INDY BITS

ABOUT SUNDAY: Behind a scoreless five innings from Bubba Chandler and a go-ahead two-run single from Darick Hall in the eighth, the Indianapolis Indians emerged victorious in the series opener over the Louisville Bats on Tuesday night at Victory Field, 3-1. With the contest knotted at one in the bottom of the eighth, Tsung-Che Cheng led off with a single and advanced to third on a groundout by Nick Yorke. Following back-to-back walks issued by Major League rehabber Sam Moll, Hall came through with a clutch two-run single to left field to give the Indians the lead. Nick Solak opened the scoring in the fourth inning with a solo home run to left off Louisville starter Aaron Wilkerson. The Bats responded in the seventh, tying the game after Blake Dunn walked and Ivan Johnson singled. Both runners stole bases, and Francisco Urbáez brought home the Bats' lone run on a sacrifice fly.

ANOTHER BUCCO ABOARD: The Pittsburgh Pirates today announced that catcher/first baseman Endy Rodríguez began a major league rehab assignment with the Indianapolis Indians. He is the fifth rehabber assigned to Indy this season, following infielder Jared Triolo, right-handed pitcher Colin Holderman, first baseman Spencer Horwitz and right-handed pitcher Dauri Moreta. Rodríguez was placed on the 10-day injured list on April 15 with a right-hand laceration, sustaining the injury when struck by a pitch in the dirt on April 14 vs. Washington. The infielder appeared in 57 games for Pittsburgh in 2023, hitting .220 (41-for-186) with seven doubles, two triples, three home runs and 13 RBI. He has logged 72 total major league games, appearing in 15 contests this season before suffering the hand injury.

BUBBA ON THE BUMP: Bubba Chandler turned in another stellar start, tossing 5.0 shutout innings with four hits, three walks and eight strikeouts. He ranks among International League leaders in ERA (1.91, 7er/33.0ip, 4th), AVG (.168, 19-for-113, 4th), strikeouts (49, 4th) and WHIP (1.00, 6th). In four career starts against the Bats, he is 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA (2er/18.0), 10 hits, seven walks and 27 strikeouts. In 15 career starts with the Indians, Chandler lowered his ERA to 1.87 (15er/72.1ip). In this span, he has 103 strikeouts and opponents are hitting just .176 (45-for-255). He has struck out six-plus in 10 of those starts and eight-plus in seven. Last week, he was named the 2025 International League April Pitcher of the Month after he led all minor league pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in fewest hits allowed (seven) and batting average against (.106, 7-for-66). He is the first Indianapolis Indians pitcher to win a league monthly award since Zach Duke in May 2005.

MAY MADNESS: The Indianapolis pitching staff is off to a stellar start to May, leading Triple-A in AVG (.202, 70-for-346), strikeouts (128) and WHIP (1.07). Additionally, they rank second in ERA (2.51, 27er/97.0ip), trailing only Durham (2.38, 27er/102.0ip). Indianapolis starting pitchers rank first in Triple-A in strikeouts (72) in the month, doing so in just 50.0 innings for a 12.96 strikeouts per nine innings. Indy relievers in May lead Triple-A in WHIP (0.81), AVG (.159, 25-for-157) and rank second in bullpen ERA (1.53, 8er/47.0ip) behind Durham (1.40, 7er/45.0ip). The Indians five saves in the month are tied with Gwinnett for the most in Triple-A. Mike Burrows is tied with Sacramento's Carson Whisenhunt with 23 strikeouts for the most by any pitcher in High-A or above in the month. Bubba Chandler ranks third behind them with 22 punchouts.

BOASTING BULLPEN: The Indians bullpen has dominated during their 12-game homestand posting a Triple-A best marks in ERA (0.82, 3er/33.0ip), WHIP (0.76) and saves (five) since the homestand began on May 6. Indy relievers have a .140 opponent average (15-for-107) and 41 strikeouts in this span, ranking second and tied for third among Triple-A teams in those categories in this span, respectively. Nine of 16 total pitchers used in the homestand have not allowed a run.

YEAN SHORTS: Eddy Yean picked up his fourth save of the season on Sunday, stranding the tying runs on-base with a scoreless ninth inning in the Indians 2-0 win over Columbus. Yean extended his scoreless outing streak to nine games, marking the longest run by an Indians pitcher this season and the fifth-longest active run in the International League. In this span, he has blanked opponents across 11.1 innings with 10 hits, seven walks, eight strikeouts and four saves. This, opposed to allowing four runs, five hits, five walks and just one strikeout in his first 2.1 innings this season.

