ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Matt Fraizer lined the go-ahead single in the top of the 10th inning and threw out the would-be tying run at the plate in the bottom half to lift the Indianapolis Indians to a 6-5 victory over the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders in 10 innings on Friday night at PNC Field. Fraizer stepped to the plate in the top of the 10th with one out and Nick Solak at second base. He lined a single to left field, his third hit of the night, and it plated Solak to give Indy the 6-5 advantage. In the bottom half of the frame, with Jorbit Vivas at second base, T.J. Rumfield singled to right field. Fraizer fired a one-hop strike to the plate and Rafael Flores applied the tag to keep Indy in front. Eddy Yean struck out the next two batters to seal the triumph for the Indians. Indy led 5-3 in the eighth, but Scranton/Wilkes-Barre tied it with two in the frame. Vivas opened it with a single and moved to third when Rumfield followed with a double. Spencer Jones then grounded out to second to knock in Vivas and advanced Rumfield to third. A balk later in the frame would score Rumfield and tie the game to help force extras. Entering the fifth, the Indians trailed 3-1 and did not have a baserunner since the second inning. That stretch ended when Alike Williams singled to left field with one out. He was replaced on the basepaths by Tsung-Che Cheng who grounded into a fielder's choice. Jase Bowen then worked a walk, and Ji Hwan Bae delivered a triple to left-center field to tie the game. Bae scored to put Indy in front, 4-3, on Nick Yorke's single to right field.

OVI-K-DO: Johan Oviedo did not factor into the decision in last night's contest, tossing 5.0 innings with four hits, three runs (2er), two walks and seven strikeouts. He has struck out 15 batters in his last 8.2 innings. In three starts with Indy on the campaign he has struck out 20 in just 13.2 innings, posting a 0.80 WHIP and .170 opponent average (8-for-47). In his second start on Aug. 9 vs. Omaha, Oviedo struck out eight batters across 3.2 innings with two hits, one run and one walk. He struck out six consecutive batters through the second and third frames. He is one of six Triple-A pitchers to strike out eight-plus batters in 3.2 innings or fewer this season and the first since Iowa's Peter Solomon (3.0ip, 8k) on May 16 vs. St. Paul. He was the first Indian to do so since Paul Skenes (3.1ip, 8k) on April 18, 2024, vs. St. Paul. It was Oviedo's most strikeouts in a Triple-A game since May 28, 2022, with Memphis vs. Iowa.

HERO BALL: Matt Fraizer was the Indians extra-inning hero in last night's contest, delivering the go-ahead hit in the top of the 10th inning and throwing out the potential tying run at home plate with a dart from right field in the bottom half. He went 3-for-5, with two runs, two doubles, one RBI and one stolen base. He raised his batting average to .309 (58-for-188) on the season, which ranks 16th in the International League (min. 200 PA). He extended his hitting streak to six games since Aug. 9, hitting .500 (9-for-18) with four runs, two doubles, one triple, three RBI, one walk, two stolen bases and a 1.248 OPS. He has recorded a hit in 18 of his last 23 games since July 4. In 11 games this month, he is hitting .409 (18-for-44) with a .971 OPS.

YEAN SHORTS: Eddy Yean earned his seventh save of the season last night, blanking the RailRiders in the 10th inning, assisted by Matt Fraizer's outfield assist at home plate to erase automatic runner Jorbit Vivas. 28 of his 40 outings this season have been scoreless. Since entering play on June 5 with a 3.98 ERA, Yean has pitched to a 2.35 ERA (8er/30.2ip) in 24 games. 17 of those 24 were shutout appearances.

NICK YORKE CITY: Nick Yorke posted his second consecutive multi-hit game, going 2-for-5 with one RBI and one stolen base. His 27 multi-hit contests on the campaign trail only Nick Solak's 28 for the most on the club. He has hit safely in 12 of his past 15 games since July 19, hitting .338 (22-for-65) with nine runs, three doubles, one home run, 11 RBI, three walks, one stolen base and a .799 OPS.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's six-game series against the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders on Saturday night at 6:05 PM. With one more win in the remaining two contests, the Indians can capture their first series over the RailRiders since taking two of three games at Victory Field from May 14-16, 2019. It would be their first series win at SWB since taking three of four games from May 6-9, 2013, capped by a 2-1 win in 11 innings in the finale. RHP Bubba Chandler takes the mound tonight for the Indians, set to make his Triple-A leading 24th start of the season. It marks his first career outing against the RailRiders. Opposite Chandler is right-hander Brendan Beck, who is set for his 10th start of the campaign. In his last outing at Lehigh Valley on Aug. 10, he allowed four runs across 5.0 innings. It would be his first career outing against the Indians.

LATE NIGHT WITH BUBBA CHANDLER: Bubba Chandler, Pittsburgh's No. 2 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 7 overall, owns a 2.43 ERA (19er/70.1ip) in 15 night game starts this season. While he owns a 5.36 ERA (25er/42.0ip) in 10 starts on the road, those numbers improve to a 3.60 ERA (12er/30.0ip) in seven road starts at night.

ON THIS DATE IN 1969: Bill Short and John Noriega tossed back-to-back two-hit shutouts in a twin bill sweep vs. Denver, 3-0 and 11-0. Each pitcher fanned six in their respective 7.0-inning outings. Offensively, home runs were the name of the game, with Clyde Mashore launching a solo homer in the opener to give Indianapolis the lead. Dave Concepción added a two-run double in the fifth for insurance. In the nightcap, Mike de la Hoz hit a grand slam during an eight-run first inning, Clarence Jones belted a pair of homers and Stanley Swanson also went yard.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER	
Bubba Chandler: Right-hander Bubba Chandler is currently rated the No. 7 overall prospect in Minor League Baseball according to MLB Pipeline and is the Pirates No. 2. In 30 career starts with Indianapolis, Chandler is 9-5 with a 3.24 ERA (49er/136.0ip) and 170 strikeouts. He has struck out eight-plus batters in eight of those starts and six-plus in 17. Last Outing: Chandler took his fifth loss of the season on Sunday vs. Omaha, tossing 4.0 innings with six hits, three runs, two walks and three strikeouts. Against the RailRiders: Tonight marks his first career start against the RailRiders IL Pitcher of the Month: Chandler was named the 2025 International League April Pitcher of the Month after he led all minor league pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in fewest hits allowed (7) and batting average against (.106, 7-for-66). He is the first Indianapolis Indians pitcher to win a league monthly award since Zach Duke in May 2005. He went 1-0 with a 1.33 ERA (3er/20.1ip), 27 strikeouts and a 0.64 WHIP across five starts in the month. In addition to his minor league leading marks, he led IL pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in WHIP and finished third in ERA. IL Pitcher of the Week: Chandler was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for Aug. 5-11, 2024, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, one walk and six strikeouts while he secured the win. Miscellaneous: Selected by Pittsburgh in the third round (72nd overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of North Oconee (Bogart, GA.) High School. He was selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game and struck out Royals prospect Gavin Cross.

» Began the season with Pittsburgh, playing in two games before being optioned to Indianapolis on 4/3.

» Matched a single-game career high with four runs scored on 4/17 vs. Toledo in a 3-for-4 effort with two doubles, a walk and a stolen base.

» Hit safely in nine straight games from 4/25 (1)-5/6 and in 15 of 17 games played from 4/15-5/6; he hit .300 with six doubles, five RBI and a .758 OPS in that span.
