LAST ACTION: Sunday's game at Quad Cities was rained out. It will not be rescheduled. [The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 12-0 at Modern Woodmen Park](#) on Saturday night. The River Bandits scored two runs in the first, four runs in the second, and a run in the third to take a 7-0 lead.

EARLY ON: Joey Wiemer was hit by a pitch to start Saturday's game. Felix Valerio followed with a double and Wisconsin had runners on second and third with no outs in the first inning. Quad Cities starting pitcher Anthony Veneziano stranded both runners and Wisconsin didn't get a runner past second for the rest of the game.

TWO-OUT BLUES: Quad Cities was up 2-0 after scoring two runs in the bottom of the first. They added four runs with two outs in the bottom of the second and three more runs with two outs in the fifth inning.

BACK TO THE MOUND: Chad McClanahan made his second appearance of the season as a pitcher. McClanahan had pitched the ninth inning against Great Lakes on August 14. Last night he allowed two hits without allowing a run. Saturday was the fifth time a position player has pitched for Wisconsin this season. Gabriel García, Nick Kahle, and Kekai Rios have also pitched this season.

EXTRA MILE: Valerio's double was his seventh of the season since joining Wisconsin. He also has four homers for eleven extra base hits in twelve games.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Snappers are in their first season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11 and [moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3](#). Mike Jacobs is in his first season as the manager of the Snappers. Jacobs managed the Clinton LumberKings in 2019, Clinton's last year as an affiliate of the Marlins.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins had a history in the old Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and current Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings and went 78-61 to qualify for the playoffs. They were swept by the South Bend Cubs in the 2019 MWL Championship Series.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts seven Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Sal Frelick (#2), Joe Gray Jr. (#9), Freddy Zamora (#11), Xavier Warren (#14), Carlos Rodriguez (#22), Joey Wiemer (#23), and Victor Castañeda (#30). [MLB Pipeline](#) has three current Snappers on their Top 30 list of Miami Marlins prospects: Eury Perez (#6), Dax Fulton (#9), and Connor Scott (#24).

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP VICTOR CASTAÑEDA: The Brewers signed Castañeda as a Minor League Free Agent off the reserve list of Toros de Tijuana from the Mexican League on July 4, 2017.

TORO! TORO! Castañeda was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA over nine games – four starts – for Tijuana in 2017 as an 18-year-old.

FROM MEXICO TO MONTANA: Castañeda was 2-6 with a 5.13 ERA in fourteen games – eight starts for Helena in the Pioneer League in 2018. He walked fifteen and struck out 40 in 47-1/3 innings pitched last season.

WELCOME TO WISCONSIN: Castañeda was 4-2 with six saves in 32 appearance – one start – with Wisconsin in 2019. Castañeda walked 14 and struck out 53 in 44 innings pitched during that season.

THE SEASON WAS NOT OVER: Castañeda was assigned to the Glendale Desert Dogs for the 2019 Arizona Fall League by the Brewers at the end of the Wisconsin season. He was 3-1 with a 1.99 ERA, six walks, and 29 strikeouts over 22-2/3 innings pitched in six games – five starts – for the Desert Dogs. Castañeda was named the AFL Pitcher of the Week on September 25, 2019.

AWARD WINNING: Castañeda was named the High-A Central League Pitcher of the Week on May 31 for his performance [at Cedar Rapids on May 28](#). He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out eight over 6-2/3 scoreless innings in the game. He was also named the Milwaukee Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July. Castañeda was 2-2 with a 2.45 ERA and 36 strikeouts in 25-2/3 innings over five starts in July.

LAST START: Castañeda finished the conclusion of the suspended game against Quad Cities from [June 20 when the game was resumed on August 24](#). He allowed one run on three hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over seven innings for the complete game victory when the game was halted by rain in the bottom of the eighth inning.

VS. BELOIT (2021): Castañeda is 1-2 in four starts against the Snappers this season. He has allowed nine runs on fifteen hits with seven walks and 20 strikeouts over twenty innings against Beloit in 2021.

BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP JOSH SIMPSON: The Marlins selected Simpson in the 32nd round of the 2019 draft out of Columbia.

HEART OF A LION: Simpson was a second team All-Ivy League selection after he was 4-3 with a 3.06 ERA and 56 strikeouts in his final season at Columbia. He went 10-10 in 29 games – 28 starts – and a 4.20 ERA with 127 strikeouts over 160-2/3 innings in his three seasons at Columbia.

GETTING STARTED: Simpson appeared in sixteen games as a reliever after signing with the Marlins in 2019. He made a relief appearance with the Gulf Coast League Marlins and fifteen relief appearances with Batavia in the New York-Penn League. Simpson was 1-0 with two saves, six walks, and 26 strikeouts over 24 innings pitched in 2019.

BACK AND FORTH: Simpson started this season in the Beloit bullpen and was 0-1 with 35 strikeouts over 27 innings in fourteen games during May and June. He went on the Beloit IL after an appearance against Quad Cities on June 25 before getting back on the mound as a starting pitcher with the Marlins affiliate in the Florida Complex League [on August 17](#). He rejoined the Snappers for a start on August 25.

LAST START: Simpson allowed a run on two hits and two walks with five strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings for a no decision [against Cedar Rapids at home on August 25](#). The start was just his second as a professional.

VS. WISCONSIN: Simpson has made two relief appearances against the Timber Rattlers this season. He has walked two, hit two, struck out six, and allowed no hits over 4-1/3 scoreless innings. Simpson does not have a decision in either appearance against Wisconsin this year.
