ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The South Bend Cubs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 8-4 at Neuroscience Group Field. Jonathan Long went 3-for-3 with two walks, a three-run home run, and three runs scored for the Cubs. Felix Valerio hit a two-run home run for the Timber Rattlers.

**THAT SEEMS DIFFICULT (PT II):** The Timber Rattlers stranded four base runners last night. They were 3-for-16 with runners in scoring position. Wisconsin hit into three inning-ending double plays last night.

**NUMBER NINE:** Jadher Areinamo was 2-for-4 with a double and a run scored for the Rattlers last night. He extended his current hitting streak to nine games. Areinamo is 14-for-36 (.389) during this streak, which is the longest by a Wisconsin hitter this season.

**DOWN EARLY:** The Cubs scored twice in the top of the first inning after there were two outs and none on base. Wisconsin has outscored opponents 57-24 in the first inning. However, the Rattlers have gone ten games without scoring a run in the first inning. The last time Wisconsin scored in the first inning was on June 13 at West Michigan. The Rattlers have only allowed opponents to score in the first inning three times in the last ten games, including last night.

PUT IT IN PLAY: Wisconsin hitters have struck out 474 times this season. That is the fewest offensive strikeouts by any full-season team in Minor League Baseball. The Rattlers are striking out 6.68 times per game. Wisconsin now has a lower strikeout rate per game than every other team in full-season minor league baseball. Memphis Redbirds of the International League have struck out 517 times in 76 games (6.80/game)

POSTSEASON: Wisconsin has qualified for the playoffs for the first time since 2016 by winning the first half West Division title. Game One will be at the second half winner's stadium on September 10. The Rattlers will host Game Two on September 12 and – if necessary – Game Three on September 13.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his first year as South Bend's manager.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP TATE KUEHNER: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Kuehner in the seventh round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Louisville.

MARSHALLING THE PAST: Kuehner played high school baseball in Marshalltown, Iowa. Former Timber Rattlers catcher Jeff Clement, the #3 pick in the 2005 draft, also played his high school baseball at Marshalltown.

CARDINAL RULE: Kuehner pitched four seasons with Louisville. He was 15-13 with nine saves and a 3.69 ERA over 70 appearances – fourteen starts - for the Cardinals. Kuehner had 193 strikeouts over 165-2/3 innings. During the 2022 NCAA Regionals in Louisville, Kuehner earned two saves and a win over seven innings in three scoreless appearances for the

**COLLEGE SUMMER LEAGUES:** Kuehner made five appearances for Waterloo in the Northwoods League in 2020 and four appearances for Danbury in the New England Collegiate Baseball League in 2021.

**DOWN IN THE DESERT:** Kuehner made two appearances – one start – for the ACL Brewers in the regular season after signing with Milwaukee in 2023. He had no record with a walk and two strikeouts over three scoreless

PLAYOFF CALL: Kuehner was the winning pitcher for the ACL Brewers in the ACL Semifinal Game against the ACL Rockies on August 24, 2023. He allowed a hit over two scoreless innings with no walks and two strikeouts. The Brewers won the game to advance to the ACL Championship Series.

LAST START: Kuehner won at Fort Wayne on June 19. He allowed two runs - one earned - on two hits and two walks with seven strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Kuehner is 1-0 in two games - one start - against the Cubs this season. He has allowed three runs on six hits with four walks and thirteen strikeouts over seven innings against South Bend.

#### SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ERIAN RODRIGUEZ: The Chicago Cubs selected Rodriguez in the 13th round of the 2021 draft out of Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Georgia.

PANAMA! Rodriguez was born in Panama City, Panama on November 11, 2001. He had a commitment to Northwest Florida State College but chose to sign with the Cubs.

THE FIRST TWO YEARS: Rodriguez did not pitch professionally in 2021. He went 2-2 in eleven games – one start – for the Cubs Arizona Complex League team in 2022 with an ERA of 11.57, ten walks, and fifteen strikeouts over 11-2/3 innings. In 2023, he was 5-6 with a 6.49 ERA in 26 games - three starts - for Myrtle Beach. In 69-1/3 innings, Rodriguez walked 45 and struck out 74 with an ERA of 6.49

ON THE BEACH: Rodriguez started the 2024 season back in Myrtle Beach. He was 3-3 with a 3.29 ERA in thirteen games - two starts and struck out 41 with sixteen strikeouts over 41 innings. He was promoted to South Bend on June 18, 2024

LAST START: Rodriguez lost to Lake County at home on June 20 in his South Bend debut. He allowed three runs on three hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Rodriguez has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. His made a relief appearance against the Carolina Mudcats, the Carolina League affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers on May 25, 2024. He allowed three hits, walked one, and struck out four over four scoreless innings for a no decision in that