PAIR O' PIRATES: First baseman Spencer Horwitz and right-handed pitcher Dauri Moreta had their rehab assignments transferred to Indianapolis on Tuesday last week. Horwitz was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 27, retroactive to March 24, after undergoing right wrist surgery on Feb. 12. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. Horwitz went 1-for-3 with one walk and one run last night. In five games on the rehab stint, Horwitz is hitting .238 (5-for-21) with one double, one RBI, one walk and two runs. He posted multi-hit efforts on Tuesday and Saturday last week vs. Columbus. Moreta threw 0.2 innings last night, allowing one run in the seventh inning on one hit and one walk. He tossed 1.1 innings on Friday night, last week allowing one run with one hit, one walk and two strikeouts. He tossed a scoreless sixth inning on Tuesday last week with one walk, striking out the side.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak is on a scorching run in 2025, ranking among International League leaders in batting average (.382, 39-for-102, 1st), OBP (.448, 2nd), OPS (1.066, 3rd) and SLG (.618, 4th). He went 1-for-3 with a solo homer and two runs scored in last night's contest to extend his hitting streak to six games. He slugged his team-leading sixth home run in the fourth inning, giving the Indians a 1-0 lead with a 410-foot blast to left field, marking his furthest-hit homer of the campaign. He has reached base safely in 27 of 30 games this season and has one plus-hit in 26 of those, including a team best 13-game hitting streak from April 3-23. Solak hit .400 (20-for-50) with two doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, four walks, 11 runs, three stolen bases and a 1.056 OPS in that span, with that streak being tied for the third longest in the International League this season. He struck out just seven times across 55 plate appearances during the hitting streak. He was named the Indians April Player of the Month on Friday last week after he led the team in batting average, hits, total bases, home runs, RBI, on-base percentage, slugging percentage and OPS across 20 games.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue their 12-game homestand and six-game series against the Louisville Bats tonight at 6:05 PM. The Indians have won five of seven games on the homestand and aim for a 2-0 series advantage after last night's 3-1 win. Taking the mound for Indy is right-hander Braxton Ashcraft, who is set to make his team-leading ninth start of the season. He did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 8 vs. Columbus, tossing 4.0 innings with three runs, five hits, two walks and a season-high tying six strikeouts. In three career games (two starts) against the Bats, Ashcraft is 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA (1er/9.0ip) with seven hits, no walks and 10 strikeouts. He earned his first win of the campaign on April 9 at Louisville, tossing 5.0 innings of one-run ball with a season-high tying six strikeouts. Opposite Ashcraft is Bats right-hander Randy Wynne. In 11 career games (eight starts) against the Indians, he is 0-5 with a 5.80 ERA (23er/35.2ip) with 51 hits, seven walks, eight home runs and 25 strikeouts. He took the loss against Indy on April 9 against Ashcraft, allowing two runs across 5.0 innings.

ON THIS DATE IN 1948: In his first season at the helm, player-manager Al Lopez caught all nine innings and went 1-for-3 with one RBI as Indy upped its record to 18-10 with a 7-3 win over Toledo at old Victory Field. Right fielder Ted Beard finished 2-for-3 with a triple, run scored and RBI in the triumph. The Indians won a club record 100 games that season, finishing 100-54.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Braxton Ashcraft: The right-hander is Pittsburgh's No. 7 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 4 according to *Baseball America*.

Opening Day Starter: Ashcraft made his second career Opening Day start on March 28 at St. Paul, last doing so on June 14, 2019, with Class-A short season West Virginia.

Last Outing: Ashcraft did not factor into the decision on May 8 vs. Columbus, tossing 4.0 innings with three runs, five hits, two walks and a season-high tying six strikeouts.

Against the Bats: In three career games (two starts) against the Bats, Ashcraft is 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA (1er/9.0ip) with seven hits, no walks and 10 strikeouts.

Prospectus: Ashcraft entered the 2025 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 4 according to *Baseball America*. Since being drafted by the Pirates in 2018, No. 4 is his highest ranking according to *BA*, elevated from No. 10 last season.

Miscellaneous: Ashcraft was drafted by Pittsburgh in the second round (51st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Robinson High School (Waco, Texas). He had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on Nov. 14, 2023.

» Finished a homer short of the cycle on 4/15 vs. Toledo; apart of a six-game hitting streak from 4/12 (1)-4/17 in which he hit .391 (9-for-23) with four extra-base hits and a 1.071 OPS.
