**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers defeated the Fort Wayne TinCaps 9-0 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) TJ Shook and Max Lazar combined on the six-hit shutout. Zavier Warren, Carlos Rodríguez, and Micah Bello each had two RBI for Wisconsin.

**DOUBLE ON THE BUMP:** Warren had an RBI double, an RBI single, and two runs scored last night. Warren has one double in each of his last five games. He is 9-for-20 during his current five-game hitting streak.

**SHAKE IT UP:** Shook allowed four hits and struck out seven without walking a batter over six innings for his second win of the season. Shook's outing was the second quality start of the season by a Wisconsin pitcher. Shook has 35 strikeouts this season and is second in the Midwest League. Gordon Graceffo of Peoria (38) leads the league.

**LEADING OFF:** Tristan Peters hit in the number one spot in the order for Wisconsin last night. He was the first Rattler other than Sal Frelick to hit leadoff this season. Peters was 1-for-4 with a walk, a double, and two runs scored on Tuesday. Peters is on a thirteen-game on-base streak, the longest on the team this year. He is 15-for-48 with five walks, two doubles, two triples, a homer, eight runs scored, and eight RBI during the streak. He has a .877 OPS during the streak.

**TWO-OUT BINGO:** Wisconsin had a 2-0 lead with two outs and none on in the bottom of the fifth inning. The next seven Rattlers reached base and six of them scored to push the lead to 8-0. Peters started the rally with a double.

**SAVING THE DAY:** Lazar earned his second professional save with three scoreless innings in relief of Shook. Lazar allowed two hits and struck out two last night.

**IN CONTROL:** Last night was the first time in 2022 Wisconsin pitchers did not walk an opposing batter in a game.

**ABOUT FORT WAYNE:** The Fort Wayne TinCaps franchise started as the Mattoon Indians in Illinois for the 1947 season. That franchise moved to Keokuk, Iowa to become the Keokuk Cardinals from 1958 through 1962. The team moved again to Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin for 1963. They were affiliated with the Washington Senators in 1963 and became a Minnesota Twins affiliate after the Major League team moved to Minneapolis for the 1964 season. Wisconsin Rapids moved to Kenosha, Wisconsin for the 1984 season and remained an affiliate of the Twins. Fort Wayne joined the Midwest League after the Kenosha Twins were in 1992 and the franchise moved to Fort Wayne, Indiana for the 1993 season. The team renamed themselves as the Fort Wayne Wizards and stayed an affiliate of the Twins through the 1998 season. Fort Wayne affiliated with the San Diego Padres and has remained in that relationship to this day. There was one more move for the franchise. The team moved from Memorial Stadium to Parkview Field to start the 2009 season. They also changed their name to TinCaps for 2009. The TinCaps won the only MWL Pennant for the Fort Wayne entry of the franchise in 2009. Notable former Fort Wayne players include Torri Hunter, Jake Peavy, AJ Pierzynski, Josh Barfield, LaTroy Hawkins, Corey Kluber, David Freese, and Fernando Tatis Jr.

**ABOUT THE PADRES:** San Diego's relationship with Midwest League teams began in 1990 when they started an affiliation with the Waterloo Diamonds. That partnership moved to the Springfield Sultans with the Waterloo franchise for 1994. The Padres were the parent club of the Clinton LumberKings from 1995 through 1998 before joining with the Fort Wayne franchise.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP BRANDON KNARR:** The Brewers signed Knarr as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Tampa on July 17, 2020.

**GOLDEN DOME:** Knarr pitched at Notre Dame as a freshman and appeared in twelve games.

**TO FLORIDA:** Knarr spent his sophomore season at the College of Central Florida. He was 6-1 with 86 strikeouts and an ERA of 4.66 over 65-2/3 innings in sixteen games – thirteen starts.

**TAMPA, TOO:** Knarr transferred to the University of Tampa for the 2019-2020 season and was 4-1 with 64 strikeouts and a 2.55 ERA over 35-1/3 innings pitched in six starts before the shutdown.

**IN THE MUD:** Knarr started the 2021 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 7-2 with 103 strikeouts over 75 innings and an ERA of 3.84 in sixteen games – thirteen starts – before his promotion to Wisconsin on August 17.

**LAST START:** Knarr was the [winning pitcher at Peoria on April 28](#). He pitched six scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out seven over six innings.

**VS. FORT WAYNE:** Knarr has never faced the TinCaps prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time Knarr will pitch against an affiliate of the San Diego Padres.

## FORT WAYNE SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP JACKSON WOLF:** The Padres drafted Wolf in the fourth round of the 2021 draft out of West Virginia University.

**COUNTRY ROADS:** Wolf pitched four seasons for the Mountaineers. He was 12-11 with a 3.62 ERA in 50 games – 33 starts – over his career at West Virginia. Wolf walked 88 and struck out 205 over 208-2/3 innings pitched. In his senior season at West Virginia, Wolf was 6-5 with 104 strikeouts in 89 innings pitched.

**ONE MAN WOLFPACK:** Wolf pitched a complete game to lead West Virginia to a 5-1 victory over Texas on May 26, 2021 in the Big 12 Tournament.

**FROM THE DESERT:** Wolf began his professional career with San Diego's Arizona Complex League team in 2021. He made two brief starts, allowed one hit, and gave up two unearned runs over three innings with five strikeouts and no record.

**TO THE LAKE:** The Padres sent Wolf to Lake Elsinore in the Low-A West to finish the 2021 season. Wolf had no record in five starts with the Storm. He allowed five runs, walked nine, and struck out nineteen over twelve innings at Lake Elsinore.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Wolf earned his first professional win [on April 28 at home against the Dayton Dragons with five scoreless innings as a reliever](#). He gave up two hits, walked two, and struck out seven in the game.

**LAST START:** Wolf allowed five runs on seven hits with a walk and five strikeouts over four innings [on April 23 at Lansing for a no decision](#).

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Wolf has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. He made a start against the [Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League on August 17, 2021](#). In that game, Wolf allowed an unearned run on no hits with a walk and four strikeouts in two innings.
