JULY, 2025:

LAST ACTION: The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 10-3 at Neuroscience Group Field on Friday. Wisconsin took a 2-0 lead in the bottom of the first inning. Beloit went up 3-2 on a two-out, three-run home run by Eric Rataczak in the top of the fifth. Eduardo Garcia tied the game with a two-out, solo home run in the bottom of the sixth. The Sky Carp went back in front on a sacrifice fly by Rataczak in the seventh, added a run in the eighth, and put the game away with five runs in the top of the ninth.

MULTI-BALL: Blake Burke, Jadher Areinamo, and Juan Baez each had two hits for the Timber Rattlers on Friday. Burke and Areinamo both have 22 multi-hit games this season. They are second and third in the Midwest League in hits. Burke (86) and Areinamo (85) trail Tanner Schofield-Sam (87) of Lansing in the hits category for the season. Burke is also second in the Midwest League in batting average (.314).

A DOZEN: Garcia's home run was his twelfth of the season. He is third in the league in homers.

MISSED OPPORTUNITIES: Wisconsin had scored two runs and had the bases loaded in with no out in the bottom of the first as the first six hitters reached base. They did not add on to their lead. The Rattlers stranded ten runners in that game.

QUALITY IS JOB ONE: Wisconsin starting pitcher Jaron DeBerry struck out seven over six innings and allowed three runs for a quality start. DeBerry matched his professional single-game high for strikeouts and set a new pro high for innings pitched in a game.

**SECOND HALF:** The Timber Rattlers are hitting .198 as a team in the second half with their opponents batting .251. Wisconsin has a team OPS of .603 in the second half with 109 strikeouts. The Timber Rattlers pitchers have walked 78 opponents. Wisconsin has been outscored 69-46 in the first thirteen games of the half

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Bill Hall, Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, Mitch Stetter, and Matt Chapman played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#17), Jadher Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). MLB Pipeline has five Beloit players on their Top 30 list of Marlins prospects: Noble Meyer (#4), Echedry Vargas (#16), Gage Miller (#21), Karson Milbrandt (#24), and Brayan Mendoza (#30).

# **■ PITCHING MATCHUP**

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER (GAME ONE):

RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Rodriguez as an International Free Agent out of Mexico on April 5, 2022.

WHIRLWIND: Rodriguez had a very busy 2022. After signing with Milwaukee in April, he began his professional career in the Dominican Summer League in June and went 1-5 with a 4.54 ERA in twelve games — five starts. Later in the year he pitched for Mexico in the U-18 World Cup of Baseball. Rodriguez went 1-1 in the tournament with a win over Australia and a loss to the Netherlands.

PLAYOFF EXPERIENCE: Rodriguez has pitched in the postseason in each of the last two seasons. He made a relief appearance for the ACL Brewers in the Arizona Complex League Semifinal Game in 2023 and was the starter in Game Two of the Carolina League Playoffs for the Mudcats against Fredericksburg.

**CHECK THE RATING:** MLB Pipeline moved Rodriguez into their Top 30 list of Brewers Prospects at #30 after Yophery Rodriguez was traded to Boston on April 7, 2025 and up to #29 when Isaac Collins graduated from the list on April 19, 2025. *Baseball America* lists Rodriguez as the #25 prospect in the Milwaukee System in their 2025 Prospect Handbook.

**LAST START:** Rodriguez had a no decision at Beloit on July 1 in his second start off the IL.. Rodriguez allowed a run on a hit, a home run by Eric Rataczak, over two innings with a walk and three strikeouts.

VS. BELOIT: Rodriguez had never pitched against the Sky Carp prior the start on July 1 at ABC Supply Stadium.

### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER (GAME TWO):

RHP TANNER GILLIS: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Gillis as a non-drafted free agent on September 3, 2024.

**ON THE HORIZON:** Gillis was a First Team All-Horizon League selection in his one season at Northern Kentucky in 2024. He was 8-3 with a 5.00 ERA in fourteen starts. Gillis had pitched four seasons for Cedarville University, an NCAA Division II school from 2019-2023.

**HOW GREEN WAS THE VALLEY?** Gillis made five appearances – four starts – for Mahoning Valley in the MLB Draft League in 2024. He was 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA, struck out 24, and walked seven over 25 innings.

**CAROLINA ON MY MIND:** Gillis started the 2025 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 1-1 with a save in seven relief appearances. Gillis had a 1.32 ERA and 28 strikeouts in 27-1/3 innings for the Mudcats before he was assigned to Wisconsin on May 15.

**LAST START:** Gillis beat Peoria at home on May 30. He allowed an unearned run on four hits with no walks and a strikeout over seven innings.

VS. BELOIT: Gillis had a no decision against the Sky Carp at home on May 18. He allowed a run on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over six innings. The game was his Timber Rattlers debut.

**RHP LUKE LASHUTKA:** Selected by the Miami Marlins in the 19<sup>th</sup> round of the 2024 draft out of St. Leo University.

**SAINT TO SAINT:** Lashutka started his collegiate career at St. Bonaventure in 2021. He would pitch for the Sandusky Ice Haulers of the Great Lakes Summer Collegiate League in the summer of 2021 before transferring to St. Leo from 2022 through 2024.

**GETTING NOTICED:** Lashutka went 10-1 with a 3.51 ERA in fifteen starts in his final season at St. Leo. He walked eleven and struck out 102 in 100 innings. Lashutka earned NCAA Division II All-American honors from American Baseball Coaches Association/Rawlings; D2CCA, and National College Baseball Writers Association. He made his pro debut with the Jupiter Hammerheads with a two-inning relief appearance after signing with the Marlins.

**LET ME KNOW WHAT SPRING IS LIKE ON JUPITER:** Lashutka was 7-2 with a save and a 1.79 ERA in sixteen games – three starts – with the Hammerheads of the Florida State League to start 2025. He had 40 strikeouts and eleven walks over 40-1/3 innings before he was promoted to Beloit on June 17.

**LAST START:** Lashutka lost at Peoria on June 28. He allowed two runs on four hits with no walks and three strikeouts over three innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN**: Lashutka is making his first appearance against the Timber Rattlers tonight. This evening is also pitching against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers for the first time.

### **BELOIT STARTING PITCHER (GAME TWO):**

RHP JAKE BROOKS: Selected by the Miami Marlins in the 11<sup>th</sup> round of the 2023 draft out of UCLA.

**DAIRYLAND:** Brooks pitched for the Fond du Lac Dock Spiders of the Northwoods League in 2020. He was 1-2 with a 6.04 ERA in nine games – five starts – and struck out 24 in 22-1/3 innings.

**COAST-TO-COAST:** Brooks pitched at UCLA during the 2021 college season and with Cotuit in the Cape Cod League during the summer of 2021. He returned to UCLA for 2022 and 2023.

**SOMETHING'S BRUIN:** Brooks was 13-10 with a 4.92 ERA in 40 games – 27 starts – over his three seasons at UCLA. He walked 35 and struck out 152 in 159 innings pitched in his three collegiate seasons.

AS A PRO: Brooks made two brief relief appearances for the FCL Marlins in 2023. He spent most of 2024 in Jupiter, Miami's Florida State League affiliate, going 9-3 with a 2.28 ERA and a save in 23 games – 21 starts. Brooks made his debut with Beloit in a start at Quad Cities on September 6, 2024.

**LAST START:** Brooks won at Peoria on <u>June 29</u>. He allowed one hit, walked none, and struck out six over six scoreless innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN**: Brooks had a no decision at Wisconsin on May 17. He allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and three strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings.
