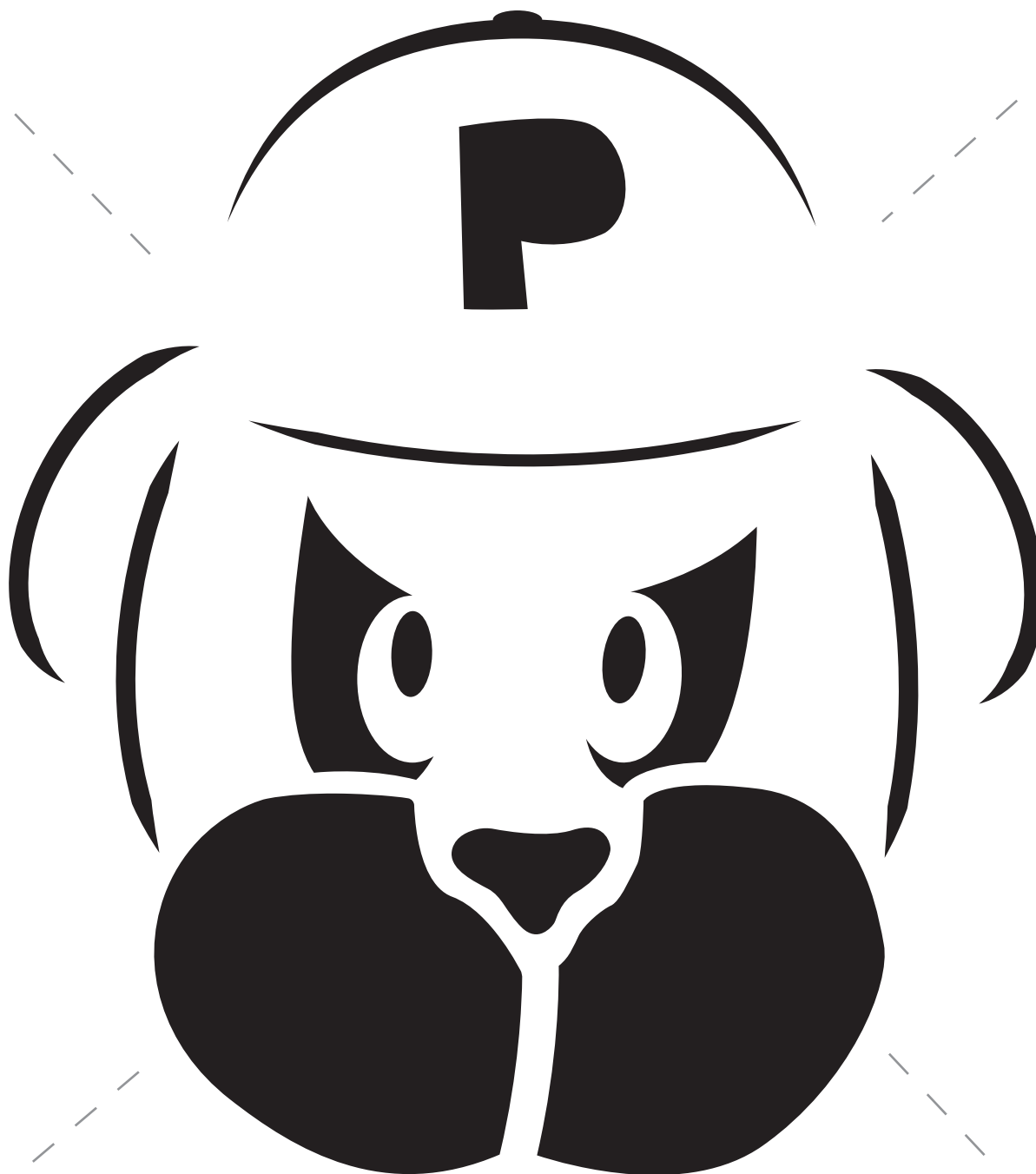




# Slugg-o-Lantern



1. With an adult's help, remove lid of pumpkin and scoop out the inside
2. Attach pattern to Pumpkin with tape or pins (*Tip: cut along the dotted lines so the pattern lays flat*)
3. Using a toothpick or other tool, poke holes along edges of black areas of the pattern
4. With an adult's help, cut along the lines you made to remove the black areas of the pattern (*Tip: remove the smallest areas first*)
5. Put a candle or light inside your Jack-O-Lantern and admire your work
