ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders overcame two late Indianapolis Indians rallies to even the series on Wednesday night at PNC Field, 6-5. T.J. Rumfield singled home two runs in the bottom of the ninth for the walk-off win. SWB entered the bottom of the ninth in a 5-4 deficit. With rain coming down, Eddy Yean entered and issued back-to-back walks to Ismael Munguia and Omar Martinez. Jorbit Vivas then bunted them both into scoring position to set up Rumfield's winning knock. Indianapolis rallied from a 3-1 deficit to briefly take a 4-3 lead in the top of the eighth, but the RailRiders tied it with a solo home run from Jose Rojas in the bottom half of the frame. Indy took advantage of the wet conditions in the top of the ninth to go back in front. Ji Hwan Bae reached on a fielder's choice and advanced to third after back-to-back walks to Nick Yorke and Nick Solak. One out later, Matt Fraizer drew a bases-loaded free pass to force home Bae to give Indy a short-lived 5-4 advantage. The Indians held an early lead thanks to a solo homer from Brett Sullivan in the second, but the SWB built a 3-1 lead in the fifth. Braden Shewmake led off with a walk and scored when Munguia tripled into the right-field corner. Martinez plated Munguia with a sacrifice fly. Vivas then singled and got to third on an error. He scored on a wild pitch for the final run of the rally.

BARC' AT THE MOON: LHP Hunter Barco did not factor into the decision in last night's contest, tossing 4.0 shutout innings with three hits, no walks and five strikeouts. It was his second consecutive scoreless outing, and has now tossed 9.2 consecutive scoreless frames dating back to Aug. 1 at lowa. In 15 starts with Indianapolis, he is yet to allow more than four runs in an outing. He has three runs or fewer in 12 of those, two or fewer in 10, one or fewer in nine and five scoreless appearances. In 21 starts between Double-A Altoona and Indy, 11 of those are scoreless. It was his second time with Indy in which he did not issue a free pass (also June 29 vs. Omaha). MLB Pipeline's No. 87 overall prospect ranks among Triple-A left handers (min. 55.0ip) in opponent average (2nd, .207), opponent OPS (2nd, 6.46) and WHIP (7th, 1.31). Min. 150 batters faced against right-handed batters, he leads Triple-A southpaws in opponent average (.164), opponent OPS (.551) and WHIP (1.12).

SULLY SMASH: Brett Sullivan launched his third home run of the season, a solo shot, in the second inning of last night's contest. It was his first longball since July 8 vs. Gwinnett. He clubbed an 0-1 slider from Allan Winans 369 feet and 95.7 mph off the bat to give Indy a 1-0 lead.

BAEWATCH: Ji Hwan Bae went 3-for-4 with two runs, two doubles and a HBP in last night's contest. He reached base safely four times for the first time since a season-high four hits on July 22 vs. Toledo. He has hit safely in four straight with three of those four being multi-hit performances. Since returning from the injured list on June 27, Bae is hitting .325 (40-for-123) with 26 runs, eight doubles, four triples, 12 RBI, 20 walks, 16 stolen bases and an .885 OPS in 33 games.

BAM BAM CAM: Cam Devanney matched a season high with three hits in last night's contest, doing so for the sixth time this season and second time with Indy (also Aug. 9 vs. Omaha). Since joining the Indians, he is hitting .289 (22-for-76) with nine runs, six doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, 10 walks and an .840 OPS in 21 games. He has reached safely in 19 of those 21 and hit safely in 14.

FLAVA FRAIZ: Matt Fraizer went 1-for-4 with one run, one RBI and one walk in last night's contest. He has recorded a hit in 16 of his last 21 games since July 4, hitting .361 (26-for-72) with 12 runs, eight doubles, one triple, six RBI, six walks, five stolen bases and a .905 OPS. His batting average in that span ranks 7th among Triple-A hitters and second behind SWB's Duke Ellis (.444, 32-for-72). In Tuesday's series opener, he went 4-for-4 with one run, one triple and one stolen base, matching a career high in hits he last set on Aug. 23, 2023, with Altoona vs.

SIMON TO THE SHOW: Ronny Simon was recalled by Pittsburgh yesterday and made his Pirates debut, batting leadoff and playing right field. He went 2-for-5 with two runs in the Pirates 12-5 loss at Milwaukee. It marked his first major league action since May 27 with Miami. It was the first multi-hit performance of his MLB career. In 52 games with Indianapolis from June 6-Áug. 12, Simon reached safely in 48 of those 52 and hit safely in 39. With Indy, he hit .291 (60-for-206) 35 runs, nine doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 30 RBI, 32 walks and 24 stolen bases. His 24 steals in that span were tied for the most among Triple-A players and his 60 hits were the third most in the International League. Simon hit four leadoff homers with Indy, setting the franchise's single-season record. His four leadoff blasts are tied with Max Moroff for second for Indy career leaders, trailing only Ji Hwan Bae's five.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's six-game series with the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders on Thursday night at 6:35 PM. LHP Nick Dombkowski will open for the Indians, marking his first career start against SWB. Left-hander Ryan Yarbrough takes the mound for the RailRiders on an MLB rehab assignment, marking his first Triple-A action since July 4, 2023, with Omaha. Yarbrough made one career start against the Indians on April 20, 2017, with Durham at Victory Field. He tossed 7.0 innings of one-run ball in that game with six hits, no walks and three strikeouts.

ON THIS DATE IN 1958: In the Indians 11th consecutive victory, right fielder Johnny Callison and catcher John Romano were dubbed the "Home Run Twins" after they each hit a home run in their combined 6-for-6 day at the plate with three runs scored and four RBI. Indianapolis beat Louisville, 7-2, thanks to a complete game by Jimmie "Hot Rod" McDonald, who allowed two earned runs on 11 hits and one walk with two strikeouts.
