ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Billy Cook's 10th-inning single propelled the Indianapolis Indians to an 8-5 win over the Iowa Cubs on Friday night at Principal Park. Ronny Simon opened the top of the 10th inning at second base as the automatic runner, and the Indians loaded the bases after Ji Hwan Bae walked and Nick Solak reached on an infield single. That set the stage for Cook who smashed a 107 mph single to center field to score Simon and Bae. The throw to the plate was well short and missed by multiple I-Cubs. It rolled into the dugout and enabled Solak to score a third run. The game was full of twists and turns, with Iowa striking first with three runs in the opening frame. The rally was highlighted by a single from Kevin Alcántara and a two-run double from Ben Cowles. Indy would move to within one run, tallying a pair in the fourth, but Iowa's lead held firm until the later stages of the game. Tsung-Che Cheng tied the game with a sacrifice fly in the sixth, and it was Cook who put the Indians in front in the seventh. With Bae aboard, Cook lined a double into the left field corner to advance Bae home. Cook would later score in the inning on an infield hit by Nick Yorke. The I-Cubs would force extras with one swing of the bat in the bottom of the eighth. After a leadoff walk to Cowles, James Triantos belted a two-run home run to left-center field to knot the game up at five. Cam Sanders earned the win for Indy, covering the ninth and 10th innings, recording all six outs via strikeout in the team's 19-punchout affair. Nate Pearson entered the game in the 10th and surrendered the winning runs.

HARVESTING K'S: The Indians totaled 19 punchouts across 10.0 innings pitched in last night's extra-innings affair, their most since also racking up 19 on July 30, 2017, vs. Pawtucket. Their strikeout total was one shy of matching the Victory Field-era record of 20 on Aug. 15, 2003 (1) at Columbus. It was also the 10th time since at least 2005 a Triple-A team has fanned 19 or more batters in 10.0 innings pitched or less in a road game and the first instance since Charlotte struck out 19 in 9.0 innings on Sept. 4, 2024, at Norfolk. Indy's strikeout flurry was driven by five punchouts in 3.1 innings from Sean Sullivan and six from Cam Sanders in 2.0 innings to finish the game. It is the first time since May 23, 2024, that two Indians relievers (Issac Mattson and Chris Gau) totaled five or more strikeouts in a road game. Additionally, Cam Sanders joined Brady Feigl on Aug. 15, 2024, as the only Indians pitchers with six strikeouts in an outing of 2.0 innings.

FREE BASEBALL: With last night's extra-innings win, the Indians moved to 8-2 in extra innings, tied for the best winning percentage (.800) and second-most wins among Triple-A teams in extras this season. Eight wins in extras are the Indians most to this point in the season since they racked up 10 through 105 games in 2013 and are their most in a season overall since they had eight in 2021. Indy's pitching staff has struck out a Triple-A-high 19 batters in extra innings and have held opponents to the lowest batting average (.167, 8-for-48) and second-lowest OPS (.563) in extras (min. 10.0ip).

MAGIC NUMBERS: The Indians scored seven or more runs for the 29th time this season and moved to 28-1 in those games. Indy is one of three Triple-A teams to surrender one loss or fewer in these games, joining Jacksonville (18-0) and Durham (31-1). Additionally, Indy's 52-12 record when they score four or more runs is tied with Durham (52-12, .833) for the best winning percentage in these affairs.

RIDICULOUS-NICK: Nick Solak extended his on-base streak to 35 games after being hit by a pitch last night and singled in the 10th inning, marking his 31st game during his streak with a hit. His run is the longest active streak in Triple-A, the second-longest streak on the season and the second-longest active run among full-season minor league hitters. Solak is on the longest run by an Indians hitter since Chris Richard's 46-game on-base streak from May 13-July 6, 2006. During his streak, Solak ranks among qualified International League hitters in on-base percentage (3rd, .439), batting average (4th, .351, 47-for-134) and hits (T-5th, 47) while racking up eight doubles, three homers, 22 RBI, 17 walks to 16 strikeouts and a .917 OPS. On the season, Solak leads qualified full-season minor league hitters in batting average (.365, 95-for-260), ranks fourth in OPS (.984) and sixth in on-base percentage (.438). Solak's batting average through Aug. 1 is the highest by a qualified International League hitter since at least 2005, surpassing Jorge Padilla's .362 average (108-for-298) in 2009 with Syracuse.

