ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 5-3 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Joe Gray Jr hit a pair of solo homers and added an RBI double for Wisconsin's offense. Antoine Kelly went seven innings and struck out nine while allowing two runs and walking one as the starting pitcher for the Rattlers. The win was the fourth in a row for the Timber Rattlers.

SE7EN: Kelly threw 101 pitches over seven innings for his longest outing as a professional. He also struck out seven batters in a row from the fourth through the sixth innings. Kelly has 93 strikeouts on the season and has taken over the Midwest League lead in that category.

GRAY SKIES ARE GONNA CLEAR UP: Gray put the Rattlers ahead 3-2 with a solo home run in the fourth. He hit his second home run of the night with two outs in the bottom of the sixth. Gray made it 5-2 with a two-out, RBI double in the eighth inning to give him ten total bases in the game. Last night was the second two-homer game of Gray's career. He had two homers in a game at Quad Cities on August 25, 2021.

SAVINGS PLAN: James Meeker got the call in the top of the ninth inning. He allowed a run on a hit and two walks but closed out the game for his fifth save of the season.

COMPOUNDING INTEREST: Meeker and Cam Robinson have traded saves from the Wisconsin bullpen in the four Wisconsin wins in this series. Robinson had saves in game two and game four of the series. Meeker had saves in game three and game five. The Timber Rattlers had 24 saves as a team and lead the league in that category.

ALOHA: Kolten Wong went 0-for-4 with a run scored last night as the Wisconsin designated hitter in the first game of his rehab assignment from the Brewers. He is in the lineup today as the leadoff hitter and the second baseman, Wong, a first-round pick of the St. Louis Cardinals in 2011, played for the River Bandits that season. He was 6-for-15 against Wisconsin in 2011.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo from 1969-1976, Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#7), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Xavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](#) has three current River Bandits on their Top 30 list of Kansas City Royals prospects: Peyton Wilson (#11), Luca Tresh (#23), and Diego Hernandez (#30).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP RUSSELL SMITH: Selected by the Brewers in the second round (51st overall selection) of the 2021 draft out of Texas Christian University. He is rated as he #16 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline.

AREA CODE: Smith was picked as the Most Outstanding Player at the Area Code Games in 2016. He was also a four-year letter winner at Midlothian (TX) High School.

NO, CUBS, NO: The Chicago Cubs picked Smith in the 38th round of the 2017 draft. He elected to honor a commitment to TCU.

HORNED FROGS: Smith was 7-3 with a 3.83 ERA in fifteen starts during his final season at TCU. He had 101 strikeouts in 82-1/3 innings pitched that season.

MISSING TIME: Smith missed the 2019 season due to Tommy John Surgery and most of the 2020 season due to the pandemic shutdown.

LAST START: Smith [had a no decision at Beloit on June 7](#). He allowed two runs on seven hits and a walk over 5-2/3 innings. Smith set a new single-game high as a pro with eight strikeouts.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Smith had a [no decision against the River Bandits at home on April 20](#). He allowed seven runs – five earned – on seven hits with a walk and three strikeouts over 2-1/3 innings.

QUAD CITIES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ERIC SKOGLUND: Selected by the Kansas City Royals in the 3rd round of the 2014 draft out of the Central Florida with the 92nd overall pick.

ON THE JOURNEY: Skoglund started his professional career with the Idaho Falls Chukars in 2014, moved to the Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2015, and was with the Northwest Arkansas Naturals in 2016. He was 6-3 in fifteen starts at Wilmington and went 7-10 in 27 starts for the Naturals with 134 strikeouts over 156-1/3 innings.

CHASING STORMS: Skoglund made nineteen starts for Omaha, the Triple-A affiliate of the Royals, in 2019. He went 4-5 with a 4.11 ERA and 102 strikeouts over 100-2/3 innings.

MLB DEBUT: Skoglund made the start for the Royals against the Detroit Tigers on [May 30, 2017](#) and was the winning pitcher after allowing two hits and no runs over 6-1/3 innings. Skoglund is 2-11 in 27 games – 22 starts – over parts of three seasons with Kansas City.

NEWS: Skoglund received an 80-game suspension for the 2019 season for violation of the MLB drug policy. Missed the 2021 season due to injury. He started this season on the Omaha IL before being sent out to the Arizona Complex League to start a rehab assignment on June 6, 2022.

LAST START: Skoglund had a [no decision against the Timber Rattlers in game one of this series on June 21](#). He allowed a run on two hits with two walks and two strikeouts over 2-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Skoglund's only appearance against the Timber Rattlers was the start in game one of this series.
