ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The game between the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers and West Michigan Whitecaps was suspended with no score after one inning due to a severe downpour in the area. Both teams had two hits in the first inning of the game but neither scored. The game will resume with West Michigan coming to the plate in the top of the second inning and played to its conclusion. Sunday's regularly scheduled game will not be played and will not be rescheduled.

HOT AS A FIRECRACKER: In the first four games of this series, Wisconsin pitchers allowed two runs – one earned with twelve walks and 41 strikeouts in 37 innings. West Michigan is 14-for-122 (.115) in this series. In July, Wisconsin pitchers have 112 strikeouts and just 39 walks in 89 innings with a team ERA of 1.72. Opponents are hitting .161 against Wisconsin in ten games this month.

WILL TO WIN: Will Rudy allowed two hits and struck out five over his five scoreless innings as the Wisconsin starting pitcher Friday night.

LUKE AND LARA: Wisconsin grabbed the lead on Friday in the bottom of the fourth inning on a lead-off home run by Luis Lara, his second of the season. Luke Adams put the Rattlers up 3-0 with a two-run homer after Jadhler Areinamo had singled. Adams leads the Rattlers in homers with nine after his blast last night.

BETTER MAKE IT FIVE: Wisconsin is on its fourth five-game winning streak of the season.

A QUARTER: Wisconsin is 25 games over .500 for the first time since they were 63-38 on July 27, 2001. The 2001 Timber Rattlers finished that season 84-52 (32 games over .500) for the best record in Rattlers history.

WELCOME BACK: Milwaukee Brewers reliever Devin Williams is scheduled to appear in relief for Wisconsin today. Williams, the 2020 NL Rookie of the Year and NL Reliever of the Year in 2020 and 2023, pitched for the Rattlers in 2015 and 2016.

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Comstock Park, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps have won six Midwest League Pennants – 1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Francisco Cordero, Brandon Inge, Cameron Maybin, Alex Avila, and Willy Adames.

ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED PITCHER:

RHP PATRICIO AQUINO: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Aquino as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: Aquino made his professional debut with the Brewers #1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He made eleven starts and was 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 44 innings pitched.

LET'S GO TO ARIZONA: Aquino was 2-1 with a 4.72 ERA in eight games – seven starts – for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League during the 2022 season. He had 49 strikeouts over 34-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO CAROLINA: Aquino was 5-3 with a 2.75 ERA in 21 games – 19 starts – with 86 strikeouts over 88-1/3 innings pitched during the 2023 regular season.

PLAYOFF CALL: Aquino was the starting pitcher for the Mudcats in Game Two of the first round Carolina League playoff series against the Down East Wood Ducks. He had a no decision with six scoreless innings. The Mudcats would lose the game 6-5 in ten innings.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline rates Aquino as the #28 prospect in the Brewers organization.

LAST APPEARANCE: Aquino earned the save against West Michigan on [July 9](#). He allowed three hits and struck out five without issuing a walk over four scoreless innings.

LAST START: Aquino had a no decision at home against Fort Wayne on [May 28](#). He allowed three runs on five hits with a walk and three strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: Aquino is 0-1 with a save in two relief appearances against the Whitecaps. He allowed two runs on five hits in three innings at West Michigan and took the loss on [June 14](#). He didn't walk or strike out a batter in that game.

WEST MICHIGAN SCHEDULED PITCHER:

RHP CARLOS MARCANO: The Detroit Tigers signed Marcano as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 25, 2021.

DOMINICAN SUMMER: Marcano made his professional debut with Detroit's affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 5-6 with a save in eighteen games – one start. Marcano had 41 strikeouts and ten walks with a 5.25 ERA in 36 innings pitched.

TWO SEASONS IN FLORIDA: Marcano spent 2022 and 2023 with the Lakeland Flying Tigers in the Florida State League. In 2022, he was 3-3 with two saves in 29 relief appearances. In 2023, Marcano made eighteen starts out of his 22 appearances for Lakeland while going 4-5. In his two seasons in the Florida State League, Marcano had a 4.55 ERA, 59 walks, and 119 strikeouts over 142-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST START: Marcano won at Great Lakes on [July 6](#). He allowed three runs – one earned – on six hits with a walk and three strikeouts over five innings. Sam Mongelli hit a solo homer against Marcano in that game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Marcano had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers at home on [June 14](#). He allowed two runs on four hits with three walks and three strikeouts over six innings. The Timber Rattlers scored twice in the top of the second inning of that game against Marcano.