BILLY COOKED: Billy Cook went 3-for-5 last night with a double, a triple and four RBI, becoming the first Indians hitter to record three hits, including a double and a triple, and four RBI in a road game since Josh Bell's cycle with five RBI on April 22, 2016, at Louisville. Additionally, he's the first Indians hitter to finish a home run shy of the cycle while driving in four runs since Chris Duffy (3-for-5, 2B, 3B, 4 RBI) on July 2, 2005, at Louisville. Cook, who made his 17th start of the season in left field last night, leads Triple-A left fielders (min. 15 G in LF) in batting average (.417, 30-for-72) and slugging percentage (.708) while ranking second in OPS (1.148).

HE GETS ON (BAE)SE: Ji Hwan Bae singled and drew two walks in last night's win, extending his on-base streak to 11 games since July 18. Across his streak, Bae is hitting .314 (11-for-35) with a .967 OPS and ranks among International League hitters in stolen bases (T-1st, 7), triples (T-1st, 2), on-base percentage (2nd, .510) and walks (T-2nd, 12). Bae has reached base safely in 21 of 24 games played since returning from the 7-day IL on June 27 and in 43 of his 48 games on the campaign overall. Since returning from the IL, he leads the International League in triples (4), is tied with teammate Ronny Simon for the most stolen bases (13) and ranks second in on-base percentage (.449) while hitting .337 (29-for-86) with 12 RBI, 17 walks to 16 strikeouts and a .902 OPS.

NAPTOWN NEWCOMERS: Following the trade deadline, the Indians roster will feature two new acquisitions: LHP Evan Sisk and catcher Rafael Flores. Sisk, 28, was acquired by Pittsburgh from Kansas City in exchange for LHP Bailey Falter on July 31. He made his major league debut earlier this season, on April 15, and earned a 1.69 ERA (1er/5.1ip) with 11 strikeouts in five appearances with the Royals. From the beginning of the season through June 25 with Omaha, he allowed no runs in 16 of 19 appearances, good for the third-lowest ERA (0.47, 1er/19.1ip) by a Triple-A pitcher in that span (min. 15.0ip). Flores, 24, was acquired by Pittsburgh from New York (AL) with catcher Edgeline Perez and OF Brian Sanchez in exchange for RHP David Bednar, also on July 31. Flores slots in as the Pirates' No. 11 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. He was promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on July 19 after hitting .287 (96-for-335) with 23 doubles, 15 homers, 56 RBI and a .842 OPS in 87 games with Double-A Somerset. He reached base safely in all 10 games he played with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, logging a .211 batting average (8-for-38) with three runs, a homer, four RBI and a .388 on-base percentage.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians and Iowa Cubs meet in the penultimate match of their six-game set tonight at 7:38 PM from Principal Park. With a win, the Indians would clinch their fifth-straight six-game series split or better since June 24 vs. Omaha and their eighth out of their last nine dating back to May 26 vs. Nashville. Since May 26, Indy has the third-best record (36-20, .643) of any Triple-A team. Southpaw Randy Labaut will start a bullpen game for Indy while RHP Spencer Turnbull will take the mound for Iowa. This will be Labaut's second start of the season, his fifth in Triple-A and the eighth of his minor league career. Labaut has made eight appearances (one start) against Iowa, five of which have been scoreless, including his last three since Aug. 18, 2024. Turnbull, 32, will be making his fourth start of the season for the I-Cubs, his 14th Triple-A appearance and the first of his career against the Indians.

ON THIS DATE IN 1979: Arturo DeFreites hit a two-run, walk-off home run in the bottom of the 16th inning to complete a cycle and lift the Indians to a 7-5 win over Wichita. DeFreites went 4-for-8 with two runs scored and three RBI in the four-hour, 21-minute contest. After Indy surrendered a 2-0 lead, it mounted a late-inning comeback with two runs in the eighth and one in the ninth to force extra innings. The two teams did not score a run for six consecutive frames before DeFreites' walk-off blast.
