### WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: [The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 9-5](http://www.wisconsinradio.com).

The River Bandits erased a 3-1 deficit with four runs in the top of the sixth inning and a run in the seventh. The Rattlers took the lead with two runs in the bottom of the fifth inning on an RBI double by Robert Moore and an RBI single by Matt Wood. Wisconsin rallied to within 6-5 with two runs in the seventh, but Quad Cities pulled away with two runs in the eighth and a run in the ninth to send Wisconsin to its third straight loss.

**MOORE, MOORE, MOORE!** Moore had two doubles, two RBI, and two runs scored for the Timber Rattlers. He has twelve doubles on the season and is tied for second in the Midwest League in that category.

**TOUGH NOTE:** The River Bandits scored a run in the top of the second inning to take a 1-0 lead. Opponents have scored first in 22 games this season. Wisconsin is 3-19 when the opponents score first.

**DOUBLE UP:** Darrien Miller doubled in the sixth inning for the Timber Rattlers. Miller had doubled in three straight games.

**TRAFFIC CONGESTION:** Quad Cities had thirteen hits, drew eight walks, and had a hit batsman on offense. That total combined with two Wisconsin errors and a fielder's choice led to 25 base runners for the Bandits. They left sixteen runners on base and went 4-for-21 with runners in scoring position.

**FIFTEEN TIMES:** Wisconsin pitchers matched their single-game high for strikeouts in a game this season as they recorded a total of fifteen.

**CROSS WORDS:** Gavin Cross hit his fourth home run of the season yesterday when he hit a lead-off homer against Brannon Jordan in the ninth inning. Cross has hit three of his four homers in 2023 against Wisconsin.

**A THREE-HOUR TOUR:** Yesterday's game had an elapsed time of three hours. That makes it the first Timber Rattlers game to hit the three-hour mark this season. Yesterday was also the first nine-inning game to take three hours for the Rattlers since July 8, 2022

**ABOUT QUAD CITIES:** The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

**ABOUT THE ROYALS:** The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE:** Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

**FAST DEBUT:** Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

**HIT PLAY:** Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

**WEEKLY AWARD:** Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021 after his performance against the White Sox on August 31, 2021. He allowed one run on one hit and two walks with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

**FEELING 2022:** Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Cornielle had a [no decision against South Bend at home on May 12](#). He allowed five runs on four hits with two walks and eight strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings. Cornielle retired the first eleven batters he faced but gave up five runs in the fifth inning.

**VS. QUAD CITIES:** Cornielle had a [no decision at Modern Woodmen Park on April 29, 2023](#). He allowed two runs on six hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

## QUAD CITIES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP WILLIAM FLEMING:** The Royals acquired Fleming from the Seattle Mariners along with pitcher Wyatt Mills in a trade for Carlos Santana on June 27, 2022.

**WAKING UP:** Fleming was 7-12 in 60 appearances – eighteen starts – in his career with the Demon Deacons. He had 125 strikeouts and an ERA of 5.39 for his career. In his final season at Wake Forest, Fleming went 4-6 with a 6.03 ERA and 65 strikeouts in 74-2/3 innings.

**GOING TO SEA:** Fleming was originally selected by the Seattle Mariners in the eleventh round of the 2021 draft out of Wake Forest University. He split time between the Arizona League Mariners and Modesto in the California League in 2021.

**MODESTO TO THE MIDWEST:** Fleming was 6-6 with a 4.92 ERA with Modesto prior to the trade between the Royals and Mariners. Fleming went 304 with a 5.10 ERA in eleven starts for the River Bandits after the trade. He had 98 strikeouts and 42 walks in 122-1/3 innings pitched between the California and Midwest Leagues last season.

**FAMILIAR FACE:** Fleming was teammates with current Timber Rattlers pitcher Joseph Hernandez in Modesto last season.

**LAST START:** Fleming had a [no decision at Beloit on July 29](#). He allowed a run on five hits with two walks and a strikeout over five innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Fleming has pitched twice against the Timber Rattlers. He made the start and took the loss at Modern Woodmen Park on [August 5, 2022](#) when he allowed two runs on seven hits and a walk with four strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings. Fleming had the win in relief against the Rattlers at Modern Woodmen Park on [April 21, 2023](#). He allowed two runs on one hit with three walks and five strikeouts over four innings. Alex Hall hit a home run off Fleming in the game earlier this season.
