ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 12-11 at ABC Supply Stadium.](#)

Wisconsin scored six runs in the first inning and had a 10-7 lead heading to the bottom of the seventh. Beloit scored four runs in the bottom of the seventh to take an 11-10 lead. The Rattlers tied the game in the eighth only to see the Sky Carp score the winning run on a two-out wild pitch in the bottom of the ninth. Luis Castillo homered, drove in four runs, and had two outfield assists for Wisconsin.

BIG INNING: The first six Rattlers to bat in the game reached base and scored for a 6-0 lead in the top of the first. There was an RBI single by Eric Bitonti, an RBI double by Juan Ortuno, a three-run homer by Castillo, and a homer by Tayden Hall.

BACK-TO-BACK JACKS: Wisconsin has hit back-to-back home runs seven times this season.

THE TWENTY CLUB: Castillo's homer was his twentieth of the season. Wisconsin has had four players reach at least twenty home runs this season: Bitonti, Braylon Payne, Andrew Fischer and Castillo.

RBI BATTLE: Castillo is tied with Derlin Figueroa for the Midwest League lead in RBI with 89. Bitonti is right behind them with 88.

A PRESENCE I HAVE NOT FELT SINCE... Castillo and Bitonti have two games remaining in the season to become the first Rattlers to reach 90 RBI in a season since Jon Nelson had 91 in 2003. The top RBI seasons in Timber Rattlers history:

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fifth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019). The Snappers played their final game at Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his second season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Bill Hall, Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Lillard, Mitch Stetter, Matt Chapman, and Matt Olson played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

STARTING PITCHERS

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP DANIEL CORNIEL: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Corniel as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 31, 2022.

ON THE WAY UP: Corniel made his pro debut with the Brewers #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 with a 1-4 record and a 4.97 ERA over ten games – nine starts. As a member of the Arizona Complex League Brewers in 2023, Corniel was 1-1 with a 5.70 ERA in eleven games – eight starts. He made 21 starts with the Carolina Mudcats in 2024 with a 4-5 record, a 4.29 ERA, and 95 strikeouts over 98-2/3 innings.

ROAD BLOCK: Corniel made his Timber Rattlers debut on April 9, 2025. He allowed one run on three hits with no walks and four strikeouts over three innings to be charged with the loss. He missed the rest of the season with an injury.

BACK ON THE MOUND: Corniel started this season with the ACL Brewers on a rehab assignment, beginning with a one-inning start against the Angels on May 19. He was 0-1 with a 2.00 ERA in five starts in the ACL before joining the Timber Rattlers on June 16.

LAST START: Corniel lost to Lake County at home on [August 21](#). He allowed five runs on six hits with two walks and two strikeout over three innings.

VS. БЕЛОИТ: Corniel is 1-0 with a save in three games against Beloit this season. He has allowed three runs on six hits with three walks and five strikeouts over eleven innings versus the Sky Carp in 2026.

БЕЛОИТ STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CARSON LAWS: The Miami Marlins selected Laws in the fourteenth round of the 2025 draft out of Texas State University.

NOT SO MID: Laws pitched two seasons as a reliever at Midland College. He made 27 appearances and was 6-1 with three saves and 57 strikeouts over 35 innings pitched in Junior College. He also made 21 relief appearances for the Lake Charles Gumbaux Gators of the Texas Collegiate League in 2024 with a 2-4 record, eight saves, and a 2.63 ERA.

STATED INTENTION: Laws played one season for Texas State and made 23 relief appearances. He was 4-1 with eight saves and 52 strikeouts in 37-1/3 innings.

GETTING STARTED: Laws made his pro debut with the Jupiter Hammerheads on July 13, 2025 and was moved to Beloit on August 12. He made two brief relief outings with the Hammerheads with no record. He went 2-0 with a save in seven relief appearances with the Sky Carp to end the regular season. Laws also made two scoreless appearances with six strikeouts in 2-1/3 innings during the Western Division Finals against Cedar Rapids in 2025.

LAST START: Laws lost at Quad Cities on [August 29](#). He allowed four runs – three earned – on three hits and two walks. Laws had five strikeouts in five innings against the River Bandits.

VS. WISCONSIN: Laws is 1-0 in three games – two starts – against the Timber Rattlers this year. In 2026, he has allowed six runs on twelve hits with three walks and twelve strikeouts in 12-2/3 innings. He made two scoreless, hitless relief appearances of an inning each against the Timber Rattlers in 2025.

THIS DATE IN TIMBER RATTLERS HISTORY
