischer, Braylon Payne, Bitonti, Marco Dinges, and Castillo). This only other time Wisconsin had five players hit ten or more homers in a season since 2005 was in 2012 (Nick Ramirez, Ben McMahan, Yadiel Rivera, Cameron Garfield, and Chadwin Stang).

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fifth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019). The Snappers played their final game at Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his second season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Bill Hall, Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Lillard, Mitch Stetter, Matt Chapman, and Matt Olson played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

STARTING PITCHERS

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ETHAN DORCHIES: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Dorchies in the tenth round of the 2024 draft out of Cary-Grove (IL) High School.

GOING PRO: Dorchies signed with the Brewers over a commitment to the University of Illinois-Chicago.

PROSPECT WATCH: Dorchies is rated as the #16 prospect in the Brewers system by *Baseball America*. MLB Pipeline has him at #18 in their latest rankings of Brewers prospects.

LAST SEASON: Dorchies split time between the Arizona Complex League (Six games – three starts) and the Carolina Mudcats (Thirteen games – eight starts). Dorchies was 0-3 with four saves, a 2.74ERA, and 89 strikeouts in 82 innings pitched.

LAST START: Dorchies lost game one of this series to the Sky Carp on [July 7](#). He allowed two runs on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings. Jacob Jenkins-Cowart hit a two-run home run off Dorchies in the game.

VS. BELOIT: Dorchies is 0-1 in two starts against the Sky Carp this season. He also started at home on [April 4](#) in game two of a doubleheader against Beloit. Dorchies allowed two runs on three hits with two walks and four strikeouts over four innings.

BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:

LHP BRAYAN MENDOZA: The Miami Marlins acquired Mendoza in a trade with the Texas Rangers on December 11, 2024. The Marlins sent Jake Burger to the Rangers for Echedry Vargas, Max Acosta, and Mendoza.

ORIGIN STORY: Mendoza signed with the Rangers as an International Draft out of Venezuela on January 18, 2021. He pitched in the Dominican Summer League, Arizona Complex League, Carolina League (Down East), and South Atlantic League (Hickory) in the Rangers system.

LAST YEAR: Mendoza spent his first year in the Marlins system with the Beloit Sky Carp. He appeared in 22 games – four starts – with a 6-5 record, a save, and an ERA of 5.18. He walked 42 and struck out 73 over 80 innings with Beloit last season.

LAST START: Mendoza earned the win against South Bend at home on [July 5](#). He allowed one hit and one walk with four strikeouts over six scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Mendoza took the loss in game two of a doubleheader against the Timber Rattlers at Neuroscience Group Field on [April 4](#). He entered the game with a 4-3 lead and struck out the first two batters he faced. Mendoza issued two walks and a hit batsman to load the bases and be taken out of the game. All three runners scored after he left and the Rattlers went on to an 8-7 win. Mendoza was 1-1 in three relief appearances against Wisconsin in 2025. He allowed four runs on eight hit with nine walks and seven strikeouts in thirteen innings versus the Rattlers last season.
