ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The South Bend Cubs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 6-2 at Neuroscience Group Field. Jefferson Rojas hit two homers to lead South Bend's 14-hit attack. The Cubs have won six straight games against the Timber Rattlers dating back to the final two games of the series in May.

DOWN EARLY: Rojas led off the game for the Cubs by hitting the second pitch of the game for a home run. The Cubs have scored in the first inning of three of the first four games of this series. Rojas also homered in the first inning of game one on Tuesday.

THIS GUY: Rojas also homered in the ninth inning to provide the final margin of victory for South Bend. Rojas is 6-for-19 with four homers and seven RBI at Neuroscience Group Field this week.

HOPE: Wisconsin pulled within 3-2 in the middle of the game. Tayden Hall had a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the fourth and Blake Burke had an RBI double in the bottom of the fifth.

STAY HOT: Blayberg Diaz went 2-for-3 with a double, a walk, and a run scored last night. Diaz is 6-for-11 with two doubles in three games during this series.

SEARCHING FOR A HIT: The Rattlers were 1-for-8 with runners in scoring position last night. They are 6for-33 (.182) with runners in scoring position in the series

**OVERPOWERED:** South Bend hit three home runs last night with two by Rojas and one my Ariel Armas. The Cubs have ten homers in this series. Rojas has four, Cameron Sisneros and Armas both have two. Drew Bowser, and Brian Kalmer have the other homers for South Bend in the series.

BROKEN HOME: The Rattlers are 20-26 at home in 2025. Opponents have outscored Wisconsin 227-179 at Neuroscience Group Field. In the second half, the Rattlers are 4-9 at home and have been outscored 78-49. In the second half, Wisconsin has scored more than four runs in a game at home four times.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, Pete Crow-Armstrong, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1992. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his second year as South Bend's

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL for an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP TANNER GILLIS:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Gillis as a non-drafted free agent on September 3, 2024.

**ON THE HORIZON:** Gillis was a First Team All-Horizon League selection in his one season at Northern Kentucky in 2024. He was 8-3 with a 5.00 ERA in fourteen starts. Gillis had pitched four seasons for Cedarville University, an NCAA Division II school from 2019-2023.

**HOW GREEN WAS THE VALLEY?** Gillis made five appearances – four starts – for Mahoning Valley in the MLB Draft League in 2024. He was 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA, struck out 24, and walked seven over 25 innings.

**CAROLINA ON MY MIND:** Gillis started the 2025 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 1-1 with a save in seven relief appearances. Gillis had a 1.32 ERA and 28 strikeouts in 27-1/3 innings for the Mudcats before he was assigned to Wisconsin on May 15.

**LAST START:** Gillis had a no decision against Beloit in game two of a doubleheader on July 6 at home. He allowed one hit and had one strikeout over two scoreless innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Gillis lost at South Bend on May 24. He allowed three runs on seven hits with a walk and four strikeouts over six innings.

# SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN GALLAGHER: The Chicago Cubs selected Gallagher in the sixth round of the 2024 draft out of UC-Santa Barbara.

**GAUCHO:** Gallagher went 18-1 with a 2.72 ERA in 30 games – 29 starts – in two seasons at UC-Santa Barbara. He had 163 strikeouts over 172 innings pitched.

**BIG:** Gallagher was the Big West Freshman Pitcher of the Year in 2023 and the Big West Pitcher of the Year in 2024. Additionally, he was First Team All-Big West, First Team NCBWA All-American, Second Team ABCA/Rawlings All-American, and Third Team Perfect Game All-American.

**SLOW ROLL:** Gallagher did not pitch professionally after signing with the Cubs in 2024. He made his pro debut with the South Bend Cubs on April 12, 2025 with a start against the Peoria Chiefs. He allowed an unearned run on three hits with a walk and three strikeouts over four innings for a no decision.

**LAST START:** Gallagher lost to Peoria at home on <u>July 5</u>. He allowed five runs on ten hits with a walk and six strikeouts over 6-1/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Gallagher beat the Timber Rattlers at Four Winds Field on May 24. He allowed an unearned run on two hits with two walks and nine strikeouts over six innings.
