SUNDAY AFTERNOON: The South Bend Cubs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 6-2 at Four Winds Field. The teams split the six-game series. Wisconsin was held to one hit and struck out fourteen times in the game.

WHAT A HIT IT WAS: Joe Gray Jr cracked a two-run home run in the top of the fourth inning for Wisconsin's only hit. The homer was Gray's third of the series at South Bend and his twelfth of the season.

DOWN EARLY: Pete Crow-Armstrong homered on the first pitch from Wisconsin starting pitcher Justin Jarvis in the bottom of the first inning. Jake Washer hit a solo home run in the with two outs in the bottom of the first. The Cubs added two more runs in the bottom of the third inning.

ROUGH DAY AT THE YARD: Wisconsin centerfielder Tyler Black made a spectacular diving catch for the final out of the bottom of the third inning. However, Black had to leave the game with an injury. In the bottom of the seventh, Wisconsin reliever Justin King had to leave with an injury with two runners on base and one out after a 2-2 pitch was fouled off by Yohendrick Pinango.

OUT HERE IN THE FIELD: Gray was the designated hitter on Sunday and was not available to play the outfield after Black left the game. Ashton McGee went in to play the outfield after pinch-hitting for Black in the top of the fourth. It was McGee's first appearance as an outfielder August 26, 2019 when he played right field in a game for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona League.

ALL EVEN AT THE TOP: Wisconsin and South Bend are tied at the top of the second half Western Division standings with 11-4 records. The Cubs start a six-game series at Peoria tonight.

PURE MICHIGAN: This series at West Michigan is the first time the Timber Rattlers have visited the Whitecaps in Michigan since July 11-13, 2018.

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Grand Rapids, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps won six Midwest League Pennants (1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015) before getting the bump up to the High-A Affiliate of the Tigers going into the 2021 season. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Brandon Inge, and Cameron Maybin.

ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

THE SEASON SO FAR: West Michigan finished the first half 31-35 in fourth place in the Eastern Division. They are coming into this series with Wisconsin after going 5-1 in a six-game series at Dayton. The Whitecaps are the first-place team in the Eastern Division and have a two-game lead over Great Lakes, the first half champions in the Eastern Division.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#7), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), and Zavier Warren (#17). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has five members of the Whitecaps roster on their list of Top 30 Prospects in the Detroit system: Ty Madden (#5), Dylan Smith (#8), Colt Keith (#12), Keider Montero (#25), and Brant Hurter (#29).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ANTOINE KELLY: Selected by the Brewers in the second round of the 2019 draft out of Wabash Valley College in Mt. Carmel, Illinois. He is rated as the #14 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* places Kelly at #10 for their in-season update of Milwaukee prospects.

WARRIORS...COME OUT TO PLAY: Kelly was 9-0 with 112 strikeouts in thirteen starts for the Warriors prior to the draft. He allowed 21 hits, 19 earned runs, and 31 walks over 52-2/3 innings pitched at Wabash Valley College

SAYING NO TO SAN DIEGO: The San Diego Padres selected Kelly in the thirteenth round of the 2018 draft after his senior season at Maine East High School in Park Ridge, Illinois. Kelly chose junior college over signing with the Padres

THE BOYHOOD DREAM COMES TRUE: Kelly has been a Milwaukee Brewers fan since he was young.

WHAT'S BREWING? Kelly made his pro debut in the AZL with the Brewers Blue and made one start for the Rattlers in 2019. He spent 2020 with the Brewers Alternate Training Site. He underwent surgery for Thoracic Outlet Syndrome on November 5, 2020 and has worked his way back to Wisconsin after a relief appearance in Arizona and seven starts with Carolina before joining the Rattlers near the end of the 2021 season.

INTO THE FUTURE: Kelly has been named to the National League roster for the 2022 SiriusXM Futures Game in Los Angeles on July 17.

LAST START: Kelly had a <u>no decision at South Bend on July 7</u>. He allowed three runs on five hits with three walks and four strikeouts over three innings.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: Kelly has never faced the Whitecaps prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Detroit Tigers.

WEST MICHIGAN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CARLOS GUZMÁN: The Tigers signed Guzmán as an International Free Agent on March 4, 2015 out of Venezuela.

STARTING POINT: Guzmán was originally signed as an infielder. He hit .156 in 34 games with Detroit's affiliate in the Venezuelan Summer League in 2015 and .107 for the Tigers East affiliate in the Gulf Coast League in 2016.

MAKING THE MOVE: Guzmán made his professional pitching debut in 2017 in the Gulf Coast League as he pitched for both Tigers East and Tigers West that season. He was 1-1 with four saves in fourteen relief appearances and 25 strikeouts over 25-2/3 innings.

PRE-2020: Guzmán went 3-4 with a 3.78 ERA in 2018 in thirteen appearances – twelve starts for Connecticut in the New York-Penn League and one relief appearance with Lakeland in the Florida State League. In 2019, Guzmán was 2-2 in seven starts with a 2.73 ERA for West Michigan in the Midwest League.

SHOW US LAST YEAR: Guzmán was 7-9 with a 4.65 ERA in 23 games – 22 starts – for Lakeland in the Low-A Southeast in 2021. He walked 46 and struck out 102 in 98-2/3 innings pitched for the Flying Tigers.

LAST APPEARANCE: Guzmán won at Dayton on July 7. He allowed two runs on three hits with three walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Guzmán has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
