ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 8-4 at Dozer Park.](#) The Chiefs broke a 2-2 tie with two runs in the bottom of the fifth and added three insurance runs in the seventh to take a 7-2 lead. Bryce Madron went 3-for-4 and scored three runs for the Chiefs.

HARD LINE: Wisconsin starting pitcher Tyson Hardin allowed four runs – three earned – on nine hits over six innings last night. It was his second consecutive quality start. Hardin had allowed eighteen hits in his first 25-2/3 innings pitched this season. He also walked none and struck out five last night. Hardin has issued four walks and struck out 34 opponents in 31-2/3 innings this season.

LOOKING FOR SUPPORT: In Hardin's six starts this season, Wisconsin's offense has scored seven runs while Hardin is in the game.

LUCKY NUMBER SEVEN: Blake Burke went 1-for-3 with a walk last night to extend his current hitting streak to seven games, his longest of the season. He is 10-for-30 (.333) during the streak.

SEVEN x TWO = FOURTEEN: Burke is also on a fourteen-game on-base streak (20-for-57, six walks, .992 OPS)

EARLY RUN: Wisconsin scored first last night. Tayden Hall tripled with two outs in the top of the second inning. Yhoswar Garcia drove him in with a single for the 1-0 lead. The Rattlers are 9-6 when scoring first this season.

BACK TO STREAKS FOR A MOMENT: Garcia's single in the second inning moved his hitting streak to four games, his longest of the season. He is 4-for-13 with four walks, four runs, and three stolen bases in this series at Peoria.

DOUBLE UP: Wisconsin's defense turned two more double plays last night to give them four in the last two games. The Rattlers have 31 on the season and lead the Midwest League lead in that category.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#16), Jader Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). [MLB Pipeline](#) has three active Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Darlin Saladin (#17), Ryan Campos (#18), and Zach Levenson (#28). Zack Showalter (#19) is currently on Peoria's Developmental List.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ANTHONY FLORES: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Flores as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on June 4, 2022.

ON AN ISLAND: Flores pitched the 2022 and 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League. He combined to go 3-8 with a 4.42 ERA and 87 strikeouts over 79-1/3 innings in 22 games – eighteen starts.

COMING TO AMERICA: Flores made twelve appearances in the Arizona Complex League and seven appearances with the Carolina Mudcats in 2024. He combined to go 5-4 with a 5.17 ERA and 85 strikeouts and 27 walks over 69-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Flores had a no decision against West Michigan at home on [May 4](#). He allowed three runs on two hits with two walks and three strikeouts in 3-2/3 innings.

VS. PEORIA: Flores has never pitched against the Chiefs prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals.

PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

RHP GERARDO SALAS: The St. Louis Cardinals signed Saladin as an International Free Agent out of Mexico on July 2, 2019.

LEVELING UP: Salas has pitched in the Dominican Summer League (2021 and 2022), Florida Complex League (2023), and Florida State League (2023 and 2024) before joining the Chiefs in 2025. He was 9-5 with a 2.62 ERA in 22 starts for the Palm Beach Cardinals last year. Salas walked 25 and struck out 119 in 113-1/3 innings pitched last year.

WINTER WORK: Salas has pitched for Sultanes de Monterrey of the Mexican Pacific League for the past three seasons. He is 1-8 with a 4.67 ERA over 17 games – 15 starts – for Monterrey.

LAST START: Salas lost to Beloit at home on [May 4](#). He allowed four runs – three earned – on three hits and two walks over 3-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Salas has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
